ASSASSINATION OF MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.

On April 5, 1968, Professor Charles B. Schildecker, Chairman, Police Science Department, Miami Dade Junior College North, Miami, Florida, advised that at about 10:00 a.m. on this date, a group of approximately 100 Negroes staged a "sit-down" in the area of the Student Center Lounge reserved for the fraternities. Approximately six or seven Negroes then stood up and made speeches deploring the assassination of King and blaming the white people, whom they called "Charlies," for causing this tragedy. Approximately 200 white students gathered around, and when it appeared tempers were rising, College Vice President Ambrose Garner made an appearance. He spoke about King's death being a great loss to the country, pointed out the open door policy of the college regarding the races, and asked everyone to stand and bow their heads in silent prayer. All the students complied and afterward returned to their classes.

The Dade County Department of Public Safety, 111th M. I. Group, and U. S. Secret Service, Miami, were advised of the above on April 5, 1968.

On April 5, 1968, an anonymous male telephoned the Miami Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation around 1:50 P.M. and advised that a Negro on the previous evening had seen two machine guns in Gils (phonetic) Bar in Coconut Grove, Miami, Florida. The caller then hung up stating he knew his call was being traced.

A few minutes later the same caller called again and stated that a violent demonstration would take place in Coconut Grove following the funeral ceremonies for Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, and that the two machine guns referred to previously would be involved. He again hung up stating he knew his call was being traced.

The above information was immediately made available to the Alcohol Tobacco Tax Unit of the U.S. Treasury Department, U.S. Secret Service, Miami, Florida, 111th M.I. Group, Miami, Florida, Miami Police Department and the Dade County Public Safety Department, Miami.

Copies of this memorandum are being directed to the U.S. Attorney, Miami, Florida, Alcohol Tobacco Tax Unit, Miami, 111th M.I. Group, Orlando and Miami and the U.S. Secret Service, Miami, Florida.

On April 4, 1968, a confidential source, who holds a leadership position in the Miami Communist Party, advised that a meeting of the newly formed Coordinating Committee of the Miami Communist Party was held on the evening of April 4, 1968. This meeting was attended by leaders of the Miami Communist Party. At the inception of this meeting, the group discussed the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and everyone was shocked. (X)(U)

The group together decided to have all Communist Party members in Miami make contact with peace groups, senior citizen groups, and the Conference of Concerned Democrats, a pro-Senator Eugene McCarthy organization, to protest King's death. They are to encourage these groups to call for martial law in Tennessee until the murderer or murderers are found. They are to encourage a mass memorial meeting for King, mass marches for him, and are to urge all persons involved in protests to wear black bands in mourning for him. (X)(U)

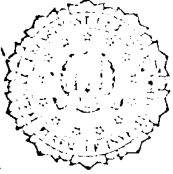

2. Has attempted or threatened to redress a grievance against any public official by other than legal means.
3. Because of background is potentially dangerous; or has been identified as member or participant in communist movement; or has been under active investigation as member of other group or organization inimical to U. S.
4. U. S. citizens or residents who defect from the U. S. to countries in the Soviet or Chinese Communist blocs and return.
5. Subversives, ultrarightists, racists and fascists who meet one or more of the following criteria:
 - (a) Evidence of emotional instability (including unstable residence and employment record) or irrational or suicidal behavior;
 - (b) Expressions of strong or violent anti-U. S. sentiment;
 - (c) Prior acts (including arrests or convictions) or conduct or statements indicating a propensity for violence and antipathy toward good order and government.
6. Individuals involved in illegal bombing or illegal bomb-making.

A confidential source, who is familiar with the activities of the Congress of Racial Equality (CORE), and who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised today as follows:

A memorial march and service will be held on April 7, 1968, in memory of Doctor MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. The march is being sponsored by the CORE and all civil rights organizations are being invited to participate. All participants are to meet at the Dade County Courthouse on Flagler Street at 4:00 PM. The march will proceed east on Flagler Street to Northeast 2nd Avenue, north on Northeast 2nd Avenue to Northeast Fifth Street, west on Northeast Fifth Street to Northwest 2nd Avenue, north on Northwest 2nd Avenue to Eighth Street where the march will terminate. At this point the marchers will participate in services to be held in the Greater Bethel AME Church on Northwest 8th Street between 2nd and 3rd Avenues. There is no estimate as to the number of people expected to participate; however, the march and service is to be a quiet, peaceful demonstration. Anyone who feels that he cannot restrain himself from committing acts of violence is being asked not to participate in this march for Doctor KING.

On the morning of April 6, 1968, an individual identifying himself as JOHNNY MCKAY, believed to be a Negro male, advised that there will be a riot in downtown Miami at 2:00 PM, April 7, 1968. The caller
