

It appears that the conversation between SHIPWASH and "Sandy" was nothing more than "beer talk" and no further investigation is warranted.

MYRTIS RUTH HENDRICKS, also known as JITTERBUG, 873 Mesquite Street, who requested her identity be kept confidential, furnished the following information:

She went to work on March 31, 1968, for an individual known to her as DEVILISH NICK, owner and operator of John's Restaurant located just off First Street before the underpass in Laurel, Mississippi, and worked there until April 9, 1968.

She worked as a cook and on the day after she started working for him, DEVILISH NICK had sexual relations with her. He then started her working at a place he had outside of town. On April 2, 1968, she overheard NICK say, "I got a call on the King", but did not hear any more of the conversation.

On the evening of April 3, 1968, two neatly dressed men with stocky builds came to NICK's place, where she started work at 3 p.m., and worked nights.

While going to the bathroom, she observed a rifle with a telescopic sight in NICK's office. Later, the two men took the rifle and a long box which took three men to carry out and put them in a 1964 marcon Dodge with a fake "Continental kit" on the back.

On April 4, 1968, while on duty, she overheard NICK receive a telephone call on his phone which is close to the kitchen. After this call, NICK said, "MARTIN LUTHER KING is dead". This was before the news came over the radio.

NICK had meetings every night in his office, and she was told by other employees that NICK is the head of the Ku Klux Klan in that area.

A white man known to her only as "Big WILL ADAMS' son" was in on the activity at the restaurant. FROSTENE (phonetic), a large fateNegro girl who works for NICK, and two white waitresses, who are associated with the two men who took the gua, knew of the activities of NICK.

From what she overheard, she feels that NICK had some part in the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING, but she has no definite proof of this.

She became so frightened, she told NICK she had a very sick relative in Abilene, Teas. She left on April 9, 1968, and came to Abilene where she met THOMAS McGEE. She has been going with McGEE for four years and he came to Abilene shortly before Christmas to look for work. She could not identify the photograph of JAMES EARL RAY as ever being at John's Restaurant or having ever seen him.

MYRTIS RUTH HENDRICKS, also known as JITTERBUG, 873 Mesquite Street, advised that she would be unable to advise as to the location of the house at which she worked for NICK as a prostitute, as they always went there at night. She advised that this work was before she started working at the restaurant. She started working for him as a prostitute shortly before Christmas and worked a number of times, exact amount unrecalled.

She advised that the only thing she recalls about the house is that it was on the outskirts of Laurel where there are some large homes which are not too close together. There was a gaslight in the front yard and she recalled a chimney which was for a mock fireplace in the house. She advised she did not know how many rooms were in the house, but it was fairly nice inside. She could furnish no further information on the residence, except that she believed it was a one-story house and had a large room which was always kept locked, which she believed was the meeting place for the Ku Klux Klan. She knew hone of the men who frequented the place. She advised she worked from about 9 p.m., to midnight.

She advised that when NICK made the statement, "I got a call on the King", she was upstairs in the restaurant going to the bathroom and this was the same time that she saw the gun in the room upstairs on April 2, 1968. She advised she thought NICK was talking to the man who lived upstairs at the restaurant, name unrecalled.

She advised that at the time she overheard NICK state, "MARTIN LUTHER KING is dead", NICK was standing in the little booth where food is served to persons at the drive-in. She advised that NICK was called to the telephone and upon his return he made the statement to someone there, whom she does not recall. She advised as she recalled, this was early in the evening, the exact time she does not recall. She advised that at the time she overheard this, she was cooking and leaning over, listening for an order.

THOMAS McGRE, 873 Mesquite Street, furnished the following information, which he requested be kept strictly confidential and his identity be protected.

He worked at John's Restaurant about a year ago for a month as carhop. He was told the restaurant was a meeting place for the Ku Klux Klan (KKK), and DEVILISH NICK, the proprietor of the restaurant, was the head of the KKK in that area. He also determined that the women employees worked as prostitutes for NICK on off hours and the two white women who work as waitresses, one branette and one blonde, live in the most expensive hotel in Laurel, Mississippi, name unknown.

NICK beat up certain employees while he was there and McGEE decided to leave. When he learned that MYRTIS RUTH HENDRICKS was working for NICK, who was making a prostitute out of her, he had her come to Abilene.

He admitted that he is on probation out of Gulfport, Mississippi, for "moonshining", and has previously furnished information to the FBI through a one-legged man who runs a barbershop next door to Kitchen's Grocery in Seminary, Mississippi. This man could vouch for his reliability.

He feels that should DEVILISH NICK know that he and MYRTIS have talked to the FBI, he would have them located and killed, and would take some action against their friends and relatives in Laurel, Mississippi. He, therefore, requested that their identities be protected and kept very confidential. He intimated that if investigation by the FBI reflects that the information on DEVILISH NICK is of any value, he would be willing to return to Laurel and obtain information for the FBI on a paid basis.

He advised he and HENDRICKS will maintain contact with the FBI.

On 5-3-68 gt. I. W. HAYS, Marshall Police Department, Marshall, Texas telephonically advised he received information that on the previous morning an individual, similar to RAY, had been observed entering the Michaels Beauty Salon in Marshall, after getting out of a cab. He checked with the cab Griver, ERVIN HURD, and learned HWRD picked the man up at the Hotel Marshall, delivered him to Michaels, and about 2 hours later, picked him up at Michaels at took him to the bus station. HURD, a Negro, was unable to identify this man as closely resembling the WF on RAY.

On 5-3-68 both Mr. and Mrs. BILL CLARK, operators of Michaels Beauty Salon, Marshall, advised the man referred to above had called onthe phone to make an appointment to get his hair dyed, but on arrival, had his hair bleached by Mr. CLARK. This man was wearing slacks and sportshirt, no coat or hat, and was carrying sattache case, which he kept with him all the time. This man was in his 40s, 51 5. 10, very thin, and had a full head of sandy hair. He claimed to have a relative in Marshall, and was passing through, and was to catach a bus at 1:30 PM that day. He did not give his same.

Mr. and Mrs. CLARK both viewed the WF on RAY, and both individually advised the man referred to above bore no resemblence to RAY.

On 5-3-69 LILLY MAK BLACKMON, Manager, Hotel Marshall advised that MRS. ODIS D. SUMMERLIN was the clerk on duty at 11AM 5-2-68, and NELLIE COLE was the elevator operator on duty.

On 5-3-68 MELLIE COLE advised that about 11AM 5-3-68 she observed a man enter the hotel lobby from the street, carrying a small thin grip. He had some conversation with Mrs. SUMMERLIN about getting his hair dyed, and Mrs. SUMMERLIN made several calls for him before he got an appointment. He then took a cab from the hotel, and did not return. He was not a guest of the hotel.

NELLIE COLE viewed the WF on RAY, and said there is no resemblence to the man referred to above.

Efforts to contact Mrs. SUMMERLIN 5-3-68 met with negative

results.

ON 5-7-68 Mrs. ODIS D. SUMMERLIN, Desk Clerk, Hotel Marshall, advised she was on duty at 11AM 5-2-68, and she confirmed the information previously supplied by NELLIE COLE. She described him as a WM, 32-35, 5'11, very slender, with sandy hair.

Mrs. SUMMERLIN viewed the WF on RAY, and said there is no resemblence with the man referred to above.

On 5-3-68 BRUCE BERGER advised at 2:25 PM that at 2:15PM a man dressed in a yellow shirt and blue jeans boarded the bus in Marshall, and bought a ticket to Tyler, Texas. This bus was scheduled to arrive in Longview, Texas at 2:45PM. BERGER thought this man bore a resemblence to the photo of RAY on the WF.

Lt. EARL CLAXTON, Longview PD, was contacted by phone and requested to meet the above bus in Longview. Lt. CLAXTON later advised he met the bus in Longview when it arrived at 2:45PM. He easily located the man dressed in the yellow shirt and blue jeans who had boarded the bus in Marshall. This man is a WM, age 34, bore no resemblence to RAY, and a check of his fingerprints eliminated him as being possibly identical with RAY.

BILLY JOE FAULENER, Apartment H, 2002 Kirby Street, Dallas, furnished the following information:

The only time he has been in Atlanta, Georgia, during recent years was from November, 1966, through February, 1967, when he resided at an unrecalled address on Piedmont Street. Then he resided for about two weeks at what he believes was 107 14th Street, N.E. It was the first building on 14th Street off Peachtree. He lived in a first floor apartment in the rear near the kitchen door.

He was injured on March 21, 1967, and left Atlanta on March 24, 1967, and went to live with his father in Midland City, Alabama. He stayed there until sometime in August, 1967, when he went to New Orleans and began working for Edwards Transportation Company on a tugboat. He worked on the tugboat for about six weeks. Then he went to Local 513, International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Galveston, Texas, and they got him a job with Lummus Company as a wireman and journeyman electrician on a construction job in Texas City, Texas. While in Texas City, he resided at Colonial Courts which is behind the main Post Office. He was laid off this job because of a reduction in Force.

In November and December, 1967, and January and February, 1968, he was in Midland City, Alabama, with his father. In February, 1968, he went to work for Olympia Golf Course, Dothan, Alabama, and was fired in mid-March, 1968.

From the middle of March, 1968, until he came to Dallas on April 3, 1968, he lived with SUE KELLY at My Place, a beer har on Route 4, Graceville, Florida. This bar is located 3½ miles north of Graceville on Slocom (phonetic) Highway. He spent four or five days a week at this bar and the rest of the time he spent in Midland City, where he stayed with his father or in a trailer he rented from Mr. and Mrs. CHARLES WOODHAM. The only traveling he did during this time, except back and forth between

Midland City and Graceville, was one trip he made to Pensacola, Florida, to pick up a girl to work at the bar. He went to Pensacola and returned the same day.

During the time he was at My Place bar, two girls worked there, JACKIE MOLINE and JACKIE (last name unknown), who is now employed at the Busy Bea Cafe in Dothan, Alabama.

LARRY BURCH, an insurance salesman for Independent Life Insurance Company, was in the bar almost daily and can vouch for his being there.

He arrived in Dallas on April 3, 1968, and rented the apartment at 2002 Kirby on that date. On April 4, 1968, he recalls going to see WALTER (last name unknown), who operates Galaxie One on Live Oak Street, and paying him \$3.00 for a telephone call he had made to WALTER in January. On April 5, 1968, he had lunch with DALE KNOTTS, General Director of the Tuberculosis Association in Dallas.

JERRY NED MILLER, who formerly resided near My Place bar on Route 4, Graceville, has been his constant companion for the last two months and is now residing with him at Apartment H, 2002 Kirby Street, Dallas.

SUE KELLY came to Dallas with him in his car and was living with him at this address. She is currently working as a waitress at the Mandarin Restaurant on Gaston Avenue.

He stated he did not know anyone who resided at 107 14th Street, or anyone in any of the adjoining apartment buildings in Atlanta. He recalls talking to a man about 57 years old who resided at that address who was a carpenter and he believes he returned to his home in Carrollton, Georgia, on weekends.

He was shown a photograph of JAMES EARL RAY and he stated he has never seen this person at any time. He said the name is not familiar to him, nor is the name ERIC STARVO GALT.

He knows nothing whatever about the murder of MARTIN LUTHER KING and had no hatred of KING. He would never have considered participating in any way in a plot to kill KING. He admitted having been a member of the Ku Klux Klan in 1965 but said he ceased being a member in about March, 1965, after he was stopped by police in some small town in North Carolina at which time he had his klan robes on. He claimed he was only in the klan for about four months and held no position of responsibility.

He displayed a current Florida driver's license No. H181739D, which shows it was issued March 25, 1958, and expires on his birth date in 1970. It is issued to BILLY JOE FAULKNER, Route 4, Graceville, Jackson, Florida, born February 27, 1928, white, blue eyes, 5'10", 165 pounds, an electrician.

SUE KELLY, 4817 Tremont, employed as a waitress at the Mandarin Restaurant, 4822 Gaston, related the following:

She first met BILLY JOE FAULKNER in early December, 1967, in Pensacola, Florida. He was working as an electrician there and she was employed as a barmaid. They were residing at the Pace Park Motel on Pace Boulevard in Pensacola. After meeting him, he remained in Pensacola for about a week before going back to his home in Midland City, Alabama. He returned in the latter part of January or early February, stayed with her in Pensacola two or three days. They then traveled together to Midland City and began living together in a trailer FAULKNER rented.

She soon began operating My Place bar near Graceville, Florida. She and FAULKNER lived at the bar Mondays through Fridays and returned to Midland City for the weekends. From the time they left Pensacola in late January or early February, 1968, until about April 16, 1968, she and FAULKNER were together every day. He would occasionally go to Midland City from Graceville for the day, but was never away from her overnight.

On about April 16, 1968, she and FAULKNER had an argument which resulted in her moving from Apartment H, 2002 Kirby Street, to her present address. She knows FAULKNER is a homosexual and suspects there is a homosexual relationship between FAULENER and JERRY NED MILLER, who has been with FAULENER since they left Graceville and came to Ballas.

Allied Van Lines, Pipe Line and Highway 157, advised that telephone No. 817-283-1541 is the number for this Allied Van Lines office, which is the check point and dispatching office for a five-state area which includes New Mexico, Oklahoma, Arkansas, Louisiana, and Texas. He advised there are no records kept of incoming calls and he would therefore have no way of knowing the details of a call made to the above number on 12/16/67.

He further stated that drivers for Allied Van Lines are required to check in once a day at the nearest check point, and that the drivers pay for these calls at the time they are made, and that it is generally cutomary to place the call person to person in order for them to speak to a specific dispatcher. In view of the above, BOGASH concluded that the call made on 12/16/67 from either Van Horn, Valentine or Sierra Blanco, Texas was probably a routine check-in by one of their drivers.

The following investigation was conducted by SA EARLE HALEY:

AT FORT WORTH, TEXAS

On 4/25/68, MR. FRED FICK, Attorney, 202 Burk Burnett Building, furnished the following information:

He has known JAMES ALLEN SMITH for about two years.

SMITH has been in a lot of trouble and has a long arrest record.

In the summer of 1967 SMITH was in the Tarrant County Jail on four charges of burglary, forgery, and theft. He contacted FICK on several occasions to represent him and get him out on bond. SMITH could not raise any money and finally raised a total of \$400. FICK had set a fee of \$700. SMITH told FICK he owned some property in Houston and had some assets in Houston and if he could get out he could easily raise the other \$300 and pay him in full. FICK finally agreed to make the bonds and SMITH was released. He talked to SMITH after he was released from jail. SMITH was going to Houston and liquidate some assets and pay FICK the balance of his fee for making his bonds.

FICK never saw or heard from SMITH until 2/29/68, when he read in the paper that SMITH was arrested with WALKER MARK FLANAGAN, well known Fort Worth police character, in Dallas. SMITH and

FLANAGAN were immediately taken to Houston, Texas, to face a number of burglary charges. FICK went to the District Attorney's Office in Fort Worth to get off the bonds of SMITH and learned that SMITH had been cooperating with law enforcement officers to get evidence on MARK FLANAGAN. FICK did not plan to make any bond for SMITH in Houston, Texas. The District Attorney in Fort Worth and Houston, along with state officers asked his assistance in this matter, and he made bond for SMITH in Houston on or about 3/4/68. He has not seen nor heard from SMITH since then. He has tried to locate SMITH through all known contacts in Fort Worth but has not been successful. He had heard rumors that SMITH might have been killed for cooperating with officers regarding MARK FLANAGAN. He has also heard that SMITH is using this as an excuse to lay low. FICK related that SMITH is a chronic liar, boastful, and exaggerates stories about himelf. He stated SMITH is a low-life police character and will do most anything to raise a few dollars. FICK had never heard of SMITH having any dealings with MARTIN LUTHER KING and never heard SMITH mention "South Christian Conference." He has talked about everything else but this matter to FICK. SMITH claimed he could do nearly anything on earth. FICK did not trust or believe SMITH very much prior to last time he made bonds for him. He stated at this time he would not believe SMITH "on a stack of Bibles." SMITH has been involved in car thefts but FICE never heard of him being involved in Georgia or deep South. FICK is still trying to locate SMITH, as they have indicated they would call his case in Houston, Texas, in the near future. FICK related if he should receive any information as to the whereabouts of SMITH, he would notify the Fort Worth RA.

MR. H. J. COBB, Deputy Sheriff, was contacted on 4/29/68 and furnished the following information:

He is well acquainted with JAMES ALLEN SMITH and has handled him for auto theft in the past. SMITH is wanted by his attorney and bondsman at this time. SMITH is also wanted for questioning in Oklahoma, but they have not issued a warrant. COBB believes SMITH is hiding due to the fact he cooperated with law enforcement officers in arresting WALTER MARK FLANAGAN. COBB stated SMITH might have been buried but he had not learned any definite information to sustain this belief.

MR. G. W. BURKS, Texas Ranger, advised on 5/2/68, he had not heard from SMITH and had not been able to develop any information as to his whereabouts. He stated SMITH might have been knocked off by some friends of NARK FLANAGAN. BURKS knows SMITH well and has talked to a number of contacts of SMITH but has not been able to locate SMITH. He stated SMITH talks big, brags, tells big stories, and is one of the biggest liars in the world.

MR. GLEN HAWKINS, Detective, Fort Worth PD, was contacted on 5/6/68. He advised he is well acquainted with JAMES ALLEN SMITH. He has made inquiries through all his sources but has not turned up any information on SMITH. He related SMITH could be buried by some friends of MARK FLANAGAN or SMITH might be taking advantage of the situation, has left Fort Worth, and is laying low. HAWKINS had never heard of SMITH being involved in anyting in Georgia or Alabama. He further related he would not believe SMITH or any of the big stories he tells.

MR. FRED FICK was recontacted on 5/7/68, at which time he advised he had not received any information as to the wherenbouts of SHITH. The case at Houston has been called but he obtained a postponement for 60 days.

No further investigation being conducted to locate SMITH.
