are hairs or fibers that may be suitable for comparison with other material submitted by the Memphis Division.

In addition, of possible interest are the two black leather straps submitted herewith. Possibility exists that they may have connection with binoculars submitted and/or rifle in instant case. The Laboratory should examine binoculars, binocular case, and/or rifles to see whether or not possibility exists markings may help associate these items.

In addition, the necessary examination for latent prints should be made on both leather belts.

Memphis does not know at this time whether in examination of automobile conducted by Atlanta any grassy materials recovered. In the event such was submitted, the grass submitted by Memphis should be compared if such is possible.

Markings on material submitted disclosed the initials "ELH" which represent those of E. LARRY HUTCHINSON, Investigator, Attorney General's Office, Shelby County, Memphis, Tennessee. The other initials "OVJ" are those of the Agent receiving the material from E. LARRY HUTCHINSON. In one instance, the striped towel was received by SA CYRIL F. BUSCH from Inspector N. E. ZACHARY, Memphis PD.

The plastic red, white, and blue decorative pin was located by Lt. GLENN KING, Memphis PD, and turned over to Special Agents.

All the above evidence should be returned to the Memphis Division upon completion of the requested examinations.


