MONTGOMERY, ALABAMA, WILLIAM POTTER GALE, ONE EIGHT FOUR ZERO WEST AVENUE, LANCASTER, CALIFORNIA, AND DR. WESLEY A. SWIFT OF LANCASTER, CALIFORNIA. BARNES DESCRIBED "JEFF" CARDEN AS A REAL GOOD MAN WHO WOULD "GO ANYWHERE AND DO A GOOD JOB". REPORTEDLY IN LATE NINETEEN SIXTYTHREE, GALE, CARDEN, AND "OTHERS" WENT TO BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA, WITH LOADED GUNS AND THE PURPOSE WAS "TO GET MARTIN LUTHER KING^{II}".

MOBILE REPORT DATED JUNE TWENTYFIVE, NINETEEN SIXTYFOUR, CAPTIONED "NOAH JEFFERSON CARDEN, RM^{II}", SHOWS HIS RESIDENCE AS SIX FIVE TWO JOHNSTON STREET, MOBILE, ALABAMA. BARNES REPORTED RESIDED ONE THREE SEVEN NINE EAST RIVIERA DRIVE, MOBILE, ALABAMA, AS OF JULY, NINETEEN SIXTYFOUR.

FOR INFORMATION, MIAMI REPORT DATED JUNE FIFTEEN, NINETEEN SIXTYFOUR, CAPTIONED "UNSUBS; BOMBING OF SIXTEENTH STREET BAPTIST CHURCH, BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA, SEPTEMBER FIFTEEN, NINETEEN SIXTYTHREE, BOMBING MATTER", ON PAGE EIGHT REFLECTS THAT PRIOR TO INTEGRATION AT THE UNIVERSITY OF ALABAMA, TUSCALOOSA, ALABAMA, WILLIAM POTTER GALE MET WITH GOVERNOR GEORGE WALLACCE AT MONTGOMERY, ALABAMA. GALE PROPOSED A PLAN TO STOOP INTEGRATION IN ALABAMA, SAYING HE COULD PUT FIFTY THOUSAND ARMED MEN IN ALABAMA. GOVERNOR WALLACE REJECTED THIS

PLAN, TELLING GALE THAT HE HAD ONE OF HIS OWN. ACCORDING TO BARNES, GOVERNOR WALLACE AND FORMER PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY AGREED⁰ TO A PLAN FOR INTEGRATION AT THE UNIVERSITY DURING PRESIDENT KENNEDY'S VISIT TO ALABAMA, AT WHICH TIME PRESIDENT KENNEDY AND GOVERNOR WALLACE WERE TOGETHER IN A HELICOPTER. BARNES DID NOT FURTHER ELABORATE ON HOW HE OBTAINED THIS INFORMATION.

BARNES SAID THAT PRIOR TO THE SEPTEMBER FIFTEEN CHURCH BOMBING IN BIRMINGHAM, A SECRET MEETING WAS HELD IN ALABAMA, LOCATION NOT SPECIFIED. ATTENDING THIS MEETING WERE WILLIAM POTTER GALE, "JEFF" CARDEN, ADMIRAL JOHN G. CROMMELIN FROM WETUMPKA, ALABAMA, AND BARNES. THE ALLEGED PURPOSE OF THIS MEETING WAS TO MAKE PLANS FOR THINGS TO BE DONE. BARNES DID NOT FURTHER ELABORATE ON THIS REMARK. BARNES SAID HE AGREED WITH THE PLAN BUT THAT HE (BARNES) DID NOT PARTICIPATE IN THE CHURCH BOMBING. HE STATED THAT GALE AND CARDEN WERE INVOLVED, BUT AGAIN DID NOT ELABORATE AS TO THE EXTENT OF THEIR INVOLVEMENT.

BARNES STATED THAT HE WAS "HOT" IN ALABAMA AND HAD TO LEAVE. HE ALSO STATED THAT AFTER THE SECRET MEETING, CROMMELIN TOLD HIM HE PREFERRED BARNES FOR ANY ACTION OVER CARDEN DUE TO THE FACT THAT CARDEN LIKES TO TALK AND DRINKS EXCESSIVELY.
