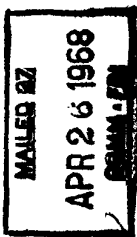

I am writing in regard to some events that might and I believe have a great deal to do with the Martin Luther King murder.

I had to go to my mother's funeral on Saturday night April 6.

I saw 5 men at Harrisburg Bus Terminal. I can only remember two enough to describe. One was sorta heavy with D. Brown Hair, Brown eyes had a Roman nose his hair line was same as papers show. Other was 6' or more slim light Blond or reddish hair he was starting to get bladd.

When I noticed them in the terminal they sat in the coffee shop. The first one with the nose acted kinda nervous or impatient.

He combed his hair while looking in a glass door. He also had a briefcase that looked brand new. They all wore suits.

On the bus that went to Pittsburgh that night. They talked all the way. I listen since they sat right behind me & my children. When we started out one said coffee tea & milk anyone cause they had just come from the airport. While passing the capital one remarked that was the third time past. ~~They~~ ^{Wonder who they you} One man did most of the talking he asked the other man about how things went & Arkansas. Then he wanted to know how he made up the name Starvo and where he got it from. They talked about there wives & home. One talked about being divorced for so many years.

Then there talk about Calif.
thing they were going to get
started in the back of the men
behind me. Also they talked
about Newark, N.J. and something
that was going to be taken care
of and said something to describe
the homes and people there. Then
they started talking about the
Pittsburgh Instit. He told about classes
there how the student behaved, as
if, he might be a Professor or Dean.
They talked so much I was tired
and might have not taken it
right. They were still talk when
we got to Pittsburgh. They got off
said something about they ^{hope} didn't have
to travel for a couple of weeks. They
would see each other in November.

There was talk about their wives
& home. One talked of being
divorced for so many years. I
heard something about a car red &
white a convertible that he paid
cash for was at home. Then
there talk about the Calif. thing
that one of the guys was going to
^{I think they call him} take care of. Also about Newark,
N. J. and something there about a
certain area and people involved
that he described. Then they talked
about Pittsburgh Institute, about
classes there how certain students
behaved; as if, he might be a
Professor or Dean. I am sure he's a
Teacher of some sort. When they were
getting off at Pittsburgh they all said
(See you in November.) ^{to each other} With all
the confusion I couldn't possibly
understand all the talk on the

bus. So if you'll excuse my
writting is a mess. Hope you'll
be able to understand this
letter.

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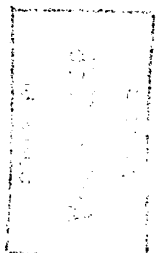

Some features noted on Qc288 which might give an indication of its place of purchase are a stamp with the wording "Montreal 28 VII 67;" the number of the money order, "C-31,600,868;" the printed name "Hector Cormier" at the bottom of the money order and the initials "M." or "N." "D." on the bottom line to the right of the printed Cormier name.

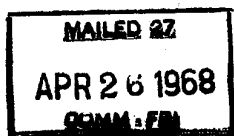

HE WAS ABOUT FIVE FEET EIGHT OR NINE INCHES TALL, CLAIMED TO BE THREE FIVE YEARS OLD, BROWN HAIR, BLUE EYES, FAIRLY WELL DRESSED WITH A BLUE DINNER JACKET AND BOW TIE AND WAS WEARING A MADRAS HAT WITH RIM PULLED DOWN.

LINDHARD SAID SUSPECT DURING ENTIRE TRIP APPEARED TO BE "DOPEY" AND TOLD LINDHARD HE HAD BEEN SHOT IN HEAD BY WIFE WITH A SHOTGUN AND, AS RESULT, HAD FORGOTTEN HOW TO READ AND WRITE AND WAS JUST LEARNING TO SPEAK AGAIN. HE SAID HE HAD BEEN BEATEN AND ROBBED IN TIJUANA, BAJA CALIFORNIA, AND HAD NO MONEY. UPON ARRIVAL AT SONOYTA, LINDHARD HAD BETTER OPPORTUNITY TO OBSERVE SUSPECT AND SAW A SCAR ON RIGHT SIDE OF FOREHEAD ABOUT HALF WAY BETWEEN CENTER OF FOREHEAD AND RIGHT EAR. THIS SCAR WAS A ROUND SCAR APPROXIMATELY ONE

INCH IN DIAMETER AND STRADDLED THE HAIRLINE WITH MORE OF THE SCAR FALLING INSIDE THE HAIRLINE THAN OUTSIDE. LINDHARD SAW NO OTHER SCARS.

SUSPECT CLAIMED TO BE FROM MICHIGAN AND TO HAVE A TEEN AGE NIGHT CLUB THERE AS WELL AS SEVERAL OTHER BUSINESSES WHICH RELATIVES WERE OPERATING. HE SAID HE EXPECTED TO EARN MONEY BY PLAYING THE GUITAR, ONCE INSIDE MEXICO, AND DID PLAY IN LINDHARDS PRESENCE. LINDHARD SAID SUSPECT WAS NOT ACCOMPLISHED IN HANDLING GUITAR AND PLAYED COUNTRY AND WESTERN MUSIC.

HE SAID HE DOES NOT KNOW WHETHER SUSPECT WAS SUCCESSFUL IN CROSSING BORDER AND HAS NOT SEEN OR HEARD ABOUT HIM SINCE. SUSPECT TOLD LINDHARD HE MIGHT TRY TO SLEEP IN ONE OF THE IMMIGRATION BUILDINGS AT BORDER IF HE WAS SUCCESSFUL IN CROSSING. LINDHARD DESCRIBED IMMIGRATION OFFICERS ON DUTY AS YOUNG "BOYS" AND THE ONE IN CHARGE SEEMED "PRETTY SHARP" AND MADE THE DECISION TO REFUSE TOURIST DOCUMENTATION TO SUSPECT AND DECLINED HIS BRIBE OFFER.

PHOENIX DIRECTLY REQUESTED TO ATTEMPT TO IDENTIFY AND INTERVIEW IMMIGRATION OFFICERS ON DUTY AT OR NEAR MIDNIGHT, APRIL ONE EIGHT LAST, TO DEVELOP FURTHER INFO CONCERNING ACTIVITIES OF SUSPECT AFTER LINDHARD LEFT HIM AT BORDER. RE DEPARTURE OF SUBJECT FROM MEXICO IN NOVEMBER LAST:

CHIEF OF INSPECTION SERVICE OF MEXICAN IMMIGRATION ADVISES ALL DEPARTURES BY LAND FROM MEXICO DURING SECOND HALF OF NOVEMBER LAST THROUGH ALL POINTS FROM THE PACIFIC TO THE GULF HAVE BEEN REVIEWED TWICE IN EFFORT TO LOCATE RECORD OF GALT'S DEPARTURE.
