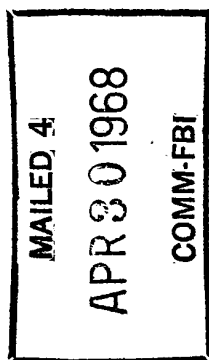

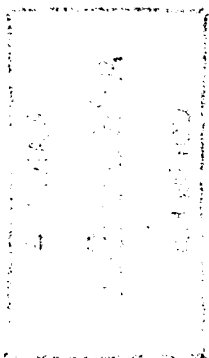

On Monday past, April 22, I was baby-sitting in the home of my niece Mrs. Alan Terwilliger. At about 10:30 a.m. I went to the living room window facing south and watched a dark (black, I believe) car slowly approaching the fork in the road outside. What attracted me was the apparent nervousness of the driver, young, about 26 or 27, dark straight smooth haired and from the rather crouched driving position of slightly above medium height. He was looking every which way and appeared very nervous. As he pulled past the house to the right I got a $\frac{3}{4}$ face view of his companion, who when he, ^{the driver} saw me appear at the window I got the impression he was trying to shield

by leaning forward and the man himself, ^{companion} to draw back against the seat. But I did get a front $\frac{3}{4}$ view of that companion's face and it looked like the face of ~~James Earl Ray~~ James Earl Ray, as he appears on the Post Office FBI Wanted list. I had the impression ^{the companion} he was wearing a mackinaw in the car, ^{no hat, going the companion's} his appearance was casual and rumpled like the Post Office poster. The direction the car turned would lead either across the mountain into the Mohantongo Valley, or along the base of the mountain to Ashland, and on.

I would have written sooner, but I did not believe my eyes. But on Tuesday I saw the Post Office Bulletin and the resemblance was striking and it set me to thinking maybe I had seen him after all. I remember thinking at the time if only I could have glimpsed that left ear, but that part of his head was hidden by the driver's. The high bank precluded getting a look at the license, afterward. It was drizzling and the macadam road was wet. The atmosphere was quite luminous, however.

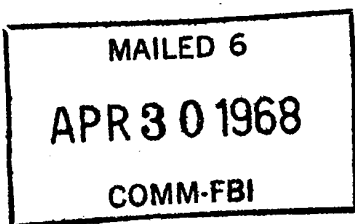

At 11:20 p.m., today, an individual who identified himself as John King, R.D. #1, Hooversville, Pennsylvania, telephonically advised that he was currently at the Palace Hotel, Wimber, Pennsylvania, and that he had observed an individual in a bar at this hotel who he believed to be identical with the "killer of Martin Luther King."

He said he had observed a photograph on television of the person that the FBI is seeking for the murder of King and that the man in the Palace Hotel bar "is that man." He said that he had called the Pennsylvania State Police but they did not pay any attention to him. He stated he had not been drinking except for "a few sodas" and that the individual he believes is identical with James Earl Ray has been drinking heavily and has indicated that he came to Wimber, Pennsylvania, from Russia, Cuba and Minnesota.

King stated that he thought about calling the Somerset County Sheriff but then "they are a bunch of crooks" so he felt he should call the FBI in Washington, D.C.

ACTION:

The above information was furnished to Security Patrol Clerk William Raymond Judd, Pittsburgh, at 11:25 p.m., with instructions to have this matter checked out and that the Bureau be advised of the results.

Bureau files disclose John King, Hooversville, Pennsylvania, telephonically contacted Bureau on 10-26-62, at which time he furnished information regarding crimes within the area of Somerset County, Pennsylvania. It was noted at the time that King was rambling, incoherent, and vague. (66-3182-6660) On 1-7-63, one John King, Pittsburgh, who appeared to be drunk or mentally unbalanced, called Bureau and furnished rambling and incoherent story about his wife's brother being missing and he believed he was murdered. King stated he wrote to President Kennedy who told him to "take the law into his own hands." (66-2120-6937)

ADDENDUM: 5/2/68 HGR:pah *pah*

At 12:25 a.m., 5/2/68, SPC David Yingling, Pittsburgh Office, called and advised the Resident Agent and local police had located John King at the Palace Hotel in Wimber, Pennsylvania, and he was completely drunk. Resident Agent advised King pointed out one Fred Foust as the individual whom he had earlier called FBI Headquarters about. It was determined Fred Foust was a long-time resident of Wimber, Pennsylvania, and well acquainted with several members of the Wimber Police Department, and not identical with James Earl Ray.
