The following investigation was conducted by SA

On 4/26/68, PATSY OWEN, P. O. Box 641, Clarksville,
Va., advised she is a cousin to SHELBY JEAN BALDRIDGE, nee
Faucett. She stated that she never traveled to the State of
Fla. with her cousin, SHELBY JEAN, and, in fact, has never
left the State of Va. She also advised that to her knowledge
SHELBY JEAN has never traveled to Fla. She stated that SHELBY
JEAN has had some difficulty with men and her marriage to
ELBERT BALDRIDGE is her second. She further stated that
while BALDRIDGE was in Vietnam SHELBY JEAN lived with another
man in Texas. She said it is her opinion that SHELBY JEAN
is trying to get away from BALDRIDGE. She stated she does not
know anyone named ERIC RAY or EARL RAY and never heard SHELBY
JEAN mention anyone by that name. She observed photographs
of JAMES EARL RAY and advised she has never seen anyone who
resembles the photo nor does she know this man.

On 4/26/68, Mrs. LENA FAUCETT, Rt. 1, P. O. Box 240, Clarksville, Va., advised SHELBY JEAN BALDRIDGE is her daughter. She stated that to her knowledge SHELBY JEAN has never traveled to Fla. at any time and she has never heard her mention an ERIC RAY or EARL RAY. She stated her daughter is having some marital difficulties with her husband, ELBERT BALDRIDGE. She said SHELBY JEAN visited her in December, 1967, and left in January, 1968, to return to Texas but she has not heard from her since that time. She said she had no idea of her whereabouts until BALDRIDGE called her about 4/23/68 and told her he received a letter from SHELBY JEAN postmarked Saltville, Va. Mrs. FAUCETT advised she has no people in Saltville, Va., and did not know why her daughter would be in that section of the state. Mrs. FAUCETT further advised that Sgt. BALDRIDGE told her not to worry about SHELBY JEAN because he had the FBI and Red Cross looking for her and they would find her soon. Mrs. FAUCETT observed pictures of JAMES EARL RAY and advised she did not know him nor did she recognize any of the photographs. Mrs. FAUCETT advised that should she learn the whereabouts of her daughter, SHELBY JEAN, she would advise this office.
