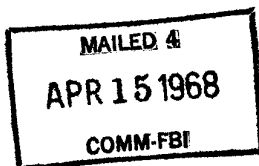

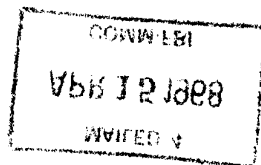

On April 10, 1968, Private John A. Horstkamp, Precinct 12, Metropolitan Police Department, Washington, D. C., advised Special Agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation that at 6:55 a.m. on April 10, 1968, he and Private Paul R. Jones responded to a report that a citizen was loading rifles into an automobile at 3204 22nd Street, N.E., Washington, D. C.

Officer Horstkamp said that, upon arrival, they noticed a blue Pontiac, Maryland license tags DZ 5648, being backed out of the alley near 3204 22nd Street, N.E. Officer Horstkamp stated they halted the vehicle and, after initiating a search, found two shotguns and two rifles in the car's trunk. The driver of the car, Robert Shirley Howerton, white male, 55 years of age, 4920 Taylor Road, Edmonston, Maryland, told the officers he recently returned from a hunting trip and rather than risk having his guns confiscated by authorities during a search of his car at a checkpoint while en route from the District of Columbia to his Maryland home, he had left the guns overnight with a friend who lives at 3204 22nd Street, N.E. He said he had just picked up the guns when the officers arrived.

Officer Horstkamp stated that they confiscated the guns for police disposition in view of the civil disorder which has existed in the District of Columbia the past several days. In addition, he said that although not charged, Howerton will be summoned to appear at a hearing on the matter before the United States Attorney, District of Columbia, on May 16, 1968, due to the restriction on firearms during an emergency situation.
