The above listed elimination prints are to be used in connection with the fingerprint examination previously conducted on documents received from BTNB pertaining to the safe deposit box rented in the name of GALT, as it was determined that all the above listed employees had at one time or another handled these documents.

The box of Norma cartridges, cal. .243 Winchester, was furnished by DON WOOD subsequent to his original interview. Mr. WOOD stated he located this box of ammunition lying on some other supplies, some ten or fifteen feet from the ammunition storage bins and it is possible that this box of ammunition is the box of ammunition that was originally given to customer using name HARVEY LOWMEYER when he purchased ammunition and the Remington model 700 cal. .243 Winchester on 3/29/68.

The Bureau is requested to examine the box and the cartridges for latent fingerprints. Elimination prints have been previously furnished the Bureau of U. L. BAKER and DON WOOD, who also handled this box.

The same examination is requested of the Remington Model 760 rifle box, it being noted that DON WOOD located this box in the garbage subsequent to his original interview. This box was in the rear of Aero Marine Supply Company and had been open to the rain. This box is the container of the second gun obtained by subject, the model 760 Remington, 30-06 cal., ser. #461476. This box may have been handled by subject, although it never left the Aero Marine Supply Company.

According to Harzenstein, SA King is unable to recall any other identifying information concerning the individual.

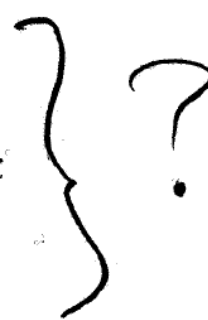

Mr. HERBERT BRADFORD, 2722 Stanton Road, S. E., Washington, D. C., on 4/11/68, advised that he had been to Atlanta, Georgia, to attend the funeral of Reverend MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. He arrived at about 9:00 p.m., on 4/8/68, and he stayed at the Holiday Inn, at the airport in Atlanta. Between 10:00 p.m., and midnight on 4/8/68, he saw an individual on the road who was wearing a red beard (not heavy) and his hair partially covered his forehead. He said this man was driving a foreign-make car, light blue, and it did not bear Georgia license plates. He thought the car might be a SAAB but he could not be sure. Subsequently, he saw a picture in the newspapers of the man being sought, and he recalled the man he had seen in Atlanta strongly resembled the suspect.

On 4/12/68, BRADFORD again called WFO and advised that he wished to correct information furnished on 4/11/68. He stated the correct make of the car he had observed in Atlanta was a 1960-61 blue or Alcapulco blue SAAB or similar form of car. The license plates were blue numbers on a white background, state unknown. He felt the individual he had seen strongly resembled the composite drawing of the suspected killer.
