LATENTS ON THREE ITEMS IN MURKIN CASE IDENTIFIED WITH EACH OTHER

Identification Division, Latent Fingerprint Section, has now identified a latent fingerprint on a map, described below, submitted by the Atlanta Office with a latent fingerprint previously developed on Remington Model 760 rifle, Q2, abandoned by Unsub. at the scene of the crime, which latent was previously identified with a latent print on the pair of binoculars, Q14, also abandoned by Unsub. at the scene of the crime. In other words, three latent fingerprints from three different objects have been identified with each other.

The Atlanta Office, by letter 4/15/68, submitted numerous items, including a map of Mexico, Q194, for examination. These items were located in storage room of the rooming house at 113 14th Street in Atlanta, Georgia, where suspect Eric Starvo calt had formerly resided.

General Investigative Division has been advised and is taking appropriate action.

Re: The Murder of Dr. King

Dear Sir:

The following information was given today to the New York branch of the FBI via telephone, but I cannot know whether or not they acted upon it.

It is urgently requested that you investigate a 34-year old male, by name of:

CLAUDE ALBERT (AL) CASS,

living and working in Atlanta, Ga. He has been employed as a marshal of the City-County Civil Court in Atlanta. Descriptions tally -- when they agree -- down to the "hot rot grin," as one Negro schoolboy expressed it. You realize the above-named project was, in all likelihood, conducted by a person or persons with 1) access to abandoned, impounded motor vehicles (the probable source of the white Mustang, registered in Galt's name), and 2) knowledge and possession of shortwave equipment similar to that of the police force.

In the deviousness of Southern politics, an out-of-the-area disposal of an annoying citizen through the instrumentality of a "clean" (i.e., no record) sub-sub-lieutenant is not altogether unheard of. Do racial Maddogs become moderates overnight -- say, upon election to office -- or do their true feelings simply go underground to be capped by a lid of expediency? Even in the South, it is now neither "nice" nor "intellectual" to be rabidly segregationist, an overall attitude which it forces politicians to a posture of uneasy fence-sitting.

It is scarcely in my province to instruct you on the conduct of your business -- but a word of caution might be in order regarding the routine fingerprint and whereabouts check you will no doubt make: wisdom dictates that you not contact, directly or initially, the Chief Marshal in the Atlanta-Fulton County office.

In the interests of apprehending the killer and helping put an end to the rioting in our cities, I am




