



Result of examination:

It was concluded that the "Eric S. Galt" and the "Eric Galt" signatures on Q216 through Q221, Q223 and Q224 were prepared by the writer of the signatures in this name appearing on specimens previously received. The signatures on Q222 are too distorted for identification with these previous signatures but similarities were noted.

Because of the lack of comparable writings and variations, it could not be determined whether the other writings appearing on Q216 through Q224 were prepared by the writer of the available writings which are attributable to Galt, however, similarities were noted between the payee names on money orders and the "Galt" writings.

Because of the lack of comparable letters and letter combinations necessary for an adequate comparison, it could not be determined whether the "Harvey Lowmyer" signature on the Q72 gun invoice was prepared by the writer of the money orders, Q216 through Q224, and other writings attributed to Galt.

It was concluded that the questioned signatures on Q225 and Q226 were prepared by the writer of the "Galt" signatures on other specimens previously submitted.

The typewritten impressions appearing on Q225 are the same style as those appearing on other items believed emanating from Galt, but the lack of identifying defects precludes a determination that the same typewriter was used to prepared all of these items.

The submitted specimens are temporarily retained. Photographs were made.

and SPOERL on 4/4/68, were in Philadelphia, Mississippi for a meeting with the Management Officers of the Philadelphia, Mississippi plant of U.S. Electrical Motors.

He further advised he and SPOERL departed Philadelphia 4/4/68, at approximately 4 p.m. and drove to Memphis, Tenn. by car, arriving approximately 7:10 p.m. He stated that the car in which they were riding was a 1967 Dodge, white in color, and rented by SPOERL at the Avis Rent-A=Car in Memphis, Tenn., on 4/1/68.

On the latter date SPOERL was in the process of establishing a site for a warehouse in Memphis. After that date, he and SPOERL met in Jackson, Mississippi, on 4/3/68, for the meeting in Philadelphia described above.

When he and SPOERL arrived in Memphis on 4/4/68, they learned of the situation re captioned matter. From Memphis, HOEHING was to take a plane to St. Louis after he and SPOERL had dinner. SPOERL was to stay over night at the Holiday Inn, South, Memphis, for a meeting 4/5/68 re the establishment of a warehouse.

After learning of the situation, SPOERL decided that the meeting on 4/5/68 could not be arranged and attempted to obtain an airplane ticket to New York or Hartford, Conn. Unable to do this, he decided to join HOEHING on the plane for St. Louis, who's ultimate destination was Chicago, Illinois.

He further advised that he did not think SPOERL could be involved in captioned matter and hadn't made out-of-the-way comments re same. He stated that he and SPOERL were together all of the time spent in Memphis except for approximately 10 or 15 minutes when SPOERL was still trying to keep the appointment on 4/5/68. This separation was about 9:30 p.m. He was re-joined by SPOERL and the plane left at approximately 10 p.m., 4/4/68, for Chicago. No further investigation being conducted re SPOERL by New Haven as it does not appear he is identical with suspects in captioned matter.

Set forth below are current developments concerning the murder of Martin Luther King, Jr.

The Laboratory has determined that various fibers found on a bedspread recovered with the rifle believed to be the murder weapon and fibers found on a sheet recovered from Galt's automobile indicate that the two items have been in physical contact. This indicates that Galt's automobile is involved in the murder.

The most intensive investigation is being pushed by all offices to locate Galt and to develop his background. Highlights of current developments are set out below.

Birmingham determined from an exhaustive search of post office records that an insured package from Chicago had been delivered to Galt's rooming house 10/4/67. This has been traced to Superior Bulk Film Company, Chicago. Company records show that in September, 1967, Galt ordered a Kodak Dual Projector, a Kodak Super 8 Camera and accessories at a total cost of \$337, 27, Airmail shipment was made to Galt's Birmingham rooming house 10/3/67. By letter of 10/5/67, Galt returned the camera, said he was going to Mexico on Saturday and would advise later as to where his refund should be sent. By letter dated 10/22/67, he requested the refund be sent to Puerto Vallarta, Jalisco, Mexico, Hotel Rio, Capartado No. 23. A refund check in the amount of \$142.89 was mailed to the Mexican laddress 11/10/67. By letter of 11/20/67, with a return address of APR

1535 North Serrano, Los Angeles, Galt requested his refund be sent to that address and was advised the check had previously been mailed to the Mexican address. Company and bank records are being checked for method of payment to the company by Galt and for the refund check.

Galt's automobile has a Mexican tourist sticker showing he entered Mexico at Nuevo Laredo 10/7/67. Investigation is being conducted in Mexico to determine his activities.

Galt has previously been placed at 1535 North Serrano in November and December, 1967, and the early part of January, 1968.

Galt has now been placed at the St. Francis Hotel,
Los Angeles, where he rented a room for \$88 a month from 1/21/68 to
3/17/68 when he checked out requesting his mail be forwarded to
General Delivery, Atlanta, until 4/25/68. He gave no instructions as
to where his mail should be sent after that date. On 2/1/68, Galt gave
the St. Francis Hotel, in partial payment of rent, local telephone
company check for \$28.65 payable to Eric Galt. This is being traced.

The Atlanta Post Office is holding two letters for Galt forwarded from Los Angeles. One is a gas bill originally sent to 1535 North Serrano; the other is a flat book from Locksmith Lodger, Little Falls, New Jersey, also originally sent to the Serrano address.

Records of the Locksmithing Institute, Little Falls, New Jersey, show that Eric S. Galt, 2589 Rue Notre Dame Est. Montreal, Canada, enrolled in a correspondence locksmithing course, 7/31/67. In an undated statement, probably submitted in January, 1968, Galt showed the Serrano address in Los Angeles, stated he had received ordnance training in military service, was 36 years of age, single, and had a high school education. Under "name of employer" was entered "Am taking course at American Business Consultants, 16010 Crenshaw, Long Beach, California." References were shown on the form as Mrs. Rita Steen, Housewife, 5666 Franklin, Los Angeles, and Mrs. Marie Deninno, Waitress, 5533 Hollywood, Los Angeles. The form contains a printed certification that the student has never been

convicted of burglary, breaking and entering, robbery or larceny and that information received from Locksmithing Institute will not be used to aid or abet the commission of a crime.

On 3/30/68, the locksmith school changed Galt's address to 113 14th. Street, N. E., Atlanta, Georgia. The cost of the course was \$229.50. \$17.50 was paid 7/31/67, \$7.50 was paid 9/7/67, \$15.00 was paid 1/10/68 and 1/10/68 and additional payments of \$7.50 were made 1/10/68, 1/10/68 and 1/10/68. The balance due is \$152.00.

The Atlanta address given to the locksmithing school by Galt is a "hippie" rooming house having thirty or forty rooms. It is next door to a "hippie" night club known as the Catacomb and the area has a large number of "hippies." A discreet surveillance is being maintained on the rooming house and background information is being developed on the owner.

Laundry tags on clothing believed to have been abandoned by Galt in Memphis apparently came from a Los Angeles laundry. Jay Vernon, former manager of the laundry has now been interviewed. He operated this laundry from 1/16/68 until 3/24/68. Vernon states Galt was a regular customer coming to the laundry each Saturday afternoon. He first appeared at the laundry 1/20/68 and Vernon last remembers seeing him at the laundry 3/16/68. According to Vernon, the shorts found in Memphis are similar to ones ordinarily worn by Galt and the size of the T-shirt matches Galt's build. He could not definitely state that these garments belong to Galt, but did identify the markings as being similar to the ones used in his laundry. Vernon only knew Galt as a customer of the laundry and has no knowledge of his background or activities. Galt paid for his laundry in cash using ten and twenty dollar bills.

Extensive investigation concerning Vernon, Ginger Day, Anita Katzwinkel and other persons considered as possible associates of Galt in Los Angeles has failed to develop that they are acquainted

with him or are involved in this investigation. Extensive investigation is continuing with regard to all possible associates, acquaintances or others who might have knowledge concerning Galt's background or the facts of this case.

With regard to the resemblance between Galt and the artist's conception of the subject, Vernon stated that the eyes, nose and chin of the Memphis artist's conception based on the interview of Memphis witnesses should be placed on the artist's conception based on the interview of Birmingham witnesses and that if this were done it would be a better likeness of Galt.

Marlin Myers, owner of Continental Dance Studios, Birmingham, has advised that Eric S. Galt took dance lessons beginning 9/12/67 when he paid \$10.00 and reported for consecutive weekly lessons from 9/12/67 to 10/3/67. He did not appear for a lesson on 10/10/67 and between 10/10/67 and 10/14/67 Myers received a letter from Galt saying he had to leave town and could not continue the lessons. Myers destroyed the letter and does not recall where it was mailed.

Myers also said that he recalled that Galt had taken dance lessons in 1964 and 1965 when Myers operated the Continental Dance Studios in New Orleans. Records of the New Orleans operation are in possession of Louella Lutz, a former partner now in Los Angeles. Joan Myers, wife of Marlin Myers, recalls Galt and believes he took dancing lessons in New Orleans on a full-year budget plan contract possibly starting in April, 1964. She described Galt as a loner who likes to dance.

Louella Lutz has been located in Los Angeles. She has burned most of the records of the New Orleans studio and no record of Galt could be located in the records that remained. She did not recall Galt.
