IN ADDITION, EMPLOYEES OF THE BLUE DOLPHIN RESTAURANT IN SAN LEANDRO HAVE ADVISED THAT NICHOLS HAS PATRONIZED THIS RESTAURANT TWO OR THREE TIMES A WEEK FOR THE PAST THREE OR FOUR MONTHS, HOWEVER, SPECIFIC DATES ARE NOT KNOWN.

IT APPEARS THAT DIRECT INTERVIEW OF NICHOLS OR HIS CLOSE ASSOCIATES, MOSTLY EMPLOYEES, WILL BE NECESSARY TO DETERMINE HIS EXACT WHEREABOUTS ON PERTINENT DATES.

AS THE BUREAU HAS BEEN PREVIOUSLY ADVISED, NICHOLS IS A MEMBER OF THE COMMITTEE WHICH SPONSORED AND PROMOTED PLACING GEORGE WALLACE ON THE CALIFORNIA PRIMARY BALLOT FOR PRESIDENT AND IS APPARENTLY EXTREMELY ACTIVE EVEN BY HIS OWN ADMISSION IN POLITICAL ACTIVITIES IN BEHALF OF GEORGE WALLACE AND THE AMERICAN INDEPENDENT PARTY (AIP).

INTERVIEW OF NICHOLS WILL NECESSARILY INVOLVE THE SUGGESTION THAT IT IS CONNECTED WITH THE MURDER OF DR. KING. SINCE THE AIP IS GENERALLY CONSIDERED TO BE ANTI-NEGRO AND IS SEEKING SUPPORT FROM PERSONS OF SIMILAR BELIEF, SUCH INTERVIEW WOULD NECESSARILY PROVIDE NICHOLS WITH AN OPPORTUNITY TO OBTAIN ENORMOUS PUBLICITY IN BEHALF OF THE AIP AND TO AROUSE CONSIDERABLE PUBLIC CONTROVERSY SHOULD HE UNSCRUPULOUSLY AND FALSELY CLAIM THAT SUCH INTERVIEW BY THE FBI WAS IN CURTAILMENT OR HARASSMENT OF THE LEGITIMATE POLITICAL ACTIVITIES OF THE AIP.

EFFORTS CONTINUING TO LOCATE AND INTERVIEW NICHOLS; HOWEVER, SHOULD BUREAU BE IN POSSESSION OF INFORMATION WHICH WOULD MAKE INTERVIEW UNDESIRABLE OR UNNECESSARY OR IF SUCH INFORMATION IS RECEIVED BY BUREAU, REQUEST SAN FRANCISCO BE IMMEDIATELY ADVISED.

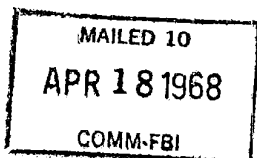
