RESIDENCE UNTIL ABOUT MIDNIGHT WHEN SHE WENT ALONE TO A PARTY AT THE PEABODY HOTEL. AT ABOUT ONE THIRTY AM ON APRIL NINETEEN LAST OGLESBY APPEARED AT LONG'S RESIDENCE LOOKING FOR WHICHARD STATING HE HAD COME TO MEET WHICHARD AT WHICHARD'S REQUEST. AFTER WAITING UNTIL THREE AM FOR WHICHARD TO RETURN TO RESIDENCE OGLESBY DEPARTED STATING HE HAD TO MAKE PHONE CALL.

SOMETIME DURING APRIL NINETEEN LAST AFTER RETURNING TO THE LONG RESIDENCE WHICHARD ADVISED LONG THAT WHILE SHE WAS IN THE COMPANY OF THE PERSON AT THE PARTY SHE OBSERVED AND IN TURN WAS OBSERVED BY OGLESBY WHILE SHE AND FRIEND WERE GOING TO A PANCAKE HOUSE AND RETURNING TO THE PEABODY HOTEL. ON APRIL EIGHTEEN AND TWENTY LAST WHICHARD ADVISED LONG OF A NUMBER OF EVENTS THAT OCCURRED AT OGLESBY'S TRAILER AT WEST MEMPHIS, ARK., INCLUDING THE FACT THAT FBI AGENTS ALLEGEDLY APPEARED AT THE TRAILER AND THAT OGLESBY HAD BURNED SOME BEER CANS THAT WHICHARD HAD PREVIOUSLY THROWN IN THE TRASH. ACCORDING TO LONG, WHICHARD ALSO MENTIONED THE FACT THAT OGLESBY HAD A LARGE NUMBER OF WEAPONS AND AMMUNITION IN HIS TRAILER BUT REMARKED THAT HE WAS

MRS. LONG STATED THAT SHE DID NOT PAY TOO MUCH ATTENTION TO THE INFORMATION BEING FURNISHED TO HER BY WHICHARD AND FINALLY PLACED WHICHARD ON A DELTA FLIGHT AT THE METROPOLITAN AIRPORT IN MEMPHIS AT EIGHT FIFTEEN PM ON APRIL TWENTY LAST WHICH WAS TO RETURN WHICHARD TO LITTLE ROCK, ARK.

LONG CLAIMS THAT ON APRIL TWENTY LAST WHICHARD STATED THAT SHE WAS GOING TO THE FBI WITH HER SUSPICIONS CONCERNING OBLESBY POSSIBLY BEING INVOLVED IN THE DEATH OF MARTIN LUTHER KING. LONG STATED SHE DEFINITELY DID NOT SUGGEST THAT WHICHARD GO TO THE FBI AND IN FACT ATTEMPTED TO DISSUADE HER FROM DOING SO AS IN LONG'S OPINION WHICHARD DID NOT POSSESS ANY BASIC FACTUAL INFO THAT COULD POSSIBLY INVOLVE OGLESBY IN THE KING KILLING.

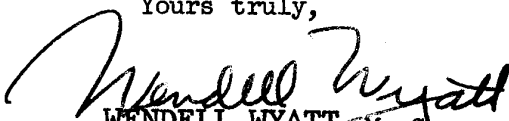

Mexicans Hunting Assassin

MEMPHIS, Tenn. (UPI) — The assassin of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. may have fled the country. The FBI has asked Mexican authorities to aid in the search.

A police spokesman in Mexico City said a drawing of the suspect, a composite of descriptions by persons who saw the white sniper in the Memphis rooming house from where King was shot, has been distributed throughout Mexico and at border crossing points.

THE MEXICAN spokesman refused to divulge any further information.

"There is an investigation going on; that is all we can say," he said.

U.S. Atty. Gen. Ramsey Clark, in Washington, said the "trail has lengthened" since Friday, the day after King slumped to his death on a motel balcony with a gaping rifle bullet wound in his neck.

The FBI has "one man on the run," Clark said. "We have a name, but whether it is the right name remains to be seen."

"WE HOPE he'll be under arrest quite soon. The focus is sharpening and we are quite close, we think, but that depends on how some of the leads we have develop," Clark said.

The assassin was described by the landlady who rented him a room on the day of the slaying as a man with a sharp nose, square chin, black hair receding on the sides, and "a silly smile." He is about 6 feet tall and 26 to 32 years old, witnesses said.

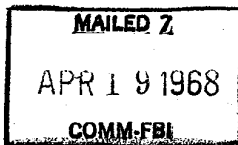

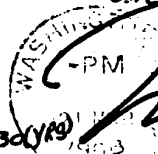
