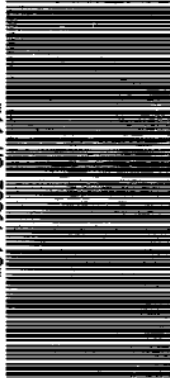

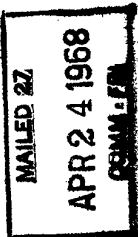

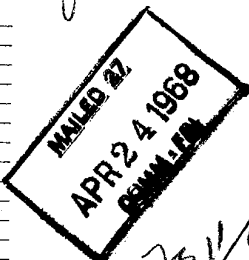

Re Bureau teletype 8:17 p.m., 4/12/68 instructing that Bureau of Vital Statistics records be checked for all male births on 7/20/31, specifically for ERIC STARVO GALT JOHN WILLARD and HARVEY LOWMYER as well as all variations of these names.

Mobile teletype to Bureau and Memphis 4/15/68 reported that BVS records for Alabama contain no record under the names of GALT, WILLARD or LOWMYER or variations of these names. RALPH W. ROBERTS, Registrar, advised that to check records of all male births 7/20/31 would entail the checking of all records of that office for a period 1928 through 1932 as birth records are recorded in 5 year periods and not listed as to specific date or as to male or female. He said to check these records would require about 3 weeks and the hiring of one additional person as his present personnel would not be able to handle. He estimated that it would cost between \$350 to \$400 to obtain this information.

The Bureau by teletype to Mobile 4/17/68, air mail copy Memphis instructed that in view of estimated cost, Mobile not pursue the identification of all male births 7/20/31 and accordingly no further investigation concerning this lead is being conducted.

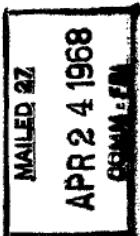
