Dear Mr. Hoover:

On Monday past, April 22, I was baby-sitting in the home of my niece Mrs. Alan Terwilliger. At about 10:30 a.m. I went to the living room window facing south and watched a dark (black, I believe) car slowly approaching the fork in the road outside. If hat attracted me was the apparent nervousness of the dever, young, 1260 about 26 or 27, dark straight smooth haired and from the rather crowched driving position of slightly about 1968 medium height. He was looking every which way and appeared very nervous. As he pulled past the house to the right I got a 34 face view of his companion, who when he saw me appear at the window I got the impression he was trying to sheld

by leaning forward and the man himself to draw back against the seat. But I did get a front 34 view of that companion's face and it looked like the face of James Carl Pray, as he appears on the Post Office I BI Stanted list. I had the impression he was wearing a mackinaw in the car, he appearance was casual and rumpled like the Post Office poster. The direction the car turned would lead either across the mountain into the Mohantongo Valley, or along the base of the mountain to Ashland, and on.

I would have written sooner, but I did not believe my eyes. But on Tuesday I saw the Post Office Bulletin and the resemblance was striking and it set me to thinking maybe I had seen him after all. I remember thinking at the time if only I could have glimpsed that left ear, but that part of his head was hidden by the driver's. The high bank precluded getting a look at the license, afterward. It was driggling and the macadam road was wet. The atmosphere was quite luminous, however.

At 11:20 p.m., today, an individual who identified himself as John King, R.D. #1, Hooversville, Pennsylvania, telephonically advised that he was currently at the Palace Hotel, Wimber, Pennsylvania, and that he had observed an individual in a bar at this hotel who he believed to be identical with the "killer of Martin Luther King."

He said he had observed a photograph on television of the person that the FBI is seeking for the murder of King and that the man in the Palace Hotel bar "is that man." He said that he had called the Pennsylvania State Police but they did not pay any attention to him. He stated he had not been drinking except for "a few sodas" and that the individual he believes is identical with James Earl Ray has been drinking heavily and has indicated that he came to Wimber, Pennsylvania, from Russia, Cuba and Minnesota.

King stated that he thought about calling the Some rset County Sheriff but then "they are a bunch of crooks" so he felt he should call the FBI in Washington, D.C.

ACTION:

The above information was furnished to Security Patrol Clerk William Raymond Judd, Pittsburgh, at 11:25 p.m., with instructions to have this matter checked out and that the Bureau be advised of the results.

Bureau files disclose John King, Hooversville, Pennsylvania telephonically contacted Bureau on 10-26-62, at which time he furnished information regarding crimes within the area of Somerset County, Pennsylvania. It was noted at the time that King was rambling, incoherent, and vague. (66-3182-6660) On 1-7-63, one John King, Pittsburgh, who appeared to be drunk or mentally unbalanced, called Bureau and furnished rambling and incoherent story about his wife's brother being missing and he believed he was murdered. King stated he wrote to President Kennedy who told him to "take the law into his own hands." (66-2120-6937)


