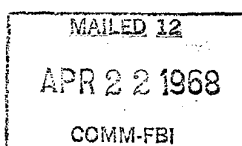

Don't Underrate The FBI

Congressman Charles Whelan, of Ohio, has been criticizing the FBI in its investigation of the murder of Dr. Martin Luther King. The Ohio lawmaker says there have been discrepancies throughout the investigation and calls upon the FBI to "set the record straight."

"The handling of the investigation and the efforts to apprehend the guilty person or persons hardly had been reassuring to a tense and troubled nation," the congressman said.

Since the FBI is not in the habit of tipping its hand and revealing its strategy to the advantage of the objects of investigation, how does the congressman know whether or not the FBI's efforts are adequate? The benefit of the doubt

would rest with the FBI, since it has a long-standing reputation for sound, thorough, effective investigation.

In police or FBI probing, many leads must be followed, and some of them inevitably turn out to be dead ends. An investigation must go in various directions. If this is what Congressman Whelan means by discrepancies, he shows a naïve lack of knowledge about police work.

It may not be reassuring to Mr. Whelan that the guilty person or persons have not been apprehended, but it is reassuring to a more realistic public that the FBI is working on the case. The FBI knows what it is doing even if Mr. Whelan doesn't know what he is talking about.

Dr. Johnson Missing For One Week

City police are searching for a 46-year-old Tucson physician who has been missing for one week after failing to keep an appointment at St. Joseph's Hospital.

Dr. Robert B. Johnson, of 100 Calle Encanto, was last seen March 29 when he left his office at 1311 N. Country Club Rd. He told his nurse he would return two hours later.

Officials at St. Joseph's said Dr. Johnson apparently never made it to the hospital.

The doctor is described as 5-feet-10, weighs about 175 pounds, and has a small scar on his forehead. He has brown eyes, graying hair worn in a crew cut and medium complexion.

Police said he was driving a 1967 white sports car when he disappeared.

on the morning of April 6th, Saturday, I boarded a
a R School-middle Bus on Kalakaua Ave in Waikiki,
Honolulu for the Bishop Museum, on Kaliphi Street. About four or
five blocks before that a young girl got on, sat down, be-

mutterings from a man across the aisle from me (who was
working a cross-word puzzle) I looked over, he smiled a sort
of silly smile of disgust, shook his head at the girl, obviously
thought her questions of the driver ridiculous. I looked again at
his profile thinking how very much he looked like the drawing
of a man, I had seen in the morning paper, who was being
sought as a suspect for the murder of Dr Martin Luther King.
I stared at the contour of the face - a rather long nose (not as
full a face as the picture I have since seen). I only saw
the profile which certainly resembled the artist's drawing.
He turned to see one staring, folded his paper and left
the Bus. I watched him walk up the hill to the right
of the main street (may have been King Street menueon)
There seemed to be some large bldgs. up on the hill -
perhaps a Hospital?

This has worried me ever since - so here it is for
what it may be worth to you. The possibility of
a hunt in Hawaii which I pray does not prove
to be false.
