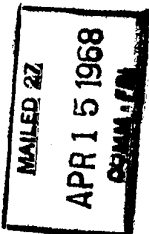

**NOTE: Printed laundry markings appear on pair of men's shorts
and a T-shirt recovered from a blue bag believed to have been
abandoned by suspect in Memphis. It has been determined these markings
were made by a machine manufactured by Textile Marking Company,
Syracuse, New York. The field is making widespread inquiry of laundries
utilizing this type of equipment and has submitted numerous samples for
comparison with the questioned markings. To date only the samples
submitted by Los Angeles have any likelihood of having had a common
origin.**

On 4/14/68, at approximately 7:30 P.M., CHARLES RUNFORD telephonically advised WFO that he was calling from St. Elizabeth Hospital, WDC (a mental institute). He stated he had resided at 1926½ 7th Avenue, North, St. Petersburg, Florida. Sometime last week, he called the FBI in St. Petersburg, Florida, and had been interviewed by SA CHARLES HUGHES and another agent concerning information he desired to furnish regarding JAMES A. POUNCEY, 216 S. Albany Avenue, Apartment 7, Tampa, Florida. He said that he had heard POUNCEY speak of the assassination of Dr. KING approximately three weeks prior to the assassination. He said that agents had attempted to locate POUNCEY at the above address with negative results.

RUNFORD advised he subsequently came to WDC and attempted to take some flowers to President JOHNSON, but was denied entry to the White House by the Secret Service, even though he had offered to wait as long as necessary to see President JOHNSON. He said he
