

A letter dated April 10, 1968, has been received from William R. Badgett, Jr., Pilot Mountain, North Carolina, in which he suggests one Rex Thomas Gravitte as a possible suspect in the killing of Warth to Badgett, Gravitte resided in either St. Louis or Louisville. The remainder of Badgett's letter is a rambling discourse relating in part to "the worldwide hotpill racket" and other matters totally unrelated to the instant case.

Bureau files do not contain any information regarding Rex Thomas/Gravitte or/Gavitte. mo KY B. APPROX 1933 38

Bureau files do disclose that one William Badgett of Pilot Mountain, North Carolina, directed a letter to the Justice Department dated February 5, 1940, on the letterhead of Badgett and Badgett Attorneys; this related to possible information he had concerning the Matson kidnapping case. A second letter was received dated February 17, 1940, from W. R. Badgett on this same letterhead, advising that the first letter had been written by his son William. He advised that his son was very abnormal and he wanted us to understand the conditions under which his letter had been written. He stated his son had experienced mental problems for several years. (7-1820-28922 and 29035)

On December 6, 1945, William Badgett of Pilot Mountain, North Carolina, telephoned the Bureau and reported that the movie star Linda Darnell who had eloped to Las Vegas, Nevada, two years previously had not done so voluntarily. (62-60004)

Mrs. CHORTOS was interviewed on 4/26/68, at which time she stated that after she had thought about this matter and visualized the car she realized from her visualization that the car had not been blue at all but was green and further that the license plate number was PS 633 or PS 655 followed by an additional four digits. According to CHORTOS, this made the plate two letters and seven digits. She stated that there was a Missouri plate and that the color was white on green.

Mrs. CHORTOS stated that her only glimpse of the subject was when she drove by the car and observed a portion of his profile from eyes down and for a moment full face when he looked in her direction. She did not see all of his face but she stated she did see his nose and that part of his face. She recalled that there was a long strand of hair hanging down by his eye. She could furnish no other description except to state that she thought he was quite handsome and could not guess his age as she "can't tell ages." She stated that her attention was drawn to this matter because of the fact that there was a Missouri license plate on the car and the next day she observed the picture of subject RAY in the Life magazine and because he slouched down in the seat. As Mrs. CHORTOS stated, she could not understand why he would slouch down in the seat when she looked at him.

Mrs. CHORTOS stated that she had written to the Bureau rather than call the Cleveland Office of the FBI because she realized that the Agents were so busy. She stated she had never met an FBI Agent before and really wanted to talk to one. She said she was very disappointed when an Agent did not come out to her house right after she had called and in fact she "cried a little."

The Agents explained to Mrs. CHORTOS that they were most appreciative of her information and had not realized that she expected to be personally contacted and that the Agents had acted in accordance with the value of the information, in immediately checking out the area indicated by her. Mrs. CHORTOS indicated that she was very pleased to have been of some assistance and was quite thrilled to have met some representatives of the FBI and indicated that she had anything to furnish, she would immediately call the Cleveland Office of the FBI.

Mrs. CHORTOS resides with a lady companion, both of whom are about 50 years of age. Mrs. CHORTOS has very heavy masculine features and was wearing a man's black sweatshirt and black pants when contacted by the Agents. It is the impression of the Agents that Mrs. CHORTOS was undoubtedly sincere in calling the Bureau, but may be experiencing some emotional problems. In view of the vague and highly questionable accuracy of the information furnished by her, Cleveland is hereby resending the lead set out to Kansas City by re IO airtel to check the Bureau of Motor Vehicles for Cadillacs bearing PS 6 plates.
