Reference is also made to your teletype 4-5-68 setting forth information furnished by J. W. Farris, driver, Yellow Cab Company, Memphis, Tennessee, who reportedly had taken Vincent Walker and Lawrence Rand to the Municipal Airport after they had checked out of the William Len Hotel, Memphis. Bureau files indicate investigation conducted by Kansas City, San Francisco, and Houston regarding the identities of the above named individuals was negative. No information is located in Bureau files regarding what action your office has taken.

If not already handled, you should exhibit photographs of Ray to J. W. Farris and personnel at the William Len Hotel. You should attempt to obtain registration cards and/or any other identifying data which would disclose handwriting and/or possible latent fingerprints of Vincent Walker and Lawrence Rand. Determine whether or not Walker and Rand made or received any telephone calls while registered at the hotel and if so attempt to determine whom they may have contacted or by whom they were contacted. Recontact personnel at Delta Airlines, Memphis, and personnel at the Municipal Airport in an effort to further identify W. Davis and B. Chidlow and conduct necessary investigation to determine whether or not Davis or Chidlow are identical with Walker and Rand.

NEAREST OF KIN, MAY SPEAR, MELVIN, KY. (SISTER); OCCUPATION COAL MINER; LAST PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT, LOGAN, UTAH. HE, MOLLETT, HAS PERFORMED HIS MILITARY OBLIGATION AND RECEIVED AN HONORABLE DISCHARGE.

ACCORDING TO OFFICIALS AT SALVATION ARMY, BUTTE, ABOVE THREE SUBJECTS WERE ALL TOGETHER DRIVING A SIXTYONE - SIXTYTWO (NOT FURTHER DESCRIBED) STATION WAGON. OFFICIALS OVERHEARD CONVERSATION AMONG THREE TO EFFECT THEY WERE TRAVELING TO SPOKANE, WASHINGTON. THEY REGISTERED NIGHT OF MAY THIRTY LAST AND CHECKED OUT MORNING OF MAY THIRTYONE LAST.

ON JUNE ONE INSTANT, JACK MOLLETT, WEEKSBURY, KY., BROTHER OF WILLIAM MOLLETT, ADVISED HE HAS NOT SEEN HIS BROTHER WILLIAM IN OVER TWO YEARS. MOLLETT ADVISED HE THOUGHT HIS BROTHER HAD BEEN KILLED IN WAYNE COUNTY, W.VA. OVER A YEAR AGO. MOLLETT STATED A SKELETON WHICH STRONGLY RESEMBLED HIS BROTHER WAS FOUND. MOLLETT STATED THE SKELETON WHICH HAD STEEL PLATE IN THE SKULL AND NO TEETH WAS FOUND WRAPPED IN ARMY BLANKET IN WOODS IN WAYNE COUNTY. MOLLETT STATED AUTHORITIES HAVE NEVER OFFICIALLY NOTIFIED HIM BUT HE BELIEVES BODY IS NOW IN CHARLESTON, W. VA.

MOLLETT WAS ADVISED BY WILLIAM THAT HE NOW HAD A GOOD JOB, IN DENVER, AND EVERYTHING WAS FINE. MOLLETT STATED HE HAS NOT HEARD FROM HIS BROTHER SINCE THAT TIME. MOLLETT ADVISED WILLIAM WAS ON HIS WAY TO VA HOSPITAL IN HUNTINGTON, W. VA. APPROXIMATELY TWO YEARS AGO WHEN HE DISAPPEARED. This is the case involving the murder of Martin Luther King, Jr.

At 9:30 p. m., 6/1/68, Moss Innes, Legal Attache, Ottawa, Canada, telephonically advised that the Roayl Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) are conducting a survey of Canadian passports in an attempt to locate James Earl Ray. RCMP investigators have located Canadian passport number DJ909324 for one Ramon George Sneyd issued 4/24/68, at Ottawa. This passport contains a photograph of Sneyd which RCMP advises is very definitely similar to Ray and there is good probability it is a photograph of Ray.

Sneyd's application for passport was filed on his behalf by the Kennedy Travel Bureau, 962 Dundad Street West, Toronto, and was handled by Miss L. Spencer who RCMP is attempting to locate for interview. Sneyd filed an affidavit in lieu of listing a guarantor that he had only been in Toronto three weeks and did not know a guarantor. Passport data listed Sneyd as white male, born [redacted], at Toronto, five feet ten inches in height, 168 pounds in weight, black hair, blue eyes, residence 968 Dundad Street, Toronto (RCMP established this to be a Chinese rooming house where Sneyd arrived 4/19/68, and roomed for three weeks). He also listed as a friend Paul Bridgman, 102 (or 108) Ossington Street, Toronto (RCMP has been unable to locate Bridgman to date).

The purpose for the Canadian passport was for Sneyd to fly to London, England, 5/6/68, via British Overseas Airlines Company (BOAC) and return to Canada 5/21/68. RCMP as yet has no information as to what BOAC flight Sneyd may have taken to London and there is no indication he has returned to Canada.

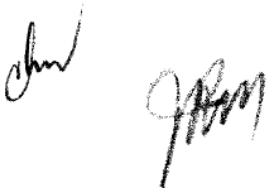
RCMP has instructed their personnel to go all out to further identify and locate Sneyd. The handwriting on the application is being examined by the RCMP and will be forwarded to FBI Laboratory by the Legal Attache, Ottawa, along with a photograph of Sneyd.

Based on name checks and data furnished, there is no identifiable record of Sneyd in Bureau Indices, Bureau Fugitive Indices, National Crime Information Center or Identification Division files.

The Identification Division has a record on one Paul Osborn Bridgeman, FBI number 352 520 C, who was last fingerprinted by Department of Correction, Jefferson City, Missouri, on 4-23-65, on a robbery charge. Bridgeman received a five-year sentence which was commuted on 1-16-68.

ACTION: The Legal Attache, London, has been instructed to have investigation conducted through his sources to attempt to identify and locate Sneyd in London and to determine through BOAC if Sneyd did arrive in London and his movements subsequent to arrival.

We are affording this case top priority attention.

Reference is made to memorandum A. Rosen to Mr. DeLoach dated 5/22/68.

This case involves the murder of Martin Luther King, Jr.

Liaison was requested to contact the Chief Postal Inspector without identifying the case involved and obtain his clearance to publish ~~an~~ an advertisement designed to solicit a reply from a particular fugitive.

On 5/27/68 this matter was discussed with Mr. Henry B. Montague, Chief Postal Inspector, U.S. Post Office, Washington, D.C., who advised as follows:

Montague stated that the subject of hypnosis is most controversial, particularly among the medical profession, and his Department has several pending false representation cases where claims regarding hypnosis were too grandiose in offering positive results. *[Signature]*

Montague, after reviewing the sample advertisements set forth in referenced memorandum, stated that as presently written, it would probably bring strong complaints from the medical profession as well as Better Business Bureaus. He suggested that the word "positive" be eliminated and the sentence "Results guaranteed or your money back" be replaced by "Money back if not completely satisfied." He stated these minor changes would make the advertisement inoffensive since no positive claims would be made and the Post Office would then be in a position to so advise anyone who lodged a complaint. Montague stated the advertisement, with the above-mentioned changes, would not violate postal laws and could be used by the Bureau in an effort to obtain the desired results.
