VAN HOLDE, Professor, Biophysics, Oregon State University, who advised that while a passenger on a commuter bus en route from Palo Alto, California, to San Francisco, California, on April 10, 1968, he noticed another passenger who appeared similar to the detailed drawing of the Unknown Subject which appeared in the newspapers.

CLARENCE HUTCHINSON, 227 St. Charles Avenue, San Francisco, California, telephone number WY 2-3478, advised that he was the driver of the Greyhound bus departing Palo Alto, California, at 9:45 a.m., April 10, 1968, which is the only transportation company furnishing commuter service between Palo Alto and San Francisco. HUTCHINSON stated that he, too, had observed a detailed drawing of the Unknown Subject in this case appearing in the newspapers, but that none of the passengers on this trip that he noted in any way resembled the drawing of the Unknown Subject which appeared in the newspapers. He stated that he did not know the identity of any passengers on this trip.

ASSASSINATION OF MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.
CIVIL RIGHTS

On 4/7/68, at approximately 1:50 p.m., Agent WILLIAM STUCKEY, Secret Service, White House, telephonically advised SA JIMMIE E. HURD that a collect call had come to the White House from Lansing, Michigan. STUCKEY advised they at first declined the collect call until the operator indicated it had to do with the assassination of KING. Call accepted and a male individual stated he knew who killed KING and immediately hung up.

Agent STUCKEY advised they traced the call through Lansing operator # 105 and determined it came from a pay phone # 337-9034 located in a Burger King near the University of Michigan with address Grand River and Stoddard.

DE conduct investigation at Lansing in attempt to identify caller and information in his possession if he is identified.

ASSASSINATION OF REV. MARTIN LUTHER KING
APRIL 4, 1968

The following information originated with the Criminal Police in Utrecht, Netherlands and was passed to us today through the Security Officer of the American Embassy in The Hague, Netherlands.

On April 8, 1968, a Dutch citizen, FREDERIK JOHANNES KOEK, residing in Ijsselstein, The Netherlands, reported to the Utrecht District Office of the Dutch Federal Police the following:

On April 6, 1968, KOEK viewed a Dutch television program dealing with the Rev. KING's assassination. Part of the program were scenes, apparently from television clips or from movie film, of a meeting addressed by Rev. KING on the evening prior to the assassination. The film showed scenes of the audience, which were seated and apparently indoors. Shortly thereafter, KOEK noted in the April 6, 1968 edition of the Dutch newspaper "Het Parool" the artist's drawing of the suspected assassin. He felt there was a strong resemblance between that drawing and a man he had noted in the audience on the TV program. The Dutch Police obtained the TV clip and made enlargements of two views of the audience, including the man in question and two enlarged views of the man himself.

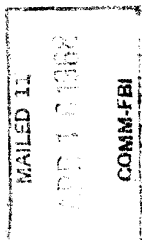

IN HIS SPEECH TO THE DINNER AUDIENCE, CLARK SAID THE CURRENT "ANXIETIES" OF AMERICA MUST BE VIEWED IN THE PERSPECTIVE THAT OTHER TIMES AND OTHER COUNTRIES HAVE BEEN EVEN MORE TROUBLED.

"THE POLICEMAN IN THE U.S. THIS YEAR IS THE MOST IMPORTANT MAN WE HAVE...ON HIS COOLNESS, ON HIS INTELLIGENCE...RESTS THE ONLY OPPORTUNITY WE HAVE" FOR AVERTING DISRUPTIVE VIOLENCE WHILE WORKING FOR PROGRESS, HE SAID.

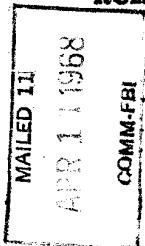

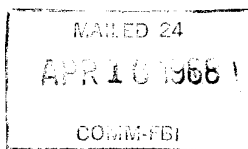
