LATENTS ON THREE ITEMS IN MURKIN CASE IDENTIFIED WITH EACH OTHER

Identification Division, Latent Fingerprint Section, has now identified a latent fingerprint on a map, described below, submitted by the Atlanta Office with a latent fingerprint previously developed on Remington Model 760 rifle, Q2, abandoned by Unsub. at the scene of the crime, which latent was previously identified with a latent print on the pair of binoculars, Q14, also abandoned by Unsub. at the scene of the crime. In other words, three latent fingerprints from three different objects have been identified with each other.

The Atlanta Office, by letter 4/15/68, submitted numerous items, including a map of Mexico, Q194, for examination. These items were located in storage room of the rooming house at 113 14th Street in Atlanta, Georgia, where suspect Eric Starvo Galt had formerly resided. *e*

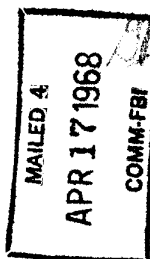

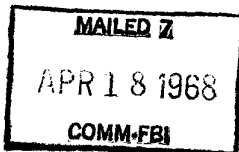

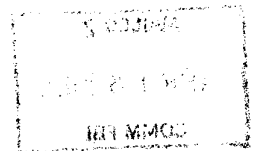

Do racial Maddogs become moderates overnight -- say, upon election to office -- or do their true feelings simply go underground to be capped by a lid of expediency? Even in the South, it is now neither "nice" nor "intellectual" to be rabidly segregationist, an overall attitude which forces politicians to a posture of uneasy fence-sitting.

It is scarcely in my province to instruct you on the conduct of your business -- but a word of caution might be in order regarding the routine fingerprint and whereabouts check you will no doubt make: wisdom dictates that you not contact, directly or initially, the Chief Marshal in the Atlanta-Fulton County office.

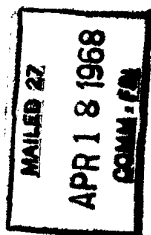

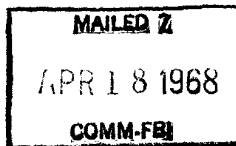

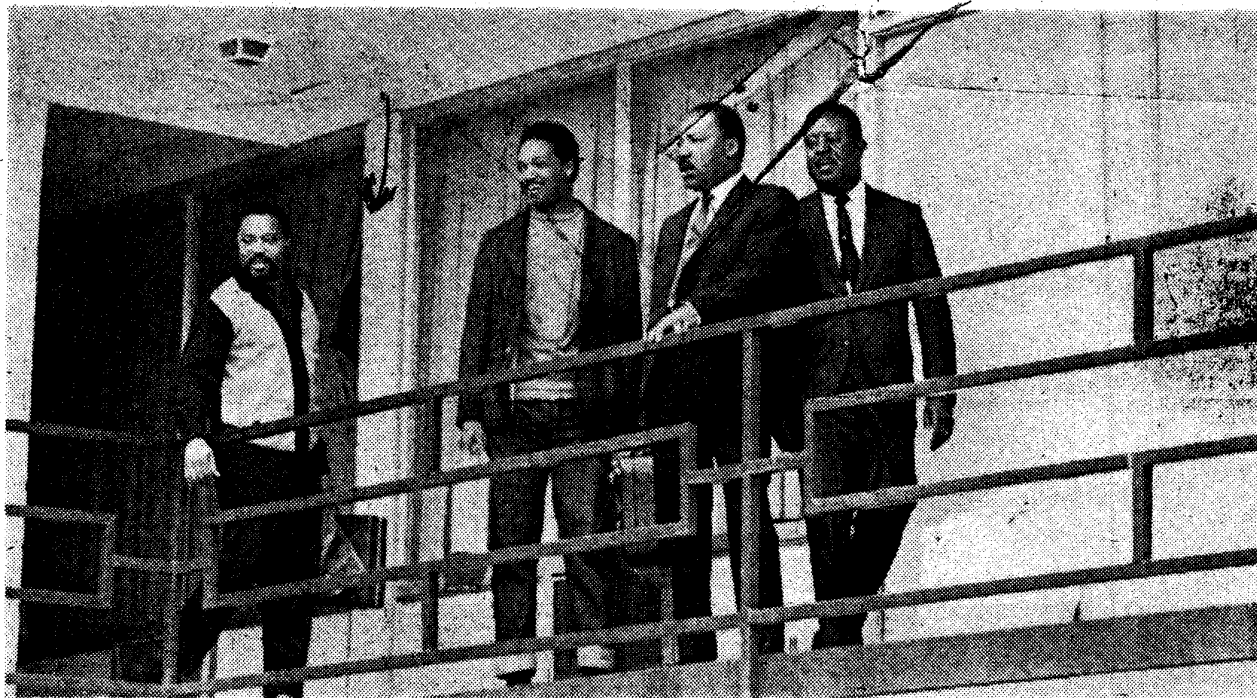
