STRENGTH CLAIMS NEXT SAW HARRISON AT HOLIDAY INN, JOHNSON CITY, TENN. ABOUT THREE MONTHS AGO AND ON THIS OCCASION HARRISON TOLD HIM HE "HAD JOB TO DO" IN MEMPHIS AND THIS THE BASIS FOR STRENGTHS' CLAIM THAT HARRISON IDENTICAL WITH SUBJECT. HE STATED PHOTO OF SUBJECT NOT LIKENESS OF HARRISON. STATED HARRISON HAS USED NAMES OF JERRY HARRISON, JERRY RAY HARRISON AND LAST NAME OF LEONARD. STRENGTH HINTED HE HAS INFO RE PRESENT WHEREABOUTS OF SUBJECT. WHEN PRESSED FOR SPECIFIC INFO, HE EXPRESSED DESIRE TO CALL HIS ATTORNEY JOHN GOODIN, IN JOHNSON CITY, TENN. 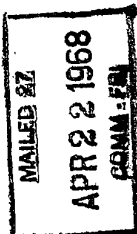
