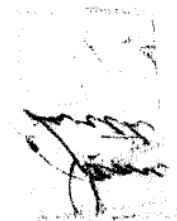

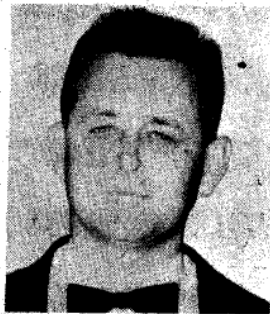

**J**ames Earl Ray, also known as Eric Starvo Galt, a Missouri prison escapee, is being sought in connection with the gunshot slaying of civil rights leader Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. He has been the subject of a massive and intensive search since the brutal gunshot slaying of Dr. King April 4, 1968, as he stood on the balcony of a Memphis, Tenn. motel.

Ray has an arrest record dating back to the year of 1949 and has been convicted of burglary, armed robbery and forging U. S. Postal Money Orders.

He is a 40-year-old white male, 5 ft. 10, weighs from 163 to 174, has blue eyes, brown hair, small scar on center of forehead, straight, narrow nose. His left ear protrudes noticeably. He is described as a 'loner' and 'drifter'. He should be considered armed and extremely dangerous.

Anyone with information concerning this fugitive is requested to immediately contact the nearest office of the FBI.

# Cucumbers and Beauty

Every woman, at some time in her life, faces the spectre of an aging skin. Most women never solve the problem, and finally become resigned. A fortunate few find the answer and are rewarded with a complexion that remains fresh and youthful all their lives.

Eight years ago, I had this skin problem. Nothing very serious, but when I took my mirror over to a bright light, I could detect evidence of dryness and faint little lines in those areas where wrinkles have a tendency to show first. 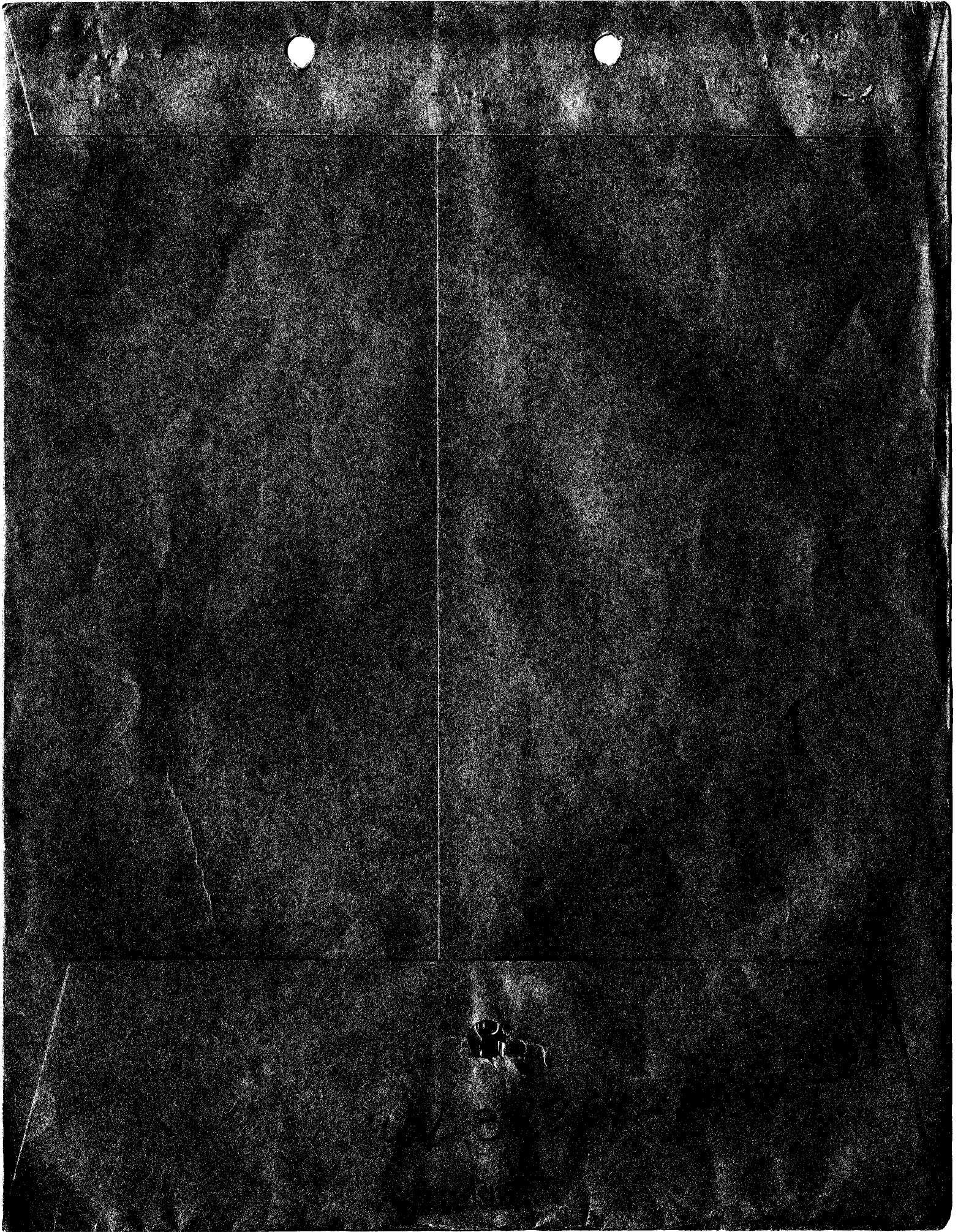

This is the case involving the murder of Martin Luther King, Jr.

In connection with the widespread publicity furnished this case the Bureau has prepared and distributed approximately 200,000 Wanted Flyers on subject as Eric S. Galt, 200,000 Wanted Flyers on subject as James Earl Ray as well as 200,000 Identification Orders on subject as James Earl Ray. In addition, 30,000 Wanted Flyers were printed in Spanish concerning the subject James Earl Ray and 30,000 were also printed in Spanish concerning subject as Eric S. Galt.

These Wanted Flyers and Identification Orders have been distributed to all field divisions and all Legal Attaches for distribution in foreign countries, particularly Mexico and Canada.

These Identification Orders and Wanted Flyers have been distributed to law enforcement agencies throughout the country, to airline and travel facilities as well as to Salvation Army, mission type rooming houses and hotels. There is attached a copy of each Wanted Flyer, Identification Order and the Circular Letter.

Identification Orders were provided to 290 U. S. Consular offices covering nations throughout the free world.

We also prepared and distributed 14,000 Circular Letters to be distributed to laundries and dry cleaning establishments throughout the United States.
