PETER S. GILCHRIST, CHARLOTTE, NC, ADVISED APRIL TWELVE
LAST HE WAS TRAVELING FROM ATLANTA TO HOUSTON VIA EAL FLIGHT
ONE THREE THREE. HE LEFT ATLANTA AT ELEVEN ZERO FIVE AM.
HE ADVISED UPON VIEWING JAMES EARL RAY'S PHOTOGRAPH, THAT HE
WAS SURE THAT RAY WAS THE PASSENGER ON THIS FLIGHT. HE SAID
THIS INDIVIDUAL WAS TRAVELING WITHOUT LUGGAGE. ONLY DIFFERENCE
BETWEEN RAY AND PASSENGER WAS COLOR HAIR. INDIVIDUAL ON
PLANE HAD BLOND HAIR. HE ADVISED THERE WERE FORTY-FIVE TO
FIFTY INDIVIDUALS ON THE FLIGHT BUT INSOFAR AS HE KNOWS, THIS
INDIVIDUAL WAS THE ONLY PERSON TO LEAVE THE PLANE AT HOUSTON.

GILCHRIST DID NOT KNOW THE NAME THIS INDIVIDUAL WAS USING.

MIAMI, THROUGH EAL RECORDS ATTEMPT TO DETERMINE INDIVIDUALS
NAMES ON THIS FLIGHT FROM ATLANTA TO HOUSTON AND SET OUT
APPROPRIATE LEADS.

WAS SITTING ON THE SIDE OF THE PLANE WHICH HAD THREE SEATS AND THE UNKNOWN MAN WAS SITTING ON THE SIDE WHICH HAD TWO SEATS. THERE WERE NOT ANY PASSENGERS SEATED BETWEEN THEM. IN FRONT OF GILCHRIST WAS A NEGRO GIRL. OTHER PASSENGERS SURROUNDING THEM WERE NOT OBSERVED.

GILCHRIST DESCRIBED THE UNKNOWN MAN HE THINKS LOOKS LIKE RAY AS A WHITE MALE, THIRTY-FIVE TO FORTY YEARS, MATURE LOOKING, FIVE FEET TEN INCHES, ONE SEVEN ZERO TO ONE SEVEN FIVE LBS., MEDIUM BUILD, WELL DRESSED, NO HAT OBSERVED, WEARING BROWN SUIT WITH FLECK OF GOLD OR YELLOW IN IT, WHITE SHIRT, TIE, BROWN SHOES. NO SCARS OR MARKS OBSERVED, NO GLASSES, LOOKED IN GOOD HEALTH, NO NERVOUS HABITS OBSERVED, HAD CONVENTIONAL HAIRCUT, HAIR WAS LIGHT BROWN, COMBED TO ONE SIDE. UNKNOWN MAN GAVE OVERALL NICE-LOOKING APPEARANCE. GILCHRIST WAS CARRYING WITH HIM A SMALL GRAY SUITCASE AND WAS WEARING OLIVE-COLORED SPORT COAT AND GRAY-GREEN SLACKS. HE DID NOT OBSERVED UNKNOWN MAN WITH ANY BAGGAGE ON THE PLANE.

GILCHRIST WAS SHOWN VARIOUS PHOTOGRAPHS OF RAY, AND ADVISED THAT THE PROFILE PHOTOGRAPH OF RAY TAKEN MARCH SEVENTEEN, SIXTY, LOOKS LIKE THE MAN HE OBSERVED, EXCEPT FOR THE HAIR. HE SAID HE DID NOT OBSERVE THE MAN'S EARS AND WOULD HAVE SEEN ONLY HIS RIGHT EAR IN ANY EVENT. DURING THE FLIGHT, WHICH LASTED ABOUT ONE AND ONE-HALF HOURS, THE UNKNOWN MAN WAS NOT OBSERVED TALKING TO ANYONE, INCLUDING PASSENGERS OR FLIGHT PERSONNEL. HE STOOD UP ONCE IN THE AISLE AND STRETCHED HIS ARMS OVER HIS HEAD AND IMMEDIATELY SAT DOWN AGAIN. GILCHRIST CAN FURNISH NO ADADITIONAL INFORMATION REGARDING THIS MAN, BUT REINTERATED AT HE LOOKED LIKE THE PROFILE DRAWINGS AND PHOGRAPHS OF ?KING'S ASSASSIN.

At 4:25 p.m., on 4/15/68, CHARLES McRAY called from the Swank Bar, 806 Texas, Houston, and advised that he had recently been fired from his job as manager of the Tennyson Hotel and as a result of this was drinking in the Swank Bar sitting next to a man who resembled the suspect that he had read about in the newspapers who shot MARTIN LUTHER KING. McRAY, who did not sound intoxicated, but spoke with somewhat of a slur, described the man as a white male, 45 years of age, with blonde hair darkened by lots of hair oil, brown eyes, 5'11" in height, 175-185 pounds, and wearing a blue sweater with a white shirt and dark pants. He said the man whose name he did not know had a prominent protruding nose, was drinking whiskey, and was very nervous. The man said he was from Birmingham, Alabama, and he got the impression he wanted to leave town.

McRAY stated his telephone number was CA 7-6119, but that he would be in or near the Swank Bar if the Agents came to investigate. He described himself as tall, thin, with a mustache and a receding hairline, wearing a brown suit.

At 4:45 p.m., SAs M. CLAY BLACKMAN and F. WILLIAM WHATLEY, JR. entered the bar and observed approximately a dozen patrons and one barmaid, but no one fitting the description of either CHARLES McRAY or ERIC STARVO GALT.

One patron was noticed sitting drinking at the bar wearing a dark blue sweater, white shirt open at the neck, dark brown pants, and black shoes. He appeared to be 50 years of age, 6'1"-6'2" tall, had gray hair, parted on the left, a prominent nose, and weighed 200 pounds. He was a white male.

He was observed to leave the bar, walk unsteadily to the Dot Restaurant two doors away where he ordered food, and had considerable difficulty playing the juke box due to his apparent intoxication.
