SENATH, MO.

On Tuesday we went by car to Pontiac, Michigan. Later I visited friends and relatives in Flint (Sat. Mar. 27). I left Pontiac, Mich. after visiting my daughter Doris April 4, by bus, via Detroit, arriving in Hammond, Indiana 6:30 p.m. (their time). My other daughter, Mollie, met me. When we arrived at their house, Gerald said: "Martin Luther King has been critically wounded in Memphis, Tenn." At 7 p.m. the TV announced he was dead from assassination. (Memphis is about 100 miles se of my home in Dunklin County (Bootheel) Southeast Missouri and about ten miles sw of Kennett, the county seat.)

I watched the Memphis march on Tv. And from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. the funeral as narrated by Walter Cronkite and others and felt deep regret. Asle the Chicago rioting and looting.....

(I am white, but not responsible for the color of my skin. As King said, it is the character that counts, not the color of the skin.)

* Thursday April 11 Hammond School was dismissed at noon as Scott, a school board member, had died. At fifteen minutes to one o'clock in the afternoon we left by car for my home.

I then knew nothing of the white Mustang--- as we did not have the car radio on, and had been too busy in the morning to listen to news. So I do not know if it had then been broadcast.

Our trip was uneventful until dark, on a highway in Illinois before reaching Cairo where we crossed the Mississippi River..... We had left the four lane highways 54-57? I recall a 37.

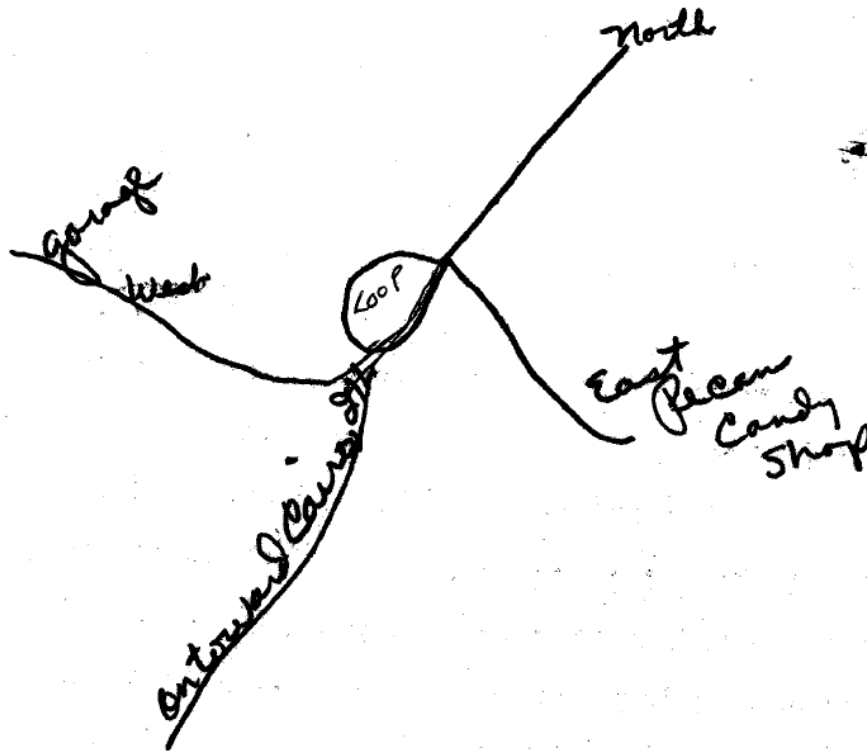
We were on a two lane lonely stretch, I think going southwest I lose directions when away from home. I was sitting on the right side of the rear seat. To the right of me I could see tree tops below me, looked like a drop from the roadbed. To the left were trees. No cars were in sight for a long distance.

THEN A CAR BEHIND showed brightly glaring lights, blinding our driver, who slowed almost to a stop as he could not see. The car pulled slowly around us, looking at us. The one man occupant wore dark glasses, shading his face, his hairline contour noticable. He then pulled in front of us and slowed down. We followed for some distance, then our driver pulled around him, as he watched us. He was "on my side now" and I had a clear view of him. The clipping photo-add dark glasses-is how he looked. He was driving a white CADILLAC. After we

passed, went ahead, again he pulled up just behind us, the blinding lights. Again our driver let the car pass. He drove slowly alongside us, so our driver slowed still slower, almost stopping. We were tense at least I was. All were quiet. I could see downward, and feared we would be pushed off the road.

In front again, he slowed. We went slower, almost stopping for some miles. By then we were uneasy. I think I saw a road marker, but not sure, read 37. Miles farther on another car in view. The dark glassed driver flashed his bright lights on this car also, slowly passed it, then slowed, repeated as with us.

When we reached a place where we saw a lighted building our driver made a loop drove to a "Pecan Candy Shop" and parked outside. The other car turned right to what looked like a lighted garage. When we could no longer see the Cadillac we went on. We did not get out at the Candy Shop.



We crossed the Mississippi at Carle, then stopped at a Truck Stop near Charleston, I think it was, to eat supper. It was eight p. m. on ~~this~~ ~~the~~ ~~clock~~, their clock.

With company over the week-end I did not have time to read the paper. Then, I saw this picture. I feel I should write, though doubt there is any connection.

Cadillac Among Items Sold at Customs Auction

A white 1961 Cadillac, seized in a counterfeiting case, was among the items sold at the annual U.S. Customs Service auction held here Wednesday.

The auto, appraised at \$1000, was sold for \$686.

The 140 lots of merchandise at the auction, appraised at \$14,000, brought \$5250.

ROLL-TOP DESK

An old-fashioned roll-top desk, valued at \$104 went to one bidder at \$66. Many cases of liquor brought about spirited bidding with the items selling at about store prices, sometimes higher.

Joseph P. Garrity, director of customs for the port of St. Louis, conducted the auction which started at 9:30 a.m. with the final gavel falling about 1:30 p.m.

Included in the items was an unusually large amount of wearing apparel. It was donated to the auction by the airlines and consisted of unclaimed baggage from foreign ports.

IMPORTED ITEMS

The Customs Service periodically auctions imported items that consignees have not claimed.

Other items carried home by new owners included, 10 dozen glass goblets from Germany, Spanish wines, rugs from Japan, golf bags, radios, toys, books and jewelry.

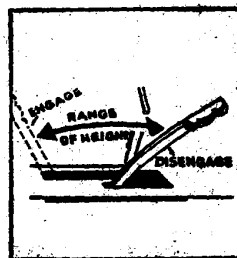

Enclosed for transmission to the FBI Laboratory are eight Thermo Seal Marking Machine Tapes, yellow in color, bearing code 20R-3.

ROBERT BERMAN, proprietor, Famous Cleaners, 3454 N. W. 7th Avenue, Miami, Florida, advised that his laundry does laundry and dry cleaning for several small cleaning establishments in the Miami, Florida area. He advised that he uses code 20R-3 about once every three weeks for the Royal Palm Cleaners, 4016 Royal Palm Avenue, Miami Beach, Florida. BERMAN believes that a yellow tape probably would have been used at least two or three times since April, 1967.

BERMAN advised that he is checking his records in efforts to determine the exact dates since April, 1967, that code 20R-3 has appeared on yellow tapes for the Royal Palm Cleaners. Thus far, BERMAN has determined this code was used on yellow tape for the Royal Palm Cleaners on September 28, 1967, and October 24, 1967.

BERMAN advised that he has not replaced any of the type characters in his Thermo-Seal marking machine since he purchased it three years ago. The model number of his machine is H5M4 and the serial number is 32647.

He further advised that approximately three or four months ago the Thermo-Seal tapes changed somewhat and he is now using the new variety. He also stated that he replaces the blades in the machine that cuts the tapes about every three months.

BERMAN made available eight yellow tapes, produced by his machine, bearing code 20R-3, which are being furnished the FBI Laboratory for comparison purposes.

On 4/18/68, SAS of the NYO while conducting investigation at Time, Inc., New York, New York, were advised of the following information by GEORGE HUNT, Managing Editor:

An AP teletype just off the wire with dateline of Kansas City, disclosed that the United States Attorney's Office reported that an informant told the Federal Government some time ago that Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING was among persons ordered assassinated if ROBERT BOLIVAR DE PUGH ever went to jail. DE PUGH is the leader of the Minutemen Organization, Militant Right Wing Organization. It was stated that DE PUGH had issued orders to other Minutemen that if he went to jail, certain persons connected with this prosecution, and others, were to be assassinated, including Dr. KING.

DE PUGH and WALTER PATRICK PEYSON are appealing a 1966 conviction in Kansas City for national firearms violation. DE PUGH and PEYSON are wanted on a Federal Grand Jury indictment accusing them of conspiracy to rob banks in Seattle in January.

HUNT advised that the aforementioned information with respect to the Minutemen recalled an article done by "LIFE" in about October, 1961 with regard to hate groups. In this connection photographs were taken in October, 1961 in Shiloh, state unknown, and in Collinsville, Illinois of certain Minutemen, some identified and some unidentified. DE PUGH was one of the individuals identified by name, but under restrictions imposed upon the photographer, identity of others by name was withheld.

The reporter for the article was WILL JARVIS, last known address and telephone number, Bronxville, New York, PE 8-0715. The photographer was CARL IWASAKI, 1465 Monroe Street, Denver, Colorado, telephone #Dexter 3-1290.

HUNT made available three 11"x14" photographs, one of which is DE PUGH and the other two photographs of an unidentified individual who somewhat resembles ERIC STARVO GALT. Both shots of this second individual apparently were taken about the same time. In one of these photographs the unknown individual is sitting with his eyes shut like in the GALT picture released to the public.

One of the other photographs in the group was an individual believed by Chief of Police REESE DOBSON, St. Clair County, Illinois, to be SA JACK ROBERTS, Belleville. ROBERTS, believed to be working undercover, was thought by DOBSON to have once worked on the COORS kidnapping case.

NIX'S STATEMENT "I GOT A CALL ON THE KING" WAS OVERHEARD WHEN SHE WAS UPSTAIRS IN THE RESTAURANT. BELIEVES STATEMENT WAS MADE TO MAN WHO LIVED UPSTAIRS AT RESTAURANT, NAME NOT RECALLED. SHE WAS IN BATHROOM AT TIME AND DOES NOT KNOW IF ANYONE ELSE PRESENT OUTSIDE WITH NIX. WHEN NIX MADE STATEMENT "MARTIN LUTHER KING IS DEAD", HE WAS STANDING IN LITTLE BOOTH WHERE FOOD IS SERVED TO PERSONS AT DRIVE-IN. By separate cover there is being forwarded one piece of cardboard on which is printed the word "CANADA," and a Texaco road map of California.

At approximately 1 PM 4/20/68, one ROBERT RICHARDSON, the principal of a parochial grade school in Seattle, telephonically contacted the Seattle Office and advised that on the previous day, he had picked up a hitchhiker coming out of Vallejo, California, and had brought this hitchhiker to Seattle without stopping overnight. RICHARDSON said that he picked up this man in California as the man was holding up the cardboard sign on which he had printed the word "CANADA" and he had let this man off in front of the Greyhound Bus Depot in Seattle on 4/20/68, just prior to 12 noon as the man indicated it was his intention to take a bus from Seattle to Vancouver, B.C.

RICHARDSON advised that after letting the man off near the Greyhound Bus Station, he, RICHARDSON, had driven to his home in Seattle and shortly thereafter, began reading the morning papers at which time he saw two separate photographs and one sketch of JAMES EARL RAY and as soon as he saw one of the pictures, he noted the striking resemblance to the hitchhiker he had just previously let out of his car. RICHARDSON said that the picture he liked extremely well was the one with tousled hair and RICHARDSON said it is his belief, although he cannot be positive of this, that the

hitchhiker he had transported from California is identical with RAY. RICHARDSON said he could not be positive of this as he could only make an identification from a photograph.

Thereafter, RICHARDSON was immediately recontacted in person and available photographs, including photographs from the wanted flyer, were shown to RICHARDSON and he still maintained it was highly possible that the hitchhiker he had just let out could be RAY.

RICHARDSON said that this man claimed to be a Canadian and was enroute to Vancouver, Canada, where he hoped to obtain a construction job. RICHARDSON said this man claimed he had hitchhiked an airplane ride from the Bahamas to Miami and then had hitchhiked all the way from Miami coming through Alabama, Louisiana, Texas, New Mexico, and Colorado. RICHARDSON said this man appeared to be very tanned, almost sunburned, and had said he had been in the Bahamas for the past two months. RICHARDSON observed although this man said he was a Canadian, he did not seem to be very conversant with the geography of Canada. RICHARDSON described this man as follows:

Height	5'10"
Weight	165 - 170 pounds
Eyes	Blue or gray
Hair	Medium brown

Hair was half-way between a crewcut and long. RICHARDSON said this man complained about his unruly hair and said he was letting it grow out from a crewcut. This man was not carrying any luggage but RICHARDSON observed this man had at least \$100.

Extensive efforts to locate the individual as described by RICHARDSON were conducted immediately and have produced no results to date. These efforts included checking of buses and trains for Canada as they were loaded in Seattle, checking buses at the Canadian border; checking one bus at Everett, Washington, that had left Seattle for Canada prior to the time the SA's arrived at the Seattle bus station; checking highway routes from Seattle to Canada that a hitchhiker could use; and immediately recontacting and alerting the border patrol at the Canadian line.

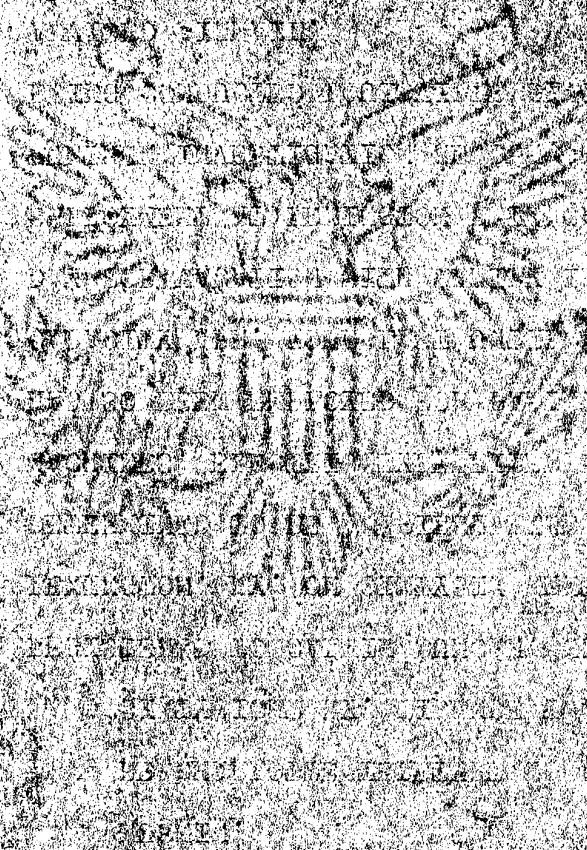

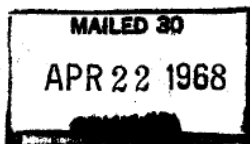

Upon his apprehension Ray can be held on the 1967 fugitive warrant until he is released to Tennessee authorities to be prosecuted for murder. This offers the advantage of making it unnecessary to introduce evidence establishing probable cause as we would have to do if he were to be held on the civil rights charge. *An*
