



All leads at Dallas in this regard have been resolved either at Dallas or by leads to other offices except passengers BEN BLEAM, MRS. PAUL S. BAINE and (FNU) LENLEY.

Reference to directories, office indices, credit and criminal records have failed to identify these three persons. It is noted, however, that none of the passengers interviewed have recalled seeing anyone on instant flight resembling subject. It is not felt that further efforts to identify these three persons at Dallas are justified. It is entirely possible that these three persons may be residents of Philadelphia.

In view of the mental condition of the source of the information that the subject may be at CLARK's residence and the fact that Rev. CLARK is a Negro minister, who has been active in NAACP affairs, no further investigation is believed warranted in this matter.

The following investigation was conducted by SA ROBERT J. STEVENS on May 17, 1968:

AT CARTHAGE, TEXAS:

Mrs. J. R. HOPKINS, 510 North St. Mary, advised her son, JOHN JACOBS, formerly sold real estate for her and her husband in Carthage. In about 1965, KENNETH R. HAYLES purchased her home in Carthage, and lived there with his wife and children. He traveled most of the time. In the Spring of 1967 HAYLES got behind in his house payments, and listed his house with them for sale. The house was sold, and HAYLES and his family moved from Carthage, reportedly to Shreveport, Louisiana. She is certain HAYLES and his family lived in Carthage from 1965 to 1967. She viewed the photographs of JAMES EARL RAY and said HAYLES bears no resemblance to him.

DOROTHY G. KILGORE, employee, First National Bank, advised KENNETH R. HAYLES opened a checking account at this bank November 7, 1966, and closed it June 24, 1967. On May 14, 1966, he financed the purchase of a car through this bank, and was living at 1227 West Sabine in Carthage. In about August 1967 HAYLES sold his house, and moved to 9012 Blom Boulevard, Shreveport, Louisiana. While in Carthage HAYLES first traveled quite a bit, then operated a grocery store until it burned to the ground, then worked some in Dallas, where he reportedly tried to promote a fight for Curtis Cokes. HAYLES still owes \$2,070.89 on the car note, and is two payments behind.

H. A. SPEARS, JR., Loan Officer, First National Bank, advised he first made a car loan to HAYLES on October 20, 1965, when he first moved to Carthage. He thereafter furnished basically the same information as Mrs. KILGORE.

MARIAN TAYLOR, Loan Officer, Mrs. KILGORE and Mr. SPEARS all viewed photographsof JAMES EARL RAY and each said he bears no resemblance to HAYLES.

Any individual who made entry into such safe-deposit box in April 1968 should be eliminated as to possibly being the subject.

RAY escaped from prison on 4/23/67, therefore, any box can be eliminated which was rented prior to that date. Some can also be eliminated on basis of renter being known to bank employees. Any questionable eliminations must be run out.

You are requested to immediately contact the at Dallas, Texas, and conduct investigation as instructed by Bureau.
