PENELOPE CHAMPAGNE reside at Apartment 322 at this address and are closely acquainted with the SEXTONS. Both advised that Mr. and Mrs. CHAMPAGNE have resided here since September, 1967, and that he is a student at American University working toward his Master's Degree. They both advised that neither Mr. or Mrs. CHAMPAGNE have left the area during their [REDACTED] here. They further advised when shown the artist's sketch of the killer in this matter that they did not think there was any resemblance between the sketch and Mr. CHAMPAGNE. They advised that Mr. CHAMPAGNE has a conspicuous facial scar extending from his lip caused from an accident a number of years ago.

Mr. and Mrs. JOHN LEWIS CHAMPAGNE were thereafter contacted and advised that they have resided in this apartment since September, 1967, and have not been out of the State of Virginia since that time. CHAMPAGNE was born [REDACTED] at Springfield, Mass., receiving an honorable discharge from the U. S. Army as a Captain, ASN [REDACTED], after serving from January 3, 1964, through August, 1967. He was employed with the Defense Intelligence Agency at Arlington Hall, Arlington, Va., from September, 1967, through February, 1968, when he left to enroll at American University to work toward his Master's Degree having obtained his Bachelor's Degree at the University of Massachusetts.

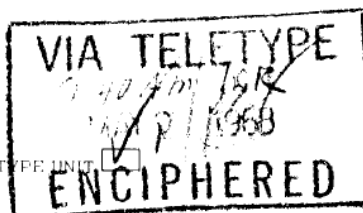
