HEALEY Stated that on 1/22/68, he visited with Governor LESTOR MADDOX at Atlanta, Georgia. He stated MADDOX asked him to attend the Georgia School Board Association Convention on 1/22/68 which was held at the Atlanta Biltmore Hotel, Atlanta, Georgia.

HEALEY advised that he attended the convention and met one, CALVIN S. CRAIG, who claimed to be the Grand Kleagle of the UKA. CRAIG advised that he resides at 1009 Byron, Drive Southwest, Atlanta Georgia.

HEALEY advised that in conversation with CRAIG, CRAIG stated to HEALEY that they (not otherwise described) were going to execute the mayor and vice mayor of Atlanta, Georgia.

HEALEY also stated that CRAIG bears a strong resemblance to photographs he has seen of JAMES EARL RAY who is presently being sought by the FBI in connection with the assassination of KING. HEALEY advised that CRAIG's physical description would appear similar to the physical description of RAY. He was unable to furnish any additional information relating to the above matters.

HEALEY advised that CRAIG furnished him a card which he claimed would permit HEALEY to join the UAK for \$40 if he would do so by 6/1/68.

Chicago indices contain numerous references to an individual (s) with the name RAYMOND J. HEALEY. Chicago file 65-122 appears to pertain to complainant HEALEY referred to above. CG 65-122 indicates HEALEY furnished information to the FBI which pertained to the German American Bund. HEALEY at that time as well as at the present time is a writer who publishes magazines.

CG indices being reviewed and results will be furnished, if pertinent. Subsequent to indice review Chicago will evaluate and give consideration to reinterviewing HEALEY, for any additional information he may have and also to determine if he has informant potential.

Copies being furnished recipient offices in view of continuing interest in matter set forth above.

CG 44-1114

Since it appears HEALEY may offer informant potential his identity should be protected at this time.

Information relative to the alleged plot against the Mayor and Vice Mayor of Atlanta should be disseminated by Atlanta to appropriate authorities.

Atlanta advise if HEALEY is known to Atlanta sources or the Atlanta Police Department. Atlanta indices should be checked re HEALEY.

Atlanta also requested to conduct appropriate inquiry to determine if information by HEALEY is accurate. Specifically, did HEALEY meet with Governor MADDOX on 1/22/68 and did he attend the Georgia School Board Association Convention which was allegedly held at the Atlanta Biltmore Hotel on 1/22/68.

On May 8, 1968, Mrs. BETSY RIGGS, 1711 Elmhurst, advised she has been the subscriber to telephone number 842-5325 for approximately one year. She stated that her family has previously resided in Houston, Texas, and that her daughter went to Houston on December 21, 1967, to visit friends. She stated she believes that the call to her residence on December 17, 1967, would probably have been made to her daughter by either a girl friend, SHERYL RUSSELL, 307 Ranier, Houston, telephone number HO 8-4957, or a boy friend, MIKE REESBY, 502 Lanecrest, Houston, telephone number HO 8-0375. She further stated her husband, RICHARD RIGGS, travels throughout the Houston area in his job, and could have made this telephone call to the residence during December of 1967. Current photographs of JAMES EARL RAY were exhibited to Mrs. RIGGS and she stated the person in the photographs was unfamiliar to her.

On May 8, 1968, JEAN JOFFRION, 1529 Northeast 9th, advised that she is the subscriber to telephone number 424-4153, and was the subscriber to this number during December, 1967. She stated that she does not recall receiving any telephone calls from Houston, Texas, as she does not know anyone in that city. She stated that prior to a month ago, she had a tenant by the name of DOROTHY WILLIAMS, and that the relatives of WILLIAMS resided in the Houston area. She stated WILLIAMS was about six months pregnant and left Oklahoma City to return to her relatives' home. She further stated that WILLIAMS did on occasion receive

and make telephone calls to the Houston area. She stated that she does not know of the current whereabouts of WILLIAMS or any of her friends or relatives. She further advised that WILLIAMS has not changed her mailing address and is still receiving mail at that address. JOFFRION described WILLIAMS as being about 21 years old, Negro, female, and single. She stated that to her knowledge WILLIAMS was employed at Lerner's, Penn Square, Oklahoma City.

On May 8, 1968, Mrs. JO (DUANE) WILLIAMS, 4621 Northwest 33rd, advised she has been the subscriber to telephone number 946-2137 for many years. She stated that she does not specifically recall receiving the telephone call from Houston, Texas, on December 16, 1967, but believes it was her husband calling, inasmuch as he was traveling in business in the vicinity of Houston during that time period. She stated he is employed for Jeffries Company, and that this company is engaged in hauling heavy equipment. Mrs. WILLIAMS was shown current photographs of JAMES EARL RAY without effecting an identification.

Mr. BUTCHER advised he is a trucker, and that in December, 1967, he was hauling wheat from Oklahoma to Houston, Texas, and was in Houston every other day prior to Christmas, 1967. On several occasions, he called his wife from a pay telephone in Houston located near the Continental Grain Company loading dock. At that time he was paying for these calls when made rather than making them collect to his home phone number, as he had run up a large bill a few months before without realizing it, and made the calls only when he had the money in his pocket to spare. Both Mr. and Mrs. BUTCHER advised the photographs and the description of Subject RAY were unfamiliar to them.
