On 4/24/68, Mrs. JOHN HARVEY, Manager, Biscayne Apartments, 3211 South Vernon, advised that VICK PARKER, who had been renting Apartment 108, was evicted on 4/22/68. She advised he moved in on 12/1/67, with JERRY FREELAND, whose mother HELEN FREELAND lives in Dallas. Neither PARKER nor FREELAND left a forwarding address when evicted. HARVEY was shown an Identification Order concerning RAY and advised there was no similarity whatsoever between either FREELAND or PARKER and RAY. She advised both boys are about 20-22 years old.

On 4/24/68, LINDA FREELAND, 607 North Franklin, Apartment 20k, telephone WH 6-9246, advised her brother is JERRY FREELAND and JERRY, who was recently evicted from an apartment on Vernon Street, has come to live with her and their mother. She advised upon seeing a photograph of subject RAY and an Identification Order, that she knew of no one identical to that photograph. She advised she would have her brother get in contact with the FBI as soon as possible.

On 4/24/68, JERRY FREELAND telephonically advised he had viewed the photographs of RAY and the Identification Order and knows of no one that could be identical to RAY. He advised he knows VICK PARKER's friends fairly well, having lived with PARKER for several months, and does not think any one of them resembles RAY. When advised of the circumstances under which the individual was seen by an anonymous caller driving the car PARKER rented, FREELAND stated he thought it was possible that someone viewing PARKER from a distance and not getting a real good look at PARKER could find a slight resemblance between PARKER and the photograph of RAY.

AT GRAND PRAIRIE, TEXAS

On 4/22/68, an attempt was made to contact B. J. GRIFFIN, 1106 Northwest Dallas Street. GRIFFIN was unavailable, but a copy of the Identification Order for JAMES EARL RAY was furnished his roommate, CARL BLACKWOOD.

On 4/22/68, LUCIAN WINN and W. E. RICHARDSON, Red R Coffey Shop, 518 West Main, advised neither could recall an individual identical to the Identification Order photograph of RAY which was exhibited to them. WINN stated the 1968 photograph looked vaguely familiar. They pledged immediate cooperation with the FBI should there be a person similar to the photographs of RAY in the shop. The Identification Order was left with them.

On 4/22/68, FAITE BAYLOR and MARGARET STRENGTH, Down's Burger House, Highway 80, advised neither could recall a customer that looked like the photographs of RAY on an Identification Order which was exhibited to them. They were furnished a copy of the Identification Order and promised immediate cooperation with the FBI if they should see a similar individual.

On 4/23/68, B. J. GRIFFIN, 1106 Northwest Dallas Street, advised he had viewed the Identification Order left with his roommate and could not be positive the person he saw was identical with RAY. He stated he had been no closer than 75 feet to this person and had not seen the person standing. This individual had been seated in a car on both occasions when seen by GRIFFIN. GRIFFIN stated he would notify the FBI immediately if he saw this person again, and would attempt to get the correct license plate from this individual's car. He stated when he saw this person up the street from the Grand Prairie PD on 4/21/68, it was at the Pitt Grill and not the Red R Coffey Shop.

Contacts dailey with the Dallas P.D. Jail office failed to locate CHARLES NELSON GIBSON as being in P.D. custody at any time after 3/27/68. Contacts were maintained from 4/10/68 to 4/23/68.

On 4/10/68, telephonic contact with the Bryan Hotel, 1611 Bryan, RI 2 0285 indicated GIBSON was not registered, and had not been registered since 3/13 - 14/68. He would not have been given a room, as he cheated the hotel at that time. Contact was maintained with this hotel.

On 4/18/68, MICKEY RILEY, Deskman, Bryan Hotel was shown a photograph of RAY when he was thought to be ERIC STARVO GALT, and RILEY stated GIBSON was not identical.

On 4/11/68, WILLIAM CALLOWAY, Porter, Continental Bus Station, Jackson and Ervay, advised he had been assaulted by GIBSON on 3/22/68 at the bus station, and recalled him well. He advised if he saw GIBSON again, he would notify the FBI and the police officer at permanent assignment at the bus station.

On 4/18/68, CALLOWAY was shown a photo of RAY and he stated GIBSON was not identical.

On 4/11/68, Dallas Police officer J.H. Harking, Continental Bus Station was notified of the arrangement made with WILLIAM CALLOWAY. He was notified of the results of CALLOWAY's viewing of RAY's photo.

On 4/10/68, T.G. GRIMES, 815 S. Ravinia Dr., Tel. FE 1 5568, advised GIBSON worked for him as a construction worker about four months ago, and stayed at the apartment at 300 Rosemont which GRIMES rented for him employees. GIBSON was fired because he could not get along with other employees, and accused GRIMES of being a Communist. GRIMES advised he had not seen GIBSON and would notify the FBI should he learn of GIBSON's whereabouts.

Jackson office, by teletype, 9/17/66, entitled "UNSUB; ALLEGED PLAN TO KILL REVEREND MARTIN LUTHER KING, GRENADA, MISSISSIPPI, RACIAL MATTERS," reported that the Reverend Emmett Garfield, Pastor, First Presbyterian Church, Grenada, Mississippi, who requested his identity be concealed, claimed an attorney in his parish told him two white residents of Grenada planned to assassinate King on 9/19/66, at Grenada. These men allegedly wanted to retain the attorney should they be charged.

Sam Holloway Bowers, Jr., aka Sam, Imperial Wizard, Wikon, reportedly made a statement at a Klan meeting near Harrisville, Mississippi, on 11/15/64, that two men had requested his permission to shoot King. Bowers reportedly told the men not to take any chances and stated that any American citizen would consider it his patriotic duty to shoot King if given the opportunity.

the Dallas office that one Donald James Nissen, FBI Number 670320A, then an inmate of the County Jail, Sherman, Texas, reportedly knew of an offer of \$100,000 to kill King which had been made by the KKK.

Bureau files indicate that on 4/23/67, JN 265-R (PROB) advised that L. C. Blalock, owner of Curley's Place, Winona, Mississippi, had indicated that one Julio Romeo of Jacksonville, Florida, would pay the source \$100,000 cash to kill King. At the time this information was received, Jacksonville was unable to identify Romeo and Bureau files were negative on Blalock and Romeo. All offices conduct logical investigation to determine if above persons and incidents are implicated in King's death.

Although subject Ray has been identified as the assailant, you should conduct investigation to determine if any of the above might be implicated as a conspirator.

Initial information in that case was received from DONALD JAMES NISSEN, who at the time he reported the information, was incarcerated in the Grayson County Jail, Sherman, Texas. NISSEN was released on \$1,000 bond on 6/19/67 and was believed to have returned to Atlanta, Georgia.

On 4/30/68, investigation at Sherman, Texas, revealed that the last known address of NISSEN, as of 6/19/67, was in the care of HAROLD B. FITZGERALD, SPENCER INTERNATIONAL PRESS, 3230 Peachtree Road, NE, Atlanta, Georgia, MARY LOU CROCKETT, Secretary to the County Attorney, Sheriff GEORGE W. BLANTON, and Court Appointed Attorney JOHN HILL, all of Grayson County, Sherman, Texas, advised they have heard nothing from NISSEN since his release on bond. The charge against him is still pending but the county has no intention of proceeding with prosecution.
