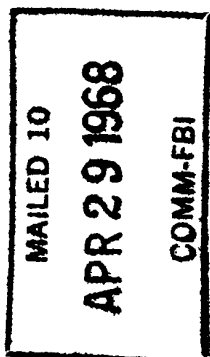

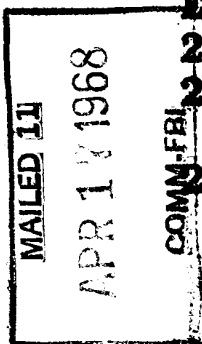

Result of examination:

The "Eric S. Galt" signatures on Q128, Q130, Q131, Q132 and Q135 were prepared by the writer of the signatures in this name appearing on items previously submitted in this case.

The typewritten impressions appearing on Q127, Q128, Q130, Q131, Q132 and Q135 were found to be the same style of type but the lack of identifying defects precluded a determination as to whether the same typewriter prepared all of these items; however, no significant differences were noted between the impressions appearing on these items. The style of type appearing on these specimens conforms to a standard for Royal pica style of type spaced ten letters to the inch. This style of type also appears on a typewriter sold under the Singer name.

It was determined that the hand printing appearing the Q133 order blank and the Q134 enrollment form was prepared by the same individual. No questioned hand printing appears on the other items received.

Indented impressions were noted on the reverse side of the Q128 letter. The names "Ray," "Galt" and "Rily" and numerals "ET3623" were some of the notations interpreted on this item. A photograph of the indented writing is enclosed for the information of Los Angeles.

Sandy Smith telephonically contacted the Bureau on the evening of 4/18/68 concerning the captioned matter. Smith related that George Hunt, editor of "Life" magazine, had received information that one Curtis Way of the Youth Corps, Newark, New Jersey, claimed to have photographs of subject Galt. Way allegedly stated that Galt had marched with King about two weeks before King was killed. Way claimed to have both movies and still photographs of Galt in the crowd.

Smith stated that the information could be obtained from Hunt or the first assistant editor of "Life" magazine, Phil Kuhnhardt.

New York Office contacted "Life" magazine and interviewed Curtis Way, Deputy Director, Neighborhood Youth Corps, City of Newark, New Jersey. They also interviewed Gloria Way and Theodore Rose, all of Newark. These individuals positively identified a newspaper photograph of Galt as being the individual they had observed on 3/24/68 at a parade in Newark, New Jersey. Way contended that the individual had approached him at the start of the parade and requested permission to participate. Way endeavored to discourage him since he was unknown and looked out of place as the group were mostly teenagers. However, the individual continued in the march. Way contended that this individual also attended a dance that night and was observed sitting with three or four colored women between the ages of 50 and 60 years and that the individual danced nearly every dance with these women.

The unknown individual was described as being in his late 30's, 6 feet 3 inches tall, weighing over 190 pounds, hair black graying at temples, neatly dressed.

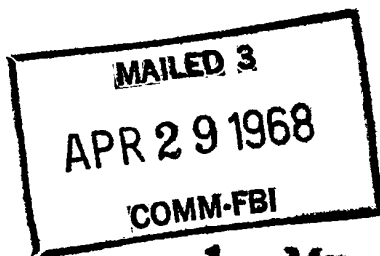
