FOX, GRADUATE STUDENT, UNIVERSITY OF MICHIGAN, ANN ARBOR, MICHIGAN, ADVISED APRIL THIRTY, SIXTY-EIGHT THAT APRIL TWENTY-FOUR, SIXTY-EIGHT WHILE VISITING GUATEMALA HE WAS TOLD BY PAULINO JARQUIN, OPERATOR OF RESTAURANT CATOC, KILOMETER EIGHTY-SEVEN, DEPARTMENT OF TECTAN, GUATEMALA, THAT JAMES EARL RAY REPORTEDLY IN CENTRAL AMERICA AND WAS REPORTEDLY SEEN IN GUATEMALA. ## BODY FOUND BURIED IN SAND IN ACAPULCO, MEXICO

An examination of the skin tissue remaining on the left index finger of the body found buried in the sand on the beach at Acapulco positively eliminated this body as being James Earl Ray.

The body was found May 10, 1968, and, according to the chief of police, had been dead at least three days and the outer skin of the fingers had already sloughed off and been lost. Fingerprints taken at that time were examined in Identification Division the night of May 11, and found to be of absolutely no value for identification.

Following examination by the local authorities on May 10, the body had been placed in a metal box, covered with lime, and kept without refrigeration in the 90 degree heat in a building at one of the local cemeteries. Access to the body was not obtained until after dark the night of May 13, and an examination by an Identification Division fingerprint examiner revealed there had been further deterioration of the skin tissue of the fingers caused by the lime and maggots. It was necessary for the examiner to remove the ridged surface of the left index finger, and by scraping the flesh away, was able to transmit the light from a flashlight (only other light was a single bulb suspended from the ceiling) through the skin and determine the pattern was not the double loop formation present on Ray's left index finger. It was not possible to obtain any identifiable fingerprints from the body.

Fingerprint Examiner George J. Bonebrake returned to Washington, D. C., at 4:30 PM, on 5-15-68, via American Airlines flight #58.

Each office receiving this communication should check with postal authorities and other sources which might have information regarding the existence of similar type "swinger" or "lonely hearts" type clubs or organizations in your areas in order to develop any information as to whether Ray, under any of his known aliases, may have contacted any such club and pursue any pertinent information developed. Each office should bear in mind that as a result of investigation conducted in Los Angeles, there was obtained the photograph of subject showing him in business suit, seated, which has been described as an excellent likeness.

Postal Inspector, Los Angeles, California, made available a letter mailed to Patricia E. Anderson, 2/17/68, at Los Angeles. Galt and the owners of "The Local Swinger" recall that Galt had sent one dollar for a list of swingers and subsequently submitted five letters for transmittal to persons. Checking this matter out further, we obtained a most recent photograph of subject Ray which people describe as an excellent likeness. In view of the fact that Galt submitted correspondence for a local swinger group, the offices of Atlanta, Birmingham, Memphis and New Orleans are being requested to make inquiry with postal inspectors to determine if subject could have contacted a similar type club. These offices cover the known metropolitan areas in which subject resided since his escape, except Los Angeles.

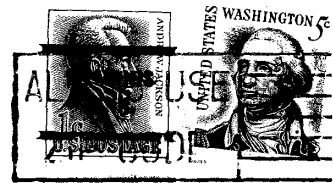
