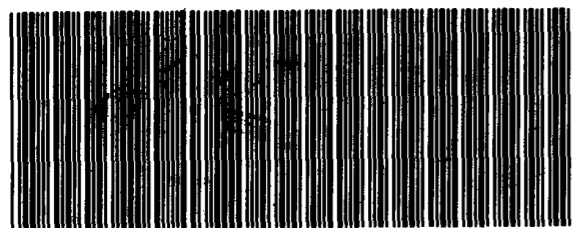

I am at present in detention at the above listed address in London England. In the near future I will most probably be deported to the United States. The reason I am writing you is that you will probably dispatch agents to London to return me to the U.S. and I would like to have it on record now that I have no intention of making any oral statements and that I have nothing to hide but I would prefer to tell my story to a judge & jury. Therefore I would respectfully suggest you send someone with less imagination than Mr. Vinson. I have also written my attorney Mr. Arthur Hous a similar letter. Sincerely

I was shown a letter yesterday (3 July) written by you on a legal fund which you represent, if I remember correctly offering legal assistance in relation to the charge against me in the U.S. as you have probably read in the papers I have returned Mr. Arthur Hanes of Birmingham Alabama. therefore I would rather wait until I return to the U.S. and get his advice before I take any other actions. as far as my personal views on the case I am more concerned with the personal charges made against me by the leftist press than the murder charge. while in the past I haven't gone to much attention to the political side of papers

they charge you with everything

I thought I would write you  
in regard to my extradition  
hearing which began Thursday,  
They seem to be running for  
a field and at this point I think  
it quite of been a mistake to  
contest extradition I won't go into  
details as you probably have read  
the details in the paper.

I suppose you read the paper  
that my English attorney sent  
you concerning Mr. Vernon press  
conference. In my appearance on  
thurs. Sept. Butler of Scotland  
yard stated where Vernon left  
off but I may correct some  
of it Tuesby when the hearing  
resume. I read the letter you  
sent me and I have no  
intention discussing the case

with anyone, I would also  
like to say that I have  
no intention of making any  
oral statement nor that  
I have anything to hide, but  
I would rather tell my  
version to a court of law.  
I am also going to write Mr.  
General Clark to this effect  
as it will stop them from  
dreaming up something while  
they are taking me from  
London to the U.S.

That was highly unusual for  
the British government not  
letting you visit me as they  
have a special place for  
so called security cases.  
From what I gather from my  
English lawyer the U.S. government  
had something to do with  
keeping you from seeing me.  
Do you think it would be  
worth while to take it up  
with a Congressman?

Also I am writing my brother and  
asking him to send you a  
retainer. I'd desire that further  
when I see you.

also I have read where  
they are getting a special  
place ready in the Memphis  
field for television cameras  
I think I have had enough  
publicity would there be any  
way to prevent this or do  
you think it necessary to prevent  
it.  
That all I can think of at the  
present.

I AM AT PRESENT BEING HELD  
IN WANDSWORTH PRISON AWAITING THE  
COMPLETION OF AN EXTRADITION  
HEARING AND PROBABLY DEPORTATION TO  
THE U.S.A. ON THUR. 21-1968  
MR. ARTHUR J. HANES MY ATTORNEYS  
FROM THE UNITED STATES CAME  
TO LONDON FROM THE U.S. TO  
SEE ME. ONE OF THE REASONS  
HE CAME WERE WAS TO CONSULT  
WITH ME ABOUT A MURDER  
CHARGE AGAINST ME IN THE U.S.

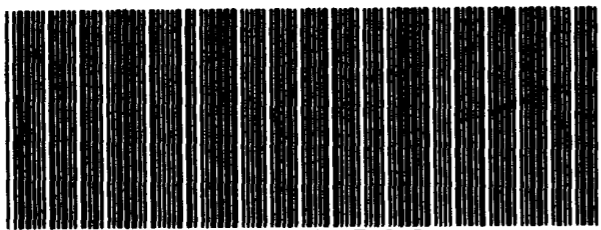
