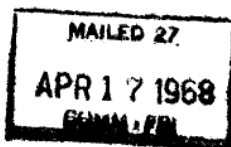

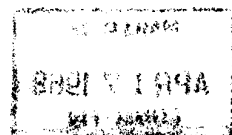

Sirs:

About the murder of Martin Luther King, it was NOT a white man (person). It was a colored person who is now hiding out at Hall of Motels in Memphis, Tenn. on Fealder Street. He is about 30 years old, 5' 9" tall and weighs about 160 lbs. He is armed and dangerous.

This is the message phoned to me at my office, and said I had been selected in some way as being trustworthy to deliver this message. The person is afraid for personal safety if this is not delivered secretly; the said person claimed not to be a crackpot, but very religious and conscientious, and felt it must be told. I have never taken part in any kind of disturbance anywhere, and have lived too long a sober-minded, minding-own-business person to start trouble for any person, group, or our country. The person felt conflict would continue until this person is caught, especially if the colored feel a white person was responsible.

I don't like to be secretive, and have never been so until now. Yet, I'm afraid for the first time in my life--of the negroes and the Communists. And my home and business would be hindered if I had to be protected by the police. I hate not to sign any letter, but cannot this one.

One to keep my word, and one
interested in peace and justice.

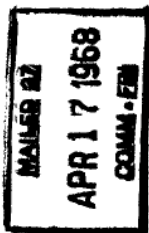

Enclosed for Memphis and Birmingham two copies each of photographs of JOHN ALAN FEDUCCIA.

On 4/15/68, ALFONSO GUARDIA MORA, PSI (protect identity, reliable in the past) advised SA JAMES F. PRICE that one JOHN ALAN FEDUCCIA applied for a Costa Rican visa on 4/11/68. Upon reviewing FEDUCCIA's visa application and U.S. Passport photo GUARDIA felt there was a strong resemblance between FEDUCCIA's photo and the composite drawing of the unknown male wanted for the murder of Reverend MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. GUARDIA advised that FEDUCCIA had not applied at the Costa Rican Embassy with his visa application, but had sent his application by messenger. GUARDIA indicated FEDUCCIA held U.S. Passport [REDACTED] Costa Rican visa number 070 was issued to FEDUCCIA on 4/11/68. His application reflected that he had been issued Guatemalan visa number 603, on 4/9/68.

GUARDIA further advised that FEDUCCIA's application was accompanied by a visa application for CHARLES FREDERIC WALKER, U.S. Passport Number [REDACTED]. Both FEDUCCIA and WALKER were connected with the University of Michigan.

On 4/16/68, SE ROBERT P. LYNCH reviewed records of the Passport Office, United States Department of State (USDS), which revealed that JOHN ALAN FEDUCCIA, born [REDACTED], at Mobile, Alabama, was issued Passport Number [REDACTED] at WDC on 3/22/68. This passport was valid for three years travel to all countries except Cuba, mainland China, North Korea and North Vietnam. In application dated 3/14/68, FEDUCCIA furnished his permanent residence as Museum of Zoology, University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, Michigan 48104. His parents were listed as JOSEPH CHARLES FEDUCCIA, born Baltimore, Maryland, [REDACTED], and MARY EMILY GARRAWAY, born Laurel, Mississippi, [REDACTED]. Person to be notified in event of death or accident was listed as his father at Pearman Avenue, Cleveland, Mississippi. It was indicated that FEDUCCIA planned to travel to Mexico, Guatemala, El Salvador, Honduras, Costa Rica and Nicaragua for scientific research, departing New Orleans in April, 1968, for four months stay.

FEDUCCIA was described as five feet eleven inches tall, brown hair, brown eyes, student and never married.

FEDUCCIA had previously been issued Passport Number [REDACTED] on 7/26/62, at WDC for proposed travel to Honduras for purpose of "scientific expedition for L.S.U." His permanent address at that time was Memorial Drive, Cleveland, Mississippi.

On 4/16/68, SE LYNCH reviewed the files of the Passport Office, USDS concerning CHARLES FREDERIC WALKER, born [REDACTED], at Columbus, Ohio, was issued passport number F288378 on 4/10/65, at WDC. Passport application dated 4/6/65, at Ann Arbor, Michigan, indicates his permanent address as 1261 Island Drive, Ann Arbor, Michigan and his mailing address as Museums Building, University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, Michigan. His parents were listed as FREDERICK

WFO 44-703

CHARLES WALKER, born [REDACTED], at Dresden, Ohio, and MARY LYMAN HARRINGTON, born [REDACTED], at Columbus, Ohio. He was described as five feet ten inches tall, gray/brown hair, gray eyes, never married and a professor.

The above passport was renewed on 3/21/68, making it valid until 4/9/69.

Moss L. Innes, Legat Ottawa, telephonically furnished the following information. The room clerk who formerly worked at 2589 Rue Notre Dame Est, Montreal, Canada, Province of Quebec, has been located in Windsor, Ontario. His name is Quintel. He recalls Eric Galt and states he can identify him. He indicates that drawings appearing recently in the Canadian press do not look like Galt. (U) (S) (X)

He stated he did not have any explanation as to why the name was written on the back of the ledger but he believes that such a notation was made by Galt himself. As Quintel recalls Galt lived in Apartment 18 for about one and one-half months during 1967. Quintel believed that this was probably August and September but he could be mistaken. He was under the impression that Galt had worked at Expo 67 (this is why he thought it was during August and September that Galt was there as the Expo closed in September of 1967). When he left Galt stated that he was returning to the United States to care for some sick relatives. (U) (S) (X)

Quintel indicated that Galt, upon arriving at the apartment, had asked about parking facilities and was quite irritated when he was advised that parking facilities were available but there would be an additional charge of \$20 a month. Quintel thought that Galt had been referred to an Esso service station nearby which had parking facilities. He further advised that Galt had bought a suit of clothes from the Tip Top Shop. He stated that Galt was a quiet man and had only two visitors that he could recall, both of them "elderly women" about 40 to 42 years old. (U) (S) (X)

Innes advised that they are reviewing the records again at the apartment in Montreal to try to obtain further information concerning Galt. In the event Galt did work at Expo 67 it would have been necessary for him to be photographed to obtain an identification card and it would have been necessary for him to have a work permit if he were an American citizen. These are being checked. (U) (S) (X)
