This afternoon JERRY SLAUGHTER, Security Department, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, called and advised that he had been in contact with his New York office concerning a call which had been made from Houston to subject JAMES EARL RAY in London. He asked if we had received any information in this regard and I told him that we had. He then stated he was furnishing the following information concerning TATUM as contained in the files of the telephone company:

Telephone listing per telephone records is in the name of J. E. TATUM and shows his residence as 117 Pamellia, Bellaire, Texas, telephone 667-6287. He is listed in the records as an attorney with his business telephone as CA 2-7333. The files indicate he is a former school teacher in the Houston Public School District.

He advised that as to the nature of the man the only information he has is that TATUM currently owes the telephone company a bill in excess of \$200. He stated when the telephone company sent TATUM a notice that he was delinquent in his account, TATUM raised a fuss and cursed the telephone employees.

He said he does not know the man personally but the above would indicate he possibly has a rather quick temper.

This call was allegedly placed from a pay telephone in the area near Houston, Texas.

It has also been alleged that the subject may have made several telephone calls while traveling through Texas.

It has been further alleged that the subject had indicated that his purpose in traveling to New Orleans was on business and the subject had mentioned an Italian sounding name as the person he was to contact.

Referenced Houston airtel, dated 5/2/68, contained a list of 281 calls made 12/15 - 17/67, from within the Houston Division to Louisiana.

Referenced Houston airtel, dated 5/6/68, contained an additional 75 phone calls made 12/15 - 17/67, from within the Houston Division to Louisiana.

Referenced San Antonio teletype contained a list of nine calls made from within the San Antonio Division to Louisiana.

In view of the allegations previously set forth, New Orleans is reporting only the results of interviews of persons residing in the New Orleans area.

The subscribers of the rest of the calls to other parts of Louisiana furnished by the Houston and San Antonio Divisions have also been determined. These persons who still reside in Louisiana have been located and interviewed, and no pertinent information relative to this investigation was developed. The results of these
