at a red light on Irving Street, at Sherman Street, N.W. A beetle Volkswagen painted (repainted) a peculiar yellowish green pulled up beside me on the one-way street about 15 feet away from me.

I saw that his headlights were on in broad daylight, ^(at the time no other travelers were showing this deference to King) so I supposed he had been driving all night and had neglected to turn off his lights. I started to lean over and wind my window down and call to him about his lights, but to my surprise he wound his window down first and waited for me to speak. He appeared nervous and watching for challengers.

I told him that I didn't know whether he knew it or not but his lights were on. He said, "I know it!" rather gruffly and then added, "Thankyou!" He resembled "Ray" although his face appeared fuller. He had a pasty complexion with a fresh red scar in the middle of his left cheek as though

a boil had been lanced.

Now here is the way I look at it. He was tipped off in prison in Missouri that on account of his successful assassination of President Kennedy, another job was being offered, to assassinate King. (Where else would a small time hoodlum get all that money except by a big job like Kennedy's assassination) His escape from prison was arranged by this powerful group of Catholic and Colored haters.

He bought a deer rifle but was told by a brother (non-soul brother) that it was not powerful enough and exchanged it for a 30.06 with telescopic sights, and went to the neighboring rooming house in Memphis to await King. (Incidentally, don't rule out the possibility that King was a part of the plot, because he expected

to be killed when he returned to Memphis and by being a martyr he could best further his ends and those of his colleagues.

This fellow, Ray or Galt, who was discharged from the Army for being inept, is still inept and it will get him in the end, but for the present he is carrying out instructions of his fellow conspirators. Like the game "hare and hounds" he dropped clues like his rifle and drove off in a white Mustang convertible that stuck out like a sore thumb.

When he reached a rendezvous in Memphis, he switched cars with a conspirator who drove the Mustang to Atlanta to throw the hounds off his (Ray's) trail. Ray took the yellowish green beetle Volkswagen (the model doesn't change and there are millions of them on the road) and drove north.

The time was just right for him

encountering me at 7:30 a.m. the next day (Friday) in Washington. He was keeping off the main highways where the police might catch him.

For some unknown reason he had made a trip to Montreal a short time ago. Now the reason is known - to establish his identity and have a place to hole up in a foreign country where the FBI would not be looking for him. He could either remain in hiding or take off from there for Europe. He probably has a hundred thousand dollars with him.

I believe you could find him in the red light district of Montreal, or possibly Paris. If you go along with the Kennedy assassination, he has established a M.O. I believe you could find out how his escape was arranged from Missouri State Penitentiary, and how the plot was hatched in Atlanta. Sincerely yours

Result of examination:

It was concluded that none of the machines used to prepare K227 through K238 was employed in preparing the laundry marks appearing on Q69 and Q70 and that the machine used to prepare K228 was not used to prepare the laundry marks appearing on Q97 and Q99.

Differences were noted between the tapes designated K227 and K229 through K235 when compared with the laundry marks appearing on Q97 and Q99, but the lack of sufficient identifying features precluded a definite opinion from being reached.

Specimens K236, K237 and K238 are not adequate for comparison with the laundry marks on Q97 and Q99. The submitted items have been retained.

MUTT WENT HAZY ON ME BUT IS GETTING BETTER, FLUSHED A COUPLE HUNDRED DOWN THE TOILET - TRIED TO KILL HIMSELF AND ALL THAT JAZZ. HE HAS A CHECK BEEF IN SAN CLEMENTE RIGHT NOW. CALIFORNIA WANTS HIM FOR THAT AND OTHER THINGS. I GOT ABOUT TWENTY THOUSAND OUT IN PAPER IN EIGHTEEN STATES MOST OF IT FEDERAL, BUT SO FAR JUST A P.V. HOLD FROM CALIFORNIA. THE KING AND KC BUSINESS AND

INFORMANT WENT TO VICAM MAY ONE ZERO LAST AND LOCATED AND INTERVIEWED SUSPECT, ARTURO FUGATE, WHO IS THERE WITH WIFE, HELEN MARGARITA FUGATE, AND CHILDREN AGED SEVEN YEARS AND EIGHTEEN MONTHS. HE IS DRIVING ONE NINE FIVE FOUR BUICK WITH ^{Mexico} CALIFORNIA PLATES L G N THREE EIGHT THREE, CROSSED BORDER APRIL ONE TWO LAST AT NOGALES, SONORA, AND GIVES ADDRESS OF ONE ONE ONE CHAPALA STREET, SANTA BARBARA, CALIFORNIA. IS ABOUT FOUR FIVE YEARS OLD, BALD, WITH NO SCARS. APPEARS TO BE SLIGHTLY UNSTABLE MENTALLY AND IS LIVING IN A SHACK MADE OF WOODEN STICKS AMONG INDIANS. INFORMANT STATES HE DOES NOT MATCH DESCRIPTION OF SUBJECT.
