LATENT PRINT EXAMINATION

Late Friday (4/12/68), a letter to Galt from "receiver of apartment" occupied by Galt and the letter with accompanying envelope used by Galt in answering were received from Los Angeles. Three latent fingerprints were developed on the letter to Galt, nothing of value on other items.

Also received 4/12/68, from Chicago were ten paper items of correspondence between Galt and the Superior Bulk Film Co. of Chicago. One latent fingerprint was developed on one of these items.

These four latent fingerprints have been compared with latent prints previously reported in this case, but no identification effected. *2*

On 4/13/68, an "Enrollment Form" and "Confidential Form" from Locksmithing Institute, Little Falls, New Jersey, in name of Eric S. Galt were received for examination. No latent prints were developed on these items. *Tony*

There are presently twenty-six latent fingerprints and seven latent palm prints remaining unidentified in this case.

SUBJECT: MURKIN

In investigating the assassination of Martin Luther King, Jr., the field has developed a good suspect who has been using the name Eric Starvo Galt. Galt registered at a motel in Memphis, Tennessee, on the afternoon of 4/3/68 and departed on 4/4/68. Galt was driving a 1966 white Mustang with Alabama tag 1-38993. The registration at the motel and the registration for the car indicate Galt's address to be 2608 Highland Avenue, Birmingham, Alabama. The investigation has disclosed that a person using the name Galt resided at that address for a three month period from approximately 9/1/67 to 12/1/67. Efforts to further identify Galt have been fruitless.

RECOMMENDATION:

Recommended that the attached teletype be directed to all offices instructing those covering points of exit to check to determine if Galt has departed from the country, and further instructing all offices to advise local police that Galt is wanted for questioning by the FBI. The offices are being cautioned that they are not to disclose the nature of the case for which Galt is wanted.

She advised that her husband is working in Waycross presently, but each Monday gets a list of house repairs from Mr. SPENCE and tackles them as he gets to them so that he may be at any part of town.

On 4/10/68, EARL SPENCE, 905 Jane Street, advised that his payroll records reflect that JACOB V. BOATRIGHT was employed and on the job for him in Waycross for the entire period of 4/1-5/68, inclusive.

Note is made of the fact that Mrs. BOATRIGHT advised that they have five daughters and that their only son was killed in 1945 in an accident.

In view of the fact that the presence of JACOB V. BOATRIGHT in Waycross at pertinent time established through payroll records, without divulging nature of investigation, he is not being interviewed.
