"I seen him when she check him in. He had his back to me, but I judge he was about 5-feet-11. He had dark hair and a pretty neat hair cut."

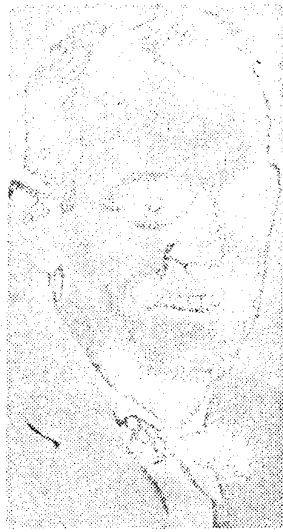
Charlie Q. Stephens, in room 6—between the room taken by Willard, and the bathroom—got a better look.

Dr. Johnson Missing For One Week

City police are searching for a 46-year-old Tucson physician who has been missing for one week after failing to keep an appointment at St. Joseph's Hospital.

Dr. Robert B. Johnson, of 100 Calle Encanto, was last seen March 29 when he left his office at 1311 N. Country Club Rd. He told his nurse he would return two hours later.

Officials at St. Joseph's said Dr. Johnson apparently never made it to the hospital.

The doctor is described as 5-feet-10, weighs about 175 pounds, and has a small scar on his forehead. He has brown eyes, graying hair worn in a crew cut and medium complexion.

Police said he was driving a 1967 white sports car when he disappeared.

One clipping notes that one Doctor Robert B. Johnson, driving a 1967 white sports car, had been missing for one week. Mrs. Peek, in her letter, raises the question as to whether Doctor Johnson could possibly be the slayer of Doctor Martin Luther King, Jr.

Phoenix conduct sufficient investigation to eliminate or include Doctor Johnson as a suspect in captioned case. Suairtel results unless more expeditious means warranted.

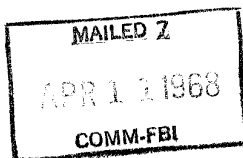
Neither Doctor Johnson nor Mrs. Peek are identifiable in Bureau files. Mrs. Peek's letter has been acknowledged.

The Philadelphia Office has advised that the Barclay Laundry, 253 South Tenth Street, Philadelphia, has used the same code numbers which appeared on the articles of clothing in instant case. It is noted that each laundry having one of the machines can prepare its own code involving a combination of letters and numbers.

The laundry in Philadelphia used a similar code on December 19, 1967, on the laundry of one Fred Neibauer, who formerly resided at 2318 Spruce Street in Philadelphia, and now resides at 2213 Spruce Street. Neibauer is a school teacher in West Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and has Social Security No. [redacted]. It is reported that he has been present at school every day during the last four weeks. It is also reported that he resides in a rooming house.

ACTION:

Philadelphia was instructed to obtain a sample tape prepared on each machine owned by the laundry and to bring the samples immediately to the FBI Laboratory so it can be determined if the tape in question was prepared on one of the machines of the Barclay Laundry. Philadelphia was also instructed to institute investigation into the background of Neibauer and to ascertain identities of occupants of the rooming house from 12/1/67 to date. Philadelphia was further instructed to expedite the handling of all leads concerning Eric S. Galt.

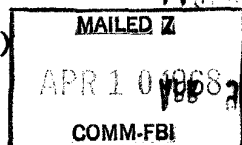

Debris found on the face of the bolt of the Q72 rifle shows that this rifle has not been fired recently. The debris has been present for a considerable length of time and this weapon probably has not been fired since manufacture.

The Memphis Office submitted a .30-06 Springfield caliber Remington Model 760 rifle, Serial Number 461476, to the Laboratory in connection with this case. A Redfield telescope sight is mounted on this rifle. No marks were found on the telescope sight tube and, therefore, the telescope sight mount, Q73, cannot be associated with this sight tube. on the basis of a toolmark examination. Therefore, it was not possible to determine whether or not the telescope sight was ever on the telescope mount.

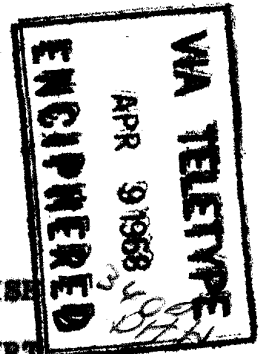
