## ORDER ON COURTHOUSE AND COURTROOM PROCEDURES AND PUBLICITY

The Constitutions of the United States and the State of Tennessee guarantee defendants in criminal cases due process of law and the right to a fair trial by an impartial jury. It is the duty of the trial Court to see that every defendant receives all his constitutional rights.

From the world wide attention attracted to this case at bar resulting in massive and pervasive publicity in the news media, the Court is of the opinion that the following rules are necessary to a constitutionally guaranteed, orderly and fair trial by an impartial jury, and therefore orders:

I.

The term "Criminal Courts Buildings" as used herein shall mean the Criminal Courts Building, 150 Washington, and the adjoining Shelby County Building, 157 Poplar Avenue, Memphis, Tennessee.

All entrance ways, corridors, and approaches to Court rooms, offices and other rooms in the Criminal Courts Buildings will be kept clear at all times for free access thereto by those using them in the course of their employment or those having business to transact therein.

II.

No cameras, photographic, television, radio or sound equipment, including tape recorders, will be permitted in the Criminal Courts Buildings or upon the alley-ways, parking los,

yards or grounds immediately surrounding said buildings. No photographs will be taken of the Jury, nor will they be televised. No sketches will be made in the Criminal Courts Buildings.

III.

All persons seeking admission to the Courtroom will submit voluntarily to a search of his person before being admitted.

IV.

No one will enter the Courtroom after a session has begun without permission of the Court, but must wait until the next recess. No one will leave the Courtroom except at recess or adjournment except in an emergency. At noon recess and adjournment, and at any other time the Jury is retiring from the second floor, or the prisoner is being removed to the jail, the spectators shall remain seated in the Courtroom until the Jury and prisoner have had ample time to withdraw, and said spectators have been given permission to disperse.

٧.

The bar of the Court within the rail is reserved for the defendant, counsel, members of the Bar, Court personnel and such witnesses as counsel may desire to be within the bar for consultation purposes. No one else will enter without permission of the Court.

VI.

No one except attorneys of record, their agents, Court personnel, witnesses and Jurors may handle exhibits except by order of the Court.

VII.

All lawyers participating in this case, their assistants, office associates, staff members, investigators and employees under their supervision and control are forbidden to take part in interviews for publicity and from making extra-judicial statements about this case from this date until such time as a verdict is returned in this case in open Court.

### VIII.

The County Medical Examiner, Jury Commissioners,
Criminal Court Clerk, County Sheriff, Police Officials and other
law enforcement officers, employees of this Court, all other
persons employed in the "Criminal Courts Buildings", their
associates, deputies, assistants, staff members and personnel
under their supervision and control are forbidden to participate
in interviews for publicity and from making extra-judicial
statements about this case from this date and until such time
as a verdict in this case is returned in open Court.

IX.

All witnesses, persons subpoenaed to Grand Jury or Court, jurors, and those persons summoned but excused from serving as jurors, are forbidden to participate in interviews for publicity and from making extra-judicial statements about this case from this date and until such time as a verdict in this case is returned in open Court.



I.S. DUNIOF of the R.C.M.P. "O" Division, Toronto, Ontario, contacted the laundry and Dry Cleaning identification examiner of this branch in regard to attempting to identify a laundry mark which appeared on a shirt collar. The mark was described as an encircled C over the digits 24, and when records search had been completed, appeared to be of the type employed by personnel of Community Cleaners, 789 Dundas Street West, Toronto, Ontario.

and Cpl. DUNIOF. M.C. A.F. officers attended this section on Monday, July 8, 1958, producing photographs of two separate laundry marks. One of the photographs related to the mark previously described. The second photograph portrayed the mark EG-CS3 which appeared to be on the waist band of a pair of underpants. The investigating officers were of the opinion that a positive identification had been made in regards to Community Cleaners in the case of the Shirt and requested that an examination be made of the second wark.

It is my understanding our examiner Mr. C.O. Hyrne and the investigating officers are in complete agreement that both marks examined could have been made by personnel of Community Cleaners. I also believe that the investigating officers would like a report on this matter.

BLOCK HAS TWO SEPARATE TV MONITORS, AS WELL AS AUDIO HOOKUP WITHIN CELL BLOCK. PRESENT PLANS CALL FOR TWO GUARDS WITHIN UNIT, ONE TO MAINTAIN WRITTEN LOG DURING DAY. THE SECOND TO OBSERVE SUBJECT. THESE MEN ON SPECIAL SHIFTS. SPECIAL UNIT OF FOURTEEN SELECTED OFFICERS OF SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT WILL BE UTILIZED ONLY FOR DEALING WITH SUBJECT. THESE FOURTEEN SPECIALLY SELECTED DEPUTIES, ACCORDING TO SHERIFF MORRIS, WILL BE TRAINED BY HOUSE CLARK OF BUREAU OF PRISONS. AT PRESENT TIME. LT. SHERIFF MORRIS ALSO ADVISED THAT ACCESS TO UNIT IN WHICH SUBJECT WILL BE MAINTAINED WILL PERMIT NO ACCESS TO OTHER EMPLOYEES OF SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT.

SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS HAVE ALREADY BEEN MADE IN CONNECTION WITH FOOD TO BE SERVED PRISONER. FOOD WILL BE SELECTED ON RANDOM BASIS FROM FOOD SEVED OTHER PRISONERS IN SHELBY COUNTY JAIL. THIS FOOD WILL THEN BE PLACED IN LOCKED CONTAINER AND DELIVERED TO CELL BLOCK IN WHICH SUBJECT WILL BE MAINTAINED.

SPECIAL STEEL PLATE BEING INSERTED INSIDE LOCKED AND SECURED WINDOWS IN CELL BLOCK OCCUPIED BY PRISONER. BUILDING ACROSS COURTWAY, AND ONLY ADJACENT BUILDING, IS COUNTY OFFICE BUILDING. ALL WINDOWS IN COUNTY OFFICE BUILDING WILL BE SECURED. SHERIFF AT PRESENT TIME MAKING ARRANGEMENTS TO INSURE ALL PUBLIC BUSINESS IN ADJACENT BUILDING WILL BE HANDLED IN OTHER COUNTY BUILDINGS IN CITY DURING PERIOD OF INCARCERATION OF SUBJECT. WITH CLOSED WINDOWS WHICH ARE FROSTED TYPE, AND QUARTER INCH STEEL PLATE, SUBJECT DURING PERIOD OF INCARCERATION CANNOT BE SEEN FROM OUTSIDE JAIL. LIKELIHOOD OF SUBJECT BEING SHOT UNDER THESE CONDITIONS WOULD APPEAR EXTREMELY REMOTE. IN ADDITION, ARRANGEMENT AND LOCATION END PAGE TWO

CELL BLOCK IS SUCH THAT PRISONER WILL NOT BE EXPOSED TO ANY OUTSIDERS OR ANY EMPLOYEE OF SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT BEYOND SELECTED GROUP OF FOURTEEN WHILE IN TRANSPORT FROM CELL TO COURTROOM. SUBJECT WILL NOT BE REQUIRED TO TRAVEL THROUGH ANY OPEN PUBLIC CORRIDORS.

SHERIFF MORRIS HAS STATED IT IS HIS INTENTION TO INSIST ON A PHYSICAL SEARCH OF ALL PEOPLE WHO ENTER COURTROOM DURING PERIOD OF TRIAL. STATED HE IS MAKING ARRAGEMENTS FOR SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS THAT ALL NEWSPAPERMEN AND OTHERS WHO WILL ENTER THE COURTROOM WILL BE PHOTOGRAPHED AND COVERED WITH VIDEO AND AUDIO TAPE. IT IS HIS INTENTION TO MAINTAIN THIS VIDEO AND AUDIO TAPE ON DAILY BASIS AND MAKE PERMANENT STORAGE OF THIS TAPE AT CONCLUSION OF TRAJL. HE ALSO STATED THAT DURING PERIOD OF TRIAL HE WILL ESTABLISH A PERIMETER, NOT YET DECIDED UPON, OUTSIDE THE AREA OF THE COUNTY JAIL. ALL PERSONS, INCLUDING EMPLOYEES WHO WISH TO ENTER THE COUNTY JAIL, MUST PASS A TRIPLE CHECK IN ORDER TO SECURE ACCESS TO THE COUNTY JAIL. ACCESS INTO THE COUNTY JAIL IN ITSELF WILL NOT PERMIT ANYONE WITHOUT ADDITIONAL AND SEPARATE AUTHORIZATION TO COME INTO AREA WHERE PRISONER WILL BE KEPT. COURTROOM IN WHICH TRIAL IS END PAGE THEE

CURRENTLY PLANNED WILL HOLD APPROXIMATELY ONE HUNDRED PEOPLE. THIS FIGURE INCLUDES JURY, POLICE OFFICERS, JUDGE, EMPLOYEES OF COURT, AND SUCH MEMBERS OF THE PRESS AND PUBLIC CITIZENS WHO WOULD BE THERE.

INSOFAR AS TRAVEL FROM INSTALLATION AT WHICH SUBJECT WILL BE
DELIVERED, SHERIFF MORRIS STATED HE PLANS TO HAVE TACTICAL UNIT
HANDLE TRANSPORTATION OF PRISONER. THIS WILL BE APPROXIMATELY FIVE
AUTOMOBILES AND ONE ARMORED CAR IN WHICH PRISONER WILL BE TRANSPORTED.
FOUR OF AUTOMOBILES WILL HAVE FIVE FULLY ARMED DEPUTIES IN UNIFORM.
ONE UNIT WILL HAVE FOUR MEN WITH ALL AUTOMATIC WEAPONS. FINAL
SECURITY PLANS AT INSTALLATION HAVE NOT BEEN COMPLETLY RESOLVED
SINCE IT IS NOT KNOWN EXACTLY WHEN OR AT WHAT TIME PRISONER WILL
BE RETURNED. THEREFORE DEEMED ADVISABLE NOT TO MAKE EXTENSIVE PLANS
TOO FAR IN ADVANCE SINCE POSSIBILITY EXISTS PLANNING AT INSTALLATION
AWAY FROM IMMEDIATE CONTROL OF SHERIFF COULD CONCEIVABLY RESULT IN
LEAK OF INFORMATION TO PERSONS WHO MIGHT BE INTERESTED. P.
