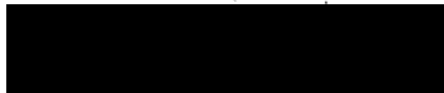
Investigation conducted by the various field divisions involved in this phase of the investigation has failed to date to identify the receiver of the alleged telephone call made by subject RAY.

FOREMAN CONSIDERED TO BE ONE OF COUNTRY'S FOREMOST ATTORNEYS IN FIELD OF CRIMINAL LAW, PARTICULARLY HOMICIDES. HE PRACTICES ALONE. HIS STRONG POINTS ARE: SELECTION OF A JURY; PERSUASIVE ARGUMENTS, PARTICULARLY REASONABLE DOUBT. HE HAS BEEN EXTREMELY SUCCESSFUL AT IMPRESSING JURIES, PARTICULARLY WHEN JUDGE HAS ALLOWED GREAT LATITUDE IN QUESTIONING OF PROSPECTIVE JURORS. IN SUCH CASES, HE HAS

HIRED LOCAL ATTORNEYS TO FAMILIARIZE HIM WITH AREA AND LOCAL SITUATIONS. HE HAS EXCELLENT MEMORY FOR NAMES AND USES THIS TALENT AND INFORMATION WHEN QUESTIONING THE PANEL IN ORDER TO ESTABLISH A PERSONAL FEELING WITH THOSE PICKED FOR JURY.

FOREMAN'S WEAKNESS, IF ANY, IS HIS LACK OF LEGAL KNOWLEDGE. HE OVERCOMES THIS WEAKNESS BY HIRING LOCAL ATTORNEYS KNOWN FOR THEIR LEGAL ABILITY. IN THE PAST HE EMPLOYED LUTHER JONES, A LEGAL AUTHORITY IN CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS; GILBERT SHARPE, NOW A MEMBER OF THE TEXAS COURT OF CIVIL APPEALS AND MOST RECENTLY C. ANTHONY FRILOUX A FORMER AUSA OF HOUSTON, TEXAS. FOREMAN IS ADEPT AT "SIDE-BAR" REMARKS AND RIDICULING PROSECUTOR, AND PROSECUTION WITNESSES. On 3/12/69, PERCY FOREMAN, Attorney, South Coast Life Building, was contacted and advised as follows:

FOREMAN has no objection to Agents of the FBI interviewing his client, JAMES EARL RAY, however, he does not wish to be quoted to anyone as giving permission and he is only speaking as an individual in this case.

FOREMAN advised that he talked to RAY for approximately 50 hours. He stated that he never discussed the facts in the case, and as a matter of fact it is his usual procedure never to discuss the facts in the case with the client, except in those cases where he intends to put the client on the stand. He stated he spent most of his time talking to RAY in an effort to get to know him as an individual and to convince him that FOREMAN was really representing him and was not in league with the District Attorney.

FOREMAN advised he believes RAY is a most unusual individual and is fully convinced that RAY will not cooperate with any authorities, particularly the FBI. He stated that

RAY became upset in the courtroom when the names of RAMSEY CLARK and J. EDGAR HOOVER were mentioned, which names RAY associates with the "establishment", his enemy.

FOREMAN advised that RAY is a racist and at one point told FOREMAN that he, RAY, felt they had a 70% chance of winning, because NIXON and WALLACE got 70% of the vote in Memphis. RAY indicated to FOREMAN that politics has more to do with the outcome of a case than does legal ability. RAY believes that a defense attorney should be of the opposite political party as that of the prosecutor.

FOREMAN advised that as an example of RAY's extreme face conscious ideas, RAY refused to accept the legal services arranged by FOREMAN of one JOHN HOOKER, a brilliant attorney in Tennessee, because HOOKER's son when running for political office had received the support of Negro groups in Tennessee.

FOREMAN restated his position that the criminal proceedings concerning RAY are over, and, therefore, he personally would have no objection to an interview by the FBI, however, he believes such interview would be as unproductive as talking to the wall. He stated that when he last saw RAY he never expected to see or hear from him again, however, RAY's brother has indicated that RAY will probably have FOREMAN represent him in some civil proceedings which involve RAY's efforts to recover some of RAY's personal property.

FOREMAN also pointed out that RAY was critical of the FBI in this regard. RAY apparently has read numerous articles concerning the facts in this case and told FOREMAN that the FBI was apparently concealing evidence because there were numerous fingerprints on the gun according to RAY, whereas the FBI stated there was a limited number of fingerprints. RAY apparently deliberately left fingerprints on the gun and RAY feels he should have received more credit in this regard.

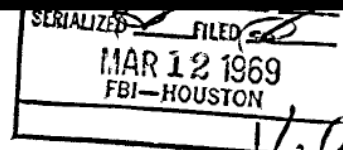

The 3/24/69 issue of "The Daily Oklahoman," a newspaper published in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, contained an article reflecting that ROY W. CLARK, age 45, from Houston, Texas, was arrested by the Oklahoma City Police Department on 3/23/69, and jailed on a drunkenness complaint. According to the article the police are investigating a notebook found on CLARK that included dates and information concerning the slaying of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING. The article indicated the notations appeared to be in diary form and included the following dates and quotes:

"4-4-68--Martin Luther King shot in the face and neck"
"4-5-68--A visit from Ray."

On 3/24/69, Lt. WILLIAM MEAD, Robbery and Homicide Division, Oklahoma City Police Department, advised SA J. A. GRIMES that ROY W. CLARK, Negro, male, born [REDACTED] was arrested in Oklahoma City on the afternoon of 3/23/69 and charged with being drunk. He is being held also as a suspect in an armed robbery which occurred in Oklahoma City shortly prior to his arrest. Lt. MEAD advised that arresting officers found a small loose-leaf notebook in CLARK's automobile which contained about three pages of handwritten dates and notations in the general form of a diary. He made available the notebook and it was noted the first two items listed were as follows:

Lt. MEAD advised that officers of the Oklahoma City PD interviewed CLARK regarding the notebook and he stated he kept this book to jot down items which he thought were of interest and which he wanted to remember at the time. He stated he wrote down the date of KING's murder since he wanted to remember the date of this event. When questioned about the entry on 4/5/68, he advised that this referred to a contact by FBI Agent VAN RAYE on 4/5/68, who at that time was contacting him periodically regarding racial and criminal matters in Houston. He stated he had originally been contacted by Agent VAN RAYE in regard to a relative who was a deserter from the Marine Corps and thereafter VAN RAYE contacted him periodically for a period of several months. He stated he has not been contacted by VAN RAYE for the last several months.

Lt. MEAD advised that the notebook maintained by CLARK contained no entries other than the above mentioned entries which would indicate CLARK had any interest or connection with the KING murder case.

On 3/24/69, SAC WESLEY T. WHALEY, Houston Division, telephonically advised that the files of that office reflect ROY W. CLARK, Negro male, born [REDACTED] was a PCI of the Houston Office during the period of KING's murder and was assigned to Special Agent OTTO VAN RY. He advised that a review of CLARK's file reflects CLARK was in fact contacted by SA VAN RY on 4/5/68, relative to racial matters.

In view of above circumstances, no further investigation being conducted.
