RITA STEIN DENIES ANY KNOWLEDGE OF USE OF NARCOTICS BY SELF, BROTHER, CHARLES OR ERIC GALT. EXAMINATION OF SCHOOL RECORDS WHERE DAUGHTERS OF RITA STEIN ARE PRESENTLY ENROLLED, NOTE FOUR DIFFERENT LOS ANGELES RESIDENCES FOR THEM PRIOR TO PRESENT ADDRESS DURING PERIOD FROM SEPTEMBER SIXTY FOUR TO JANUARY TWO SIXTY EIGHT, LATTER BEING MOST RECENT CHANGE AND CURRENT ENROLLMENT DATE IN PRESENT SCHOOL. EXAMINATION OF CORONER'S RECORDS THIS DATE, FILE SIXTY SIX DASH EIGHT EIGHT SEVEN EIGHT, REVEALS STANLEY LINO ROSAS, AKA STANLEY LINUS ROSAS, STANLEY LINO ROSSI, CAUCASIAN, BORN [REDACTED] LOUISIANA, HUSBAND OF RITA ROSAS, THREE THREE FOUR ZERO FLOYD TERRACE, HOLLYWOOD, WAS FOUND DEAD IN CAR ON STREET, LOS ANGELES ON AUGUST THIRTY ONE, SIXTY SIX, CAUSE OF DEATH "ACUTE MORPHINE POISONING."

RE W. J. PERKIN, VISITOR TO MEXICO:

W. J. PERKIN, THREE SIX TWO WEST CEDAR, BURBANK, CALIFORNIA HAS NO RECORD BURBANK POLICE DEPARTMENT WIFE INTERVIEWED. PERKIN IS AGE SIXTY ONE, AMATEUR MINERALOGIST, RETURNED FROM THREE WEEK TRIP IN MEXICO APRIL NINETEEN LAST. HE TRAVELLED WITH FOURTEEN YEAR OLD NEPHEW UTILIZING NEW VOLKSWAGEN CAMPER WITH CALIFORNIA LICENSE PLATES. EMPLOYED AS PHOTOGRAPHER. HE ENTERED MEXICO AT EL PASO AND EXITED AT NOGALES. The Laboratory has received from Secret Service, through Liaison, an anonymous handwritten letter which was addressed "To The President of The United States Mr. L. B. Johnson, Washington, D.C." This letter was postmarked April 4, 1968, at Savannah, Tennessee. In addition to generally castigating Reverend Martin Luther King, the anonymous writer states "someone will kill this man soon when everyone gets enough and I say the sooner the better!"

The writings in this letter were compared with the writings submitted in the "MURKIN" case and found to be not identical. The letter and envelope were also searched in the Anonymous Letter File but could not be identified with any prior submissions to this file.

The above mentioned anonymous letter has been forwarded to the Latent Fingerprint Section for appropriate examination.
