ADVISED AFTER VIEWING PHOTOGRAPH OF RAY THAT HE WAS NOT IDENTICAL WITH PERSON TO WHOM SHE RENTED APARTMENT. SCHWARZAUER STATED THAT IN OCTOBER. SIXTYSEVEN. SHE RENTED A TWO-ROOM APARTMENT AT SIX ZERO SIX CHURCH STREET. COLUMBIA. MISSISSIPPI. TO A YOUNG MAN WHO GAVE HIS NAME AS EARL WILLIAM RAY. INDIVIDUAL ADVISED HER THAT HE WAS GETTING MARRIED AND WOULD BRING HIS WIFE TO LIVE IN THE APARTMENT WITH HIM. EARL WILLIAM RAY WAS A YOUNG MAN.
