The FBI today released two additional photographs of James Earl Ray who is being sought in connection with the murder of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. The photograph of Ray wearing dark glasses was taken in Mexico in November, 1967, while the photograph of Ray in a business suit was made in California during the last part of January or the early part of February, 1968.



Peter Sterne, American Broadcasting Company representative in Los Angeles, California, has contacted SA Richard G. Douce to determine if the Bureau would approve this announcement being used at various times of the day over ABC television outlets for an extended period of time.

Sterne has indicated that he feels certain that ABC would be willing to do this as a public service.

OBSERVATION:

This would appear to be an excellent opportunity to afford maximum television exposure of Ray's photograph and descriptive data.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Director may wish to approve the spot announcement on James Earl Ray by Philip Abbott being used at various times of the day over American Broadcasting Company television outlets for an extended period of time.
