She said her first reaction was that his statements along this line sounded "kooky" so she ignored them, except for the fact that in a newspaper article she wrote in October, 1967, which was not published until February, 1968, and in which she made a predication of major events to occur in 1968, she did predict the assassination of a prominent Negro leader, being influenced in this predication by what her friend had written to her.

Miss CALDWELL was then asked whether she would suggest to her friend that he contact the Federal Bureau of Investigation in New York City. She replied she knows he would not do so, because he had written to her in the past that about four years ago he had contacted the Federal Bureau of Investigation to furnish information that "an FBI under-cover agent in an organization" was under suspicion. However, according to the friend, the Federal Bureau of Investigation wanted more and more information, so he broke off contact with the Federal Bureau of Investigation. The friend also claimed that shortly after contacting the Federal Bureau of Investigation, he had begun to receive anonymous threatening letters, making him realize that his contacts with the Federal Bureau of Investigation had been observed. Miss CALDWELL stated that based on the letters received from her friend, she believes him to be a very intelligent man, but who is now completely terrified by the plot of which he is aware and also apparently by the fear that

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he himself is under suspicion, as indicated by a comment
in one of his letters that he was not even invited to
"Resurrection City" and cannot understand why, unless
it is because he is no longer trusted.

Miss CALDWELL stated at one point in the
conversation that she had just received another letter
from her friend "yesterday," but when questioned about
the contents, completely ignored the questions and
then reverted to a statement that the last letter from
her friend arrived a few days before her own letter
to the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

Miss CALDWELL then proceeded to state that
because of her husband's confinement, everything at
her residence is in a state of chaos and that she is
"simply going out of my mind." She said that pre-
viously her husband had taken care of all her business
affairs, that she is killing herself going back and
forth to the hospital, that she has had to give up
her whole career to take care of her husband, and that
"all this is too much for me." She said she herself
is under constant medical care and does not know why
she has "to put up with all of this mess."

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Miss CALDWELL continued by stating her husband's
critical condition and the resultant "messing up" of her
own life is all the fault of "Warren of the Supreme Court
who let all those criminals loose," and made it possible
for them to viciously attack her husband and rob their
house.

In this connection, it is noted that according
to articles which appeared in the local press, two armed
men had broken into Miss CALDWELL's residence on March 20,
1967 when she, her husband, and their housekeeper were
all present, had demanded jewelry, and beaten and attempted
to smother Miss CALDWELL, but then had fled empty-handed.

On March 27, 1967, Miss CALDWELL had written
a letter to the Federal Bureau of Investigation in which
she related the circumstances of the above break-in,
and in which she stated that the man who had seized
her husband at the time of the break-in had forced
him down on the stairs with a gun at his back, but
"made no effort to otherwise hurt my husband." Miss
CALDWELL in the letter said she believed the objective
of the break-in had not been robbery, but an attempt
to kill her because of her anti-Communist activity.

All documents were initialed by Cpl. POWER, Cst. G.W.J. MOUSSEAU and John WEICH. Originals held as exhibits this point with photostats attached to this report. Copies of Form C246 Exhibit Report #68/41 are attached.

5. The salesman involved with this sale was FELGAL, however, no identification could be made of any photos of RAY. This applies to all the other employees of this firm also.

6. Further enquiries will be conducted at the Montreal Post Office in question and also at the Canada Customs in an effort to obtain the originals of all documents concerning the forwarding of this suit to GALT at 2608 Highland Ave., Birmingham Alabama U.S.A.

7. It will be noted that the order was placed on 21 JULY 67, the letter from GALT was dated 9-6-67 (believed to be 6 SEP 67 in the Canadian way) and the suit was shipped on the 9 SEP 67. It will also be noted that GALT paid cash for this suit.

8. It is requested that further enquiries be conducted at Birmingham, Alabama.

9. With reference to the letter in para #4 (e) above, the envelope in which the letter was sent could not be located.

10. Cst. PHARAND of the Montreal City Police (MCP) Ident. Section was contacted and advised concerning the laundry mark #TF-2307-2219. He advised that the exact location of this mark together with the colour and type of print and whether this number is printed on the shirt or attached to the shirt with some other material i.e., linen, paper or cardboard is necessary to gather all information in this respect, however in the meantime he will make preliminary investigations.

11. Mr. A. CHEVARIE, Manager of Tip Top Tailors, 488 St. Catherine St. West, Montreal (phone 861-1561) was contacted. CHEVARIE advised that tag #3-7153 was of no value in checking his records.

12. After a search of their records, with the cooperation of CHEVARIE, a carbon copy of Sales Slip #RB-239758 was located bearing the name Eric GALT of 2584 Notre Dame St., East Montreal. This item was turned over to us by CHEVARIE and same was initialed by Cpl. POWER, Cst. MOUSSEAU and CHEVARIE. This item is held as an exhibit this point and is shown as item #9 on Exhibit Report #68/41. Photostats of this item are attached.

13. CHEVARIE advises that he believes the #54424 as shown on the sales slip is also marked on the tag which showed #3-7153. Confirmation that #54424 is on this tag will enable a more complete investigation with the possibility of obtaining all original documents concerning the sale of this suit. The #54424 is typed on the tag in the colour blue and #7153 is typed in red.

On June 13, 1968, Mr. JOHN V. CLARK, Corporate Manager, Security Section, The Boeing Company, 7755 E. Marginal Way S., Seattle, Washington, referred SA CHARLES N. GIESE to Mr. CHESTER ALFRED DAHL, Boeing Supervisor in Organization 6-7900, who has a Secret Clearance. DAHL resides at 23024-99th W., Edmonds, Washington and according to CLARK he had information pertaining to a remark made by Mr. JOHN FREDERICK GRACE, a Boeing chemist in Organization 6-3020, who also has a Secret Clearance and who lives at 1009 Tenth Place S., Edmonds, Washington.

ALL MEMBERS OF THE DAHL FAMILY WHO WERE INTERVIEWED REQUESTED THAT THEIR IDENTITIES REMAIN CONFIDENTIAL.

Seattle Indices are negative concerning the DAHL family members and the GRACE family members.

On June 14, 1968, DAHL was interviewed at work; and he advised his daughter, DEBBIE DAHL, is a friend of DEBBIE GRACE, who is the daughter of GRACE above. The summation of Mr. DAHL's information was that DEBBIE DAHL learned from DEBBIE GRACE that three days prior to the KING assassination, GRACE had remarked that KING would be shot. Further, GRACE has attended many John Birch meetings "and others", types unknown. GRACE reportedly has a violent temper.

On June 14, 1968, DEBBIE DAHL, who is 17, was interviewed at her home in the presence of her mother. DEBBIE DAHL related the substance of the information outlined above and added that GRACE is "violently" anti-Communist.

On June 25, 1968, GRACE was interviewed at work by SA GIESE who prefaced the interview by stating merely that it had been reported to the Seattle FBI Office that GRACE purportedly had advanced information that KING would be shot.

GRACE stated that it was his feeling that since KING had been so much in the public eye and since some people were opposed to what he had been doing, he would not have been surprised if KING were shot. GRACE stated that he may have passed this remark to someone but he could not recall to whom or when. He said that he most certainly did not have any foreknowledge that KING would be shot although he was not surprised that it did happen for the reason stated above; but he deplored the shooting. GRACE said he most certainly did not have anything to do with the shooting itself, and he remarked that he has heard other persons remark that they would not be surprised if KING were shot in the connotation noted above.

The Seattle Division is forwarding this for the information of the Bureau and the Memphis Division but does not contemplate any further action in this specific instance.

STATEMENT OF: Lillian SPENCER

I am the Manager of the Branch Office of KENNEDY TRAVEL BUREAU LIMITED, located 424 Bloor St. West, Toronto, Ontario. I have worked for this Company about 2½ yrs.

On 16 April, 1968 a man calling himself Ramon George SNEYD asked for a 21 day ticket Toronto to London. First I confirmed flights for dates requested by telephoning BOAC, in this case it would be May 6th Eastbound, May 21st Westbound. I then assisted him in completing his passport application form. He stated that he had been in Toronto for a period of three weeks, so I also had him complete a statutory declaration in lieu of guarantor. This declaration was signed by SNEYD in my presence.

Q. I show you a photostat copy of the Passport Application and Statutory Declaration. Is this the application and declaration completed by you?

A. Yes.

I told him I would send these documents to Ottawa and the passport would be issued in approximately two weeks. I asked him to come back in two weeks. The forms went to Ottawa on 17 April, 1968.

On 20 April, 1968 I received a printed letter signed by Ramon George SNEYD to the effect that he would be in Capreol for several days and he would pick up his passport on his return.

The BOAC ticket was issued on May 2nd and on the same day Ramon SNEYD picked up the ticket and paid me \$345.00 in Canadian cash. I handed him the passport the same time.

Q. I show you a copy of the passport picture (Picture #1). Do you recognize this man?

A. Yes, as the man who represented himself as Ramon George SNEYD.
