SAC Gamble of the Birmingham Office telephonically advised that he had received a call from General Doster of the Alabama National Guard on the evening of 4/9/68. Gamble was unable to contact the General and on 4/10/68 the Adjutant of the Alabama National Guard appeared at the Birmingham Office and desired to know whether the rifle used in the killing of Martin Luther King, Jr., had been purchased in Alabama. He pointed out that the National Guard had the responsibility for the over-all security in the State and a tense racial situation might develop if it is true that the rifle used in the killing had been purchased in Birmingham, Alabama.

ACTION:

After talking with Mr. DeLoach, SAC Gamble was instructed that he could advise the General of the Alabama National Guard for his confidential information that it appeared that a rifle found near the scene of the shooting was in fact purchased in Birmingham, Alabama; that the FBI if asked about this will neither confirm or deny it; that we are pursuing a strict no comment position.

a "Fidelist" (pro-Castro). During this period he allegedly belonged to the July 26th Movement. Henriquez Lora reportedly during his residence in Miami performed some work for the Cuban Department of Investigation of the Revolutionary Army. While in Miami, he became acquainted with a number of pro-Batista exiles whom he later swindled out of substantial amounts of U. S. dollars. Subsequently he reportedly returned to Havana and from there proceeded to Spain. The HGS noted it was possible he had been sent to Spain on a specific mission since he was in frequent contact with Cuban Embassy in Madrid during the period May through July, 1959. (X) (u)

The HGS advised Henriquez Lora had been reported to be in contact with leaders of anti-Castro Cuban groups in Spain and he was known to have spent money freely. His father who was then a Dominican national was reported to be on good terms with Dominican Generals Wessin y Wessin and Imbert Barrera. This information should be classified "Secret." (S) (u)

Legat, Madrid, on 2/7/61 reported several of his Cuban sources had expressed doubts regarding the loyalties of Henriquez Lora. They noted he openly indicated he was opposed to Castro but continued to maintain rather close contact with the Cuban Embassy in Madrid. As a result, he was suspected of being an informer or undercover agent for the Castro government. (u)

Henriquez Lora in a letter dated July 23, 1966, from Madrid advised Joe Mallor, 401 Broadway, New York City, that he must know Henriquez Lora had been prosecuted by Castro in absentia for plotting to murder Castro. He claimed news of the trial had been carried in many U. S. papers and other defendants included Rolando Cubela and Ramon Guin. He claimed Castro had ordered that he be kidnapped due to his association with CIA. (u)

Another confidential source abroad (Directorate General of Security - DGS, Spanish National Police) on 3/20/67 reported during the proceedings of "Trial 108" in Cuba against Commanders Rolando Cubelas, Ramon Guin and other Cubans accused of crimes against the integrity and stability of the Cuban nation, one Hernan Henriquez Lora was described as an agent of CIA. This information was classified "Confidential" by DGS. As noted in re Butel, CIA on 8/9/66 advised it had not had any operational interest in Hernan Henriquez Lora. (X) (u)

ReSANlet and LHM 3/4/68 captioned "Francisco Alberto Henriquez Vasquez, aka, IS - DR" reported Hernan Henriquez Lora had reported that Angelica Cruz de Henriquez as of February, 1968, was in Havana, Cuba, where she reportedly was in charge of a women's prison. (U)

For your information, U. S. Customs, Miami, advised 11/10/61 that a routine inspection on that date of unmarked luggage at Miami International Airport revealed such luggage belonged to Juan Nilo Otero Rodriguez, Cuban Ambassador to the United Nations. Among the considerable quantity of material in the Ambassador's luggage was a letter from one Clemente Mattei Padilla. This letter was addressed to "Compatriot" and in part indicated that Angelica Cruz had been divorced by her husband, Chito Henriquez. (U)

Two extra copies of this communication are being furnished Legat, Santo Domingo, for inclusion in Legat's files pertaining to Hernan Henriquez Lora and Francisco Alberto Henriquez Vasquez. (U)

NOTE:

Legat in retels reported Henriquez Lora has volunteered to Legat that a third party he refused to identify had overheard conversation in Santo Domingo between two Dominican communists in which it was alleged that Stokely Carmichael and H. Rap Brown for more than 15 days prior to 4/6/68 had been advocating the death of Martin Luther King. In reButel we advised Legat additional pertinent information concerning Henriquez Lora would be forwarded by airtel. (U)

Search of premises believed occupied by Unsub who assassinated Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING on 4/4/68, disclosed suitcase in which was located tee-shirt and undershorts bearing laundry mark on red tape with black lettering believed to be thermo-seal type, manufactured by Textile Marking Machine Co., Inc., Syracuse, N. Y. The tape is $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide and $1 \frac{1}{16}$ " long and bears letters and numbers 02B-6.

Experts at Textile Marking Machine Company advise type on this machine is unusual in that the first two characters are 15 point type and the last three characters are 18 point type, with the middle character, the letter B, probably being narrow rather than regular type. The usual machine carries 15 point type for the first three characters and 18 point type for the last two characters

Textile Marking Machine experts also stated this machine is defective in that it is producing a tape $1 \frac{1}{16}$ " long instead of $1 \frac{1}{8}$ " long and is not projecting the tape far enough resulting in cutting off a portion of the first letter. The code used in the Northeast part of the U. S. is as follows:

The first letter O stands for lot number; the first number 2 indicates the day of the week, two being Tuesday; the second letter indicates the first letter of the store name, this is the letter B; the last number is the bundle number, this is 6. Color coding of the tag may designate various things such as a different month or the identity of a store in a chain. Experts also state the use of this system on laundry items is unusual in that the system is normally used on garments being dry cleaned.

The Bureau has instructed that all textile machines using this type tape be located and machines using this code be identified.
