On 4/23/68, immediately after receipt of the 4/19/68 news release issued at Washington, D. C., Legat furnished the new release and photographs to the National Police Agency of Japan (NPA), Tokyo, and the Tokyo Metropolitan Police Department (TMPD). These agencies subsequently made their own release to the effect that they had been asked to be alert to the possibility that the subject might travel outside of the U. S. It was stressed that there was no indication that the subject in fact traveled to Japan.

This material has also been made available to appropriate Chinese and Korean authorities.

News media in Tokyo territory have given a great deal of attention to the KING matter initially, and when the Japanese authorities made their announcement, the next day the story with photograph was again run prominently.

NPA has since gotten out their own circular for display in police stations Japan-wide. They are most eager to conduct all investigation necessary in order to assist in the location of subject. They made it very clear that at the first evidence subject may be heading for Asia, they be immediately notified as they have a Phase #2 plan set up which will entail more specific investigative steps. They were assured that this would be done.

On April 30, 1968, ~~WYATT~~ STANLEY, residence address North 6118 Cook, Spokane, Washington, was drinking at Casey's Gay 90s, 457 Northtown Shopping Center, Spokane, and engaged in a conversation and had a few drinks with an individual who identified himself as BILL LEE. The conversation got around to racial problems in the United States and LEE indicated he was from the South and subsequently said he would pay STANLEY \$10,000 to kill RAP BROWN or STOKELY CARMICHAEL. He mentioned the Ku Klux Klan and the Minutemen and said "we" will furnish cars or planes for carrying this out and any kind of gun wanted. LEE then said "The mark has been put on RAP BROWN, STOKELY CARMICHAEL and ROBERT KENNEDY." He then gave STANLEY a business card from Follett Music Co., W. 1131 First Avenue, Spokane, and on the back wrote "Bill Lee" then "Yes _____", "No _____" and "Where _____". LEE said he could be called at that place and that STANLEY was simply to answer "Yes or No" and where he could be contacted.

STANLEY said LEE had been drinking but did not appear to be drunk. STANLEY reported this matter several hours later and admitted he had been drinking.

ROBERT FOLLETT, Follett Music Co., advised LEE was employed by him as a salesman on March 23, 1968, but that he has not seen him for about a week, that LEE owes him about \$150.00 for merchandise, and reportedly is doing a lot of drinking. He said LEE is a "blow hard" and that he recalls that when Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., was killed LEE had remarked that he had been offered \$5,000.00 to do this job four or five years ago. FOLLETT said LEE had previously been employed by Radio Station KSPQ, Spokane.

Records of Snelling and Snelling, East 9822 Sprague, Spokane, showed his address as W. 1117 Garland, Spokane, wife ELVA and a daughter, 13, and a daughter 19. He showed employment in October, 1967, at Tubbs Electric, Spokane; in May, 1967, with Washington Health Service, Seattle, Washington; May, 1965 to February, 1967, with Koret of California, 611 Mission, San Francisco, California; January, 1960 to May 1965, with Nixon Merchandising Co., 3961 Sepulveda, Los Angeles, and from 1954 to 1960 with ABCC Corporation, Los Angeles. LEE claimed two years college at the University of Alabama from 1957 to 1959 and service in the U.S. Navy from 1948 to 1952.

Mrs. KATHERINE MACY, Assistant Manager, Snelling and Snelling, advised they have been unable to collect their fee for placing LEE with Radio Station KSP0 and that collection agencies have been trying to secure information concerning him.

LEE is described as a white, male, about 35 to 38 years of age, 5'7" tall, 140 pounds, brown hair.

The typewritten impressions appearing on Q334 are the same style as those appearing on items previously received in this case attributed to Eric S. Galt. It can not be determined whether the same typewriter was employed to prepare all of these items because of the lack of significant identifying defects; however, no significant differences were noted.
