GONZALES STATED HE AND GALT GRADUATED FROM BARTENDING SCHOOL ON SAME DATE AND HE HAS NOT SEEN GATLT SINCE. GALT NEVER MENTIONED ANY OTHER TYPE EMPLOYMENT OR MEMBERS OF HIS FAMILY, BUT DID IMPLY HAD BEEN MARRIED ONCE THOUGH NOT PRESENTLY MARRIED. ACCORDING TO GONZALES, GALT WAS QUITE SLOW IN MASTERING BARTENDING SCHOOL CURRICULUM. HE DESPLAYED A NERVOUSNESS WHILE ATTENDING THIS SCHOOL. 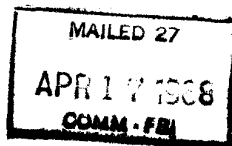

At 8:55 p. m. , SAC Wesley Grapp, Los Angeles, advised that in connection with this case, Los Angeles Agents had developed Jerome Wallis Vernon, FBI # 743 226 B, as a suspect. Vernon was employed until 3-24-68, as manager of the Home Service and Dry Cleaning establishment, 5280 Hollywood Boulevard, Los Angeles, and since 3-24-68, has not been heard from. This establishment is located approximately five blocks away from the store where the 12 pair of pliers were purchased, including the pliers under investigation this matter. Los Angeles is sending in 24 laundry marks which they have obtained from the old machine in the establishment managed by Vernon. The laundry marks appear to have the same cut, slant, and "imperfection" as the one under investigation in captioned case.

SAC Grapp advised that Vernon was previously the subject of a deserter under investigation, and in 1953, allegedly surrendered as a deserter in Birmingham, Alabama. He also advised that the Home Service and Dry Cleaning establishment is actually owned by Maurice Warren Howard, who is the subject of Bureau file 100-342602 and who is on the Communist Reserve Index. Howard has been uncooperative during previous attempted interviews.

Los Angeles will advise as soon as laundry marks are placed on airplane for forwarding to FBI Laboratory, and WFO will be informed to meet plane and immediately transport to Laboratory.

SAC Gamble, Birmingham, was advised of the above information and instructed to determine from indices if previous investigation conducted concerning Vernon in Birmingham and to run out investigation this matter.

Latent Fingerprint Examiner Crotts advised that a check of the latents in this case against the prints of Vernon showed that they were not identical. Ident records show 1965 photo of Vernon and Crotts advised he would immediately forward copies of this photo to Memphis and Birmingham.

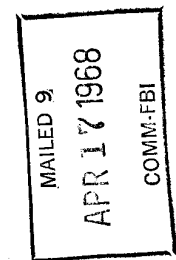
