At 4:10 a. m., 4/19/68, Dale Goff, part owner, Clarendon Hotel Court, 3824 Wilson Boulevard, Arlington, Virginia, contacted Extra Duty Supervisor Richard F. Bates. Goff advised that on the morning of 4/18/68, a guest at the hotel was looking at photographs of Eric Starvo Galt in the morning newspaper and he asked Goff if Goff thought Galt would ever be caught. Goff stated the man bore a striking resemblance to the pictures of Galt and Goff replied to him, "You look just like him." The unidentified guest laughed and walked out. Goff stated that the more he studied the photographs of Galt, the more he is certain that this unidentified guest was possibly Galt.

Goff declared that this unidentified guest was still possibly a guest at the hotel as he had not checked out to Goff's knowledge. Goff advised that the hotel had 110 rooms and he did not know the guest's name or what room he occupied.
