ESTHER NIETO, 801 West 23rd Street, Apartment 104, Los Angeles, California, was interviewed at 5280 Hollywood Boulevard, Hollywood, California, advised she was employed by Home Service Laundry and Dry Cleaning, 5280 Hollywood Boulevard.

Mrs. NIETO observed an eight inch by eleven inch color photo of one Jockey Power Knit tee shirt, size 42-44 with attached laundry mark "O 2 B-6" and one pair of white brown and gray patterned under-shorts with laundry mark "O2B-6". Mrs. NIETO advised that she could positively say that the laundry in the photograph had been marked at Home Laundry by the Thermo Seal marking machine at the laundry because of the manner in which the first digit zero is partially cut off and also because that most cleaners put the laundry mark on the inside of the underwear and that at Home Laundry the mark is put on the outside of the underwear shorts, as is shown in the photograph.

Mrs. NIETO stated that she was the only person in the shop who ran the marking machine and that she believed she had marked the laundry in question. Mrs. NIETO could not remember marking the specific piece of underwear shown in the photograph or to whom the laundry belonged. Mrs. NIETO stated that she had begun work at the Home Laundry about the last week of February and started running the marking machine on March 4, 1968. Mrs. NIETO stated that the laundry in question would have had to be marked between March 4, 1968 and March 18, 1968, because after March 18, she no longer put the laundry mark on underwear or items of that nature but only on shirts.

Mrs. NIETO also advised that while JERRY VERNON operated the laundry she believed that he had rented an apartment above the laundry establishment.

She advised that she does not know the first name or address of GALT or where he might be employed. She stated she last observed GALT in the laundry sometime during February, 1968. She advised that GALT usually brought in dress-type shirts with wide button down collars and never brought in work-type clothes. She advised that sometime during February, 1968, some of GALT's dress shirts were lost and she does not recall if they were ever recovered. She described GALT as follows:

Extra-Duty Supervisor William J. McDonnell, Domestic Intelligence Division, furnished the following information to Special Agent John J. Boyd, 4-20-68:

John Kenney, Duty Officer, Central Intelligence Agency (CIA), phoned at 5:45 p. m., 4-20-68, and advised that CIA Headquarters received a message from its station in Bogota, Colombia, at 3:43 p. m., today. CIA, Colombia, was advised by the local liaison service stationed at Bogota Airport that a U. S. national bearing a striking resemblance to Eric Starvo Galt arrived Bogota 11:20 a. m. (Bogota time) on Varig Flight Number 810 from Los Angeles (S)

The Bogota Police put the national under surveillance taking him to the Tequendama Hotel where he put up in room 528. On arrival the national advised the Immigration Service that his name is Edwin Mason, U. S. national, age 35, passport number [REDACTED] occupation: Excursion Director (S)

Immigration authorities noted that he has deep wrinkles or possible scar, center forehead. Mason advised Immigration Authorities, Bogota, that he intended to depart for Quito on 4-22-68. Local police continuing surveillance.

CIA requested Mason's identity and passport number be verified at Los Angeles; also requested fingerprint classification of Galt so same can be forwarded CIA station Bogota and furnished local police. Mr. Kenney can be reached at telephone number 351-5555 or on secure line (gray phone) 1-8517 (S)

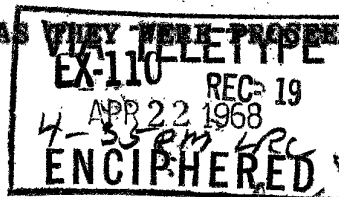
