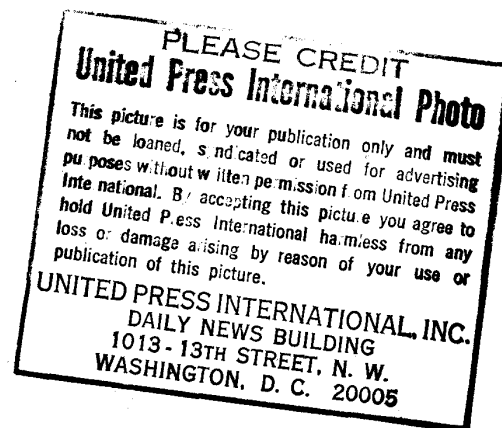

Grant Dillman, Assistant Bureau Chief, United Press International, Washington, D. C., called me on the afternoon of 4/12/68. He stated that his New York Office had collected a large number of still pictures of persons passing in front of the coffin of Martin Luther King when the body was on display on 4/6/68. He said their New York Office has advised him that the photograph of one individual passing the coffin bears a remarkable resemblance to an artist's conception of the subject which was prepared by the Mexico City police artist Sergio Yaubert, which artist's conception has been carried in many newspapers in the country.

Dillman advised that he had made arrangements for a copy of this photograph to be delivered to UPI, Washington, via Speedphoto and he would be happy to make a copy of it available to me as soon as received. Upon subsequent notification, I had an Agent from the Washington Field Office pick up the photograph from George Gaylin of UPI Photos, Washington, D. C.

A copy of the photograph is attached. Also attached is a copy of the above-mentioned artist's conception made by the Mexican police artist. It will be noted that there appears to be a remarkable similarity between the two. It is also noted, however, that the artist's conception made by the Mexican artist bears little or no resemblance to the artist's conception prepared by our Exhibits Section.

It is also noted that Dillman has advised me that UPI has no idea whatsoever of the identity or location of the individual depicted in the attached photograph.

MURDER OF MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.

SEE NOTE ON REVERSE SIDE

Laboratory examination of the bullet removed from the body of Martin Luther King, Jr., has established that it is a .30 caliber metal jacketed soft point sporting type bullet of Remington-Peters manufacture. This bullet could have been fired from the rifle found on April 4, 1968, near the scene of the shooting by Guy Warren Canipe, Sr. Due to mutilation of the bullet, it cannot be stated that it was actually fired from this particular rifle.

It has been determined that the rifle was obtained in Birmingham, Alabama, on March 30, 1968. Employees of Aero Marine Supply Company in Birmingham have advised that an individual using the name of Harvey Lowmeyer purchased a caliber 243 W Remington rifle on March 29, 1968. He had a Redfield scope mounted on the rifle at this time. Lowmeyer indicated he planned to go to Wisconsin to hunt. The following day, March 30, 1968, Lowmeyer returned the rifle to the store and exchanged it for a Remington 760 Model .30-06 caliber. The scope was then mounted on the second rifle by the store. It appears that the name Lowmeyer is fictitious, as is the address given by him.

Extensive efforts are being made to identify the person who purchased the rifle.

The binoculars, which were in the zipper bag found by Canipe, were purchased during the afternoon of April 4, 1968, at York Arms, 162 South Main Street, Memphis, Tennessee.

The full investigation is continuing and every effort is being made to identify the individual or individuals responsible for this murder.

I am advised also that the Memphis Police Department is utilizing its full facilities to solve this crime.

Enclosed for the Latent Fingerprint Section are the major case prints of RONALD BARDIN SIMPSON, WMA, born [redacted] at Halifax County, N. C., who was arrested by the Jennings, La., SO on 4/6/68 on vagrancy charges. SIMPSON is 6 feet, 150 pounds, and states he was arrested in 1966 in Tampa, Fla., for disturbing the peace. He advises he received 1967 Christmas leave, at which time he headed to the West Coast. While he states he was probably hitchhiking from Texas to Louisiana on Thursday, 4/4/68, he is vague concerning his location and SIMPSON is obviously in need of mental care. However, SIMPSON is similar in facial appearance to the artist's sketch of the UNSUB drawn by Memphis artist BILL HARRINGTON and carried in the Beaumont, Texas, Enterprise morning newspaper of 4/6/68.

The Latent Fingerprint Section is requested to compare the major case prints of SIMPSON with those reportedly found on the rifle or other latents submitted by the Memphis Division and advise interested offices as to findings.
