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The Kansas City Office has been attempting to interview Mr. and Mrs. KARL RAPP, Leawood, Kansas, however they have recently moved from their address at 3101 W. 83rd Street and a new address is not as yet known. He has an office at 208 Nichols Road, Kansas City, Missouri, which is closed at this time and the neighbors feel he may be away on vacation, but could furnish no additional information.

Kansas City will continue efforts to locate and interview the RAPPs to determine the exact date they were in Puerto Vallarta, any additional information they may have re HEINZ MANGER, Odessa or JAMES EARL RAY.

CLESSA - Organisation der SS-Angehörigen (Organization of SS Members)

The Organization: formed in 1947, initially to provide escape facilities and monies for former SS men fleeing prosecution in Germany. It established escape routes which converged at Memmingen in the Allgäu (Bavaria), a secluded, heavily wooded area adjacent to the borders of Austria and Switzerland. At Memmingen routes branched off in two (2) directions, one to Lindau on Lake Constance; the other to Innsbruck and across the Brenner Pass to Italy. In 1947 an "export-import" company was set up in Lindau with representatives in Cairo and Damascus. Much of this early activity with escapees was managed by a German traveling on a Syrian passport and calling himself Haddad Said. His actual identity is (former) Hapsturmführer Franz Röstel, one of ODESSA's main organizers. Röstel now commutes between a German settlement in Uruguay and Spain's Costa Brava where many former SS leaders have vacation homes. ODESSA maintains valuable connections with and, in most cases, officials within certain South American governments as well as Spain, Egypt, Syria, Portugal.

Funding: A secret meeting was held 10 August 1944 at the Hotel Maison Rouge in Strasbourg and among those in attendance were: Emil Kirdorf, coal industrialist, Kurt von Schroeder, Köln (Cologne) banker, Fritz Thyssen, steel industrialist, Georg von Schnitzler, I. G. Farben complex, and Krupp von Bohlen of Krupp Works. These industrialists, all of whom had heavily supported Hitler, were convinced by this point (Aug., 1944) that Hitler would ultimately be defeated. Their interest was in making long range plans for safeguarding assets from Allied confiscation. At this point large-scale transfers of looted property and funds were made to neutral and non-belligerent countries.

A U.S. Treasury Department report in 1946 reported that 750 companies had already been set up by Germans, with German money, in the following distribution: 112 in Spain, 58 in Portugal, 35 in Turkey, 98 in Argentina, 214 in Switzerland, and 233 in various other countries. The list is far from complete.

Purpose: According to Simon Wiesenthal, the world's foremost expert on ODESSA activity has said, "...before the war ended the Nazis set up large, hidden funds for the building of a Fourth Reich." Papers from the organizational meeting in Strasbourg now in U. S. Army hands, the following statement was recorded in the minutes: "Germany has already lost ... From now on Germany's industry must prepare for the economic postwar campaign. Every industrialist must seek contacts with firms abroad, each for himself, without creating attention. And that is not all. We must be ready to finance the Nazi Party, which will be forced to go underground for some time."

Activities: (among others) financing Nazi escapees and families of SS men,
(2) financing prominent lawyers to defend men accused of SS crimes whereas

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most of these defendants have no apparent source of income, 3) organization of a massive legal-aid effort for German war criminals released to Germany by Russia in 1955. After their arrival from the Soviet Union at Camp Friedland, near Göttingen, they received the names and addresses of West German lawyers and were ordered to report to them, (4) finances certain German publishers who prepare massive printings of neo-Nazi propaganda literature, (5) finances meetings of former Nazis throughout the world. One took place in 1966 in Milan. The participants arrived from all over the world with their travel and hotel expenses paid, (6) financing of subversive activities of neo-Nazi groups in several countries.

Example of ODESSA Wealth: While this is only one example of ODESSA's treasure, it is significant. In the village of Altaussee (Austria) centered in what Hitler called the Alpenfestung (Alpine Fortress), where a last heroic stand against invading Allies had been planned, Gestapo Chief Ernst Kaltenbrunner moved at Christmas-time, 1944. Some hospitals were built in the area and transportation of Reich treasures was begun, these deliveries being made to the hospitals (which had no patients) in the Altaussee region by Red Cross ambulance. After March, 1945, the SS began a methodical listing of assets transported to Altaussee. One list fell into Allied hands concerning the shipments made by Kaltenbrunner from Berlin to Altaussee. The following items are listed:

50 kilograms of gold bars
50 cases of gold coins and gold articles, each case
weighing 100 pounds
2 million American dollars
150 million pounds in English banknotes
2 million Swiss francs
5 cases, 100 lb. each, filled with diamonds and
precious stones
1 stamp collection, valued at 5 million gold marks

This and hundreds of other shipments were buried around Altaussee or thrown in Töplitzsee, a nearby lake. Adolf Eichmann lived in Altaussee before flee-ing to Brazil. It is known that he took 8 cases of treasure with him. As late as 1963 diving operations were observed at Töplitzsee. The Austrian government finally (in 1963) conducted its own investigation into the lake and found several cases of English banknotes. Experts estimate the total initial wealth of ODESSA at between \$50 million and \$1 billion.

Examples of Movement by Better-Known ODESSA Personnel: Heinz Mengele, research physician at Auschwitz, who specialized in experiments with children's eyes, attempting to change eye-colors to blue by injection of special dyes. Charged with murdering hundreds of children personally and in most painful ways. In 1954 Mengele was discovered (details on request) in Argentina where he was practicing medicine in Buenos Aires. Mengele was informed by his family in Freiburg (Germany) that a warrant for his arrest had been issued. He fled to Paraguay and was immediately granted Paraguayan citizenship (27 Nov. 1959 by

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Some Observations: ODESSA is the sort of organization which, because of the political philosophy of its members, would see profit in chaos and confusion in democratic countries. Its members still dream, however imprudently, of a return of German superiority in world affairs. This is best accomplished when it appears that democratic institutions lack the internal controls to survive, i. e., civil disobedience, riots, race wars, etc. But most importantly, it has the resources to finance most any undertaking. An organization which offered \$100,000. to anyone who would murder Simon Wiesenthal, the man who tracked down Adolf Eichmann in Buenos Aires, is capable of at least equally unfortunate interventions in other situations.

About the Africa Question: The Nazis and the Arabs have always gotten along well. Today, in the Nigeria/Biafra War, Egyptian military personnel, particularly pilots, are participating in the Nigerian Army's battle with the secessionist Biafrans. ODESSA members are known to have been in Addis Abbaba, Ethiopia. They are throughout Egypt and the Arab countries of the Middle East. They might very well find a profitable gain in influence and, perhaps, territory by financing intrigues and insurrections in sub-Saharan Africa. Their presence is very much felt in the Republic of South Africa where many government officials are former SS men. Certainly an expansion of South Africa's and Rhodesia's apartheid racial policy would be in the interests of men dedicated in mind and money to the creation of totalitarian states.

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

The organization was responsible for the safe passage into neutral or friendly territories of high-ranking SS men. It also continues to be responsible for

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financing extreme Nationalist and Right Wing activities throughout the world. For example, at a meeting in Malan, Italy, a large reward was offered for the murder of SIMON WIESENTHAL, the man who tracked down ADOLF EICHMANN in Buenos Aires. At such times as meetings of this organization are held, it is known that travel arrangements and lodgings are paid for from ODESSA funds, estimates of which run into the hundreds of millions of dollars. A portion of its treasure is reportedly still buried in the Toeplitzsee near Salzburg in Austria. Another significant activity of ODESSA was the financing of the military coup of JUAN PERON in Argentina.

POLLOCK advised that it seemed significant to him that JAMES EARL RAY should have spent a month in Puerto Vallarta and further significant that at the time of his arrest he should have been enroute to Lisbon, Portugal, which is one of the five known headquarters of ODESSA activity. POLLOCK further stated that he knows of no positive information connecting RAY and MANGER or ODESSA. He did add that probably the world's best authority on ODESSA is SIMONE WIESENTHAL, Vienna, Austria.

When the original information in this matter was received from POLLOCK telephonically on 1/21/69 his name was obtained as DALE POLLACK. The Kansas City Office indices were negative regarding DALE POLLACK. However, on DALE L. POLLOCK, Kansas City has an Internal Security - East German file in which he is the subject, KC 105-2706. This file reveals that POLLOCK had expressed an interest in the "Democratic German Report", an East German propaganda publication. No derogatory information was obtained regarding POLLOCK in this investigation and his interest was probably due to the fact that he is a student of post World War II German history. This information was furnished to the Bureau in a letterhead memorandum suitable for dissemination on 9/27/68 in case entitled "DALE L. POLLOCK, IS - EG, OO: Kansas City".



Leads in this matter to determine if RAY is in any way connected with this organization is being left to the discretion of the office of origin. Kansas City will interview Mr. and Mrs. KARL RAPP, Leawood, Kansas, for any additional information they may have.

Mrs. WARD commented her source, in telling her of the above, inferred the source may feel the reported presence of CORTEZ in Memphis, Tennessee, on the date Dr. KING, JR. was killed may in some way be connected with the recent published statement of Reverend JAMES BEVEL that BEVEL has information to the effect that Dr. KING, JR. was not murdered by JAMES EARL RAY. Mrs. WARD stated, however, that she feels this is pure speculation on her source's part.

For information of Memphis, it is noted that JAMES R. CORTEZ is currently a very controversial figure in Louisville, Kentucky. He has been in jail in Louisville since 6/1/68 under a variety of charges. CORTEZ came to Louisville from Washington, D. C., on 5/25/68, and was a leading speaker at a Negro rally in the West End of Louisville on 5/27/68, after which rioting and locting erupted, in Louisville, and continued for the next several days. CORTEZ has received much news publicity since being in Louisville and is of considerable interest to local authorities as he was the only reported "outsider" who had any leading part in events leading up to the Louisville disorders.

For the further information of Memphis, it is noted that the Washington Field Office has advised Louisville that on 4/10/68, CORTEZ voluntarily contacted Washington Field claiming to be an acquaintance of STOKELY CARMICHAEL and affiliated with the Student Non-violent Coordinating Committee (SNCC) and volunteering to furnish information to Washington Field for a price. Thereafter, on several occasions, CORTEZ did

furnish Washington Field information but CORTEZ did not advise Washington Field of his plan to come to Louisville in May of 1968, and CORTEZ made no contact with Louisville FBI upon his arrival in Louisville.



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over 200 witnesses alone (for the prosecution and defense). The first two days were devoted to selecting the jury.

Sirhan has three attorneys, one of whom is named Emile Zola Behrman by an irony of fate. But the great writer's namesake acquired a dismal fame for himself by defending a sergeant who had driven soldiers into a swamp and watched how they perished there.

As always, when a major trial is beginning, the pages of newspapers are alive with sketches from the court-room. No photographs are permitted. It is not even permitted to photograph the TV screen. The TV reporters make up their enforced absence from the court-room by activity in the streets of Los Angeles. They ask passers-by this question: can Sirhan hope for a fair trial after the "publicity" that has been received by "this case"?

Although the most skillful among the numerous visitors to the "Ambassador" are still stealing tea-spoons with the hotel's emblem, "publicity" is not a very fitting word for the tragedy that occurred on June 5-th. One should rather speak of a deliberate effort to impose a certain version of the murder upon American public opinion. When the investigation was only making its first small steps, the Mayor of Los Angeles appeared on television and announced that Sirhan Sirhan is an "agent of the communists" and that Robert Kennedy was a victim of a "communist conspiracy."

A similar rumor was circulated immediately following the shot that struck down Martin Luther King in April, and even earlier -- after the tragic death of President Kennedy in Dallas in November 1963.

The monotony of the "scenarios" foisted off on the public cannot fail to put those on guard who follow the events connected with these three murders.

During a recent trip through the United States, I spent two days in New Orleans. I naturally wanted to meet the district attorney Jim Garrison. I wanted to find out whether Jim Garrison saw any connection between the three crimes. And if so, then how?

Unfortunately, Garrison turned out to be out of town. He had gone somewhere on business. It was senseless to ask his secretary, Mrs. Shuler where he went or for how long. But I was still in luck. In New Crleans I found out that shortly before my arrival, Jim Garrison had given an interview to a small Los Angeles newspaper, the "Free Press." I managed to get a text of this interview. It turned out that the reporter had asked the district attorney many of the same questions that I had intended to ask. This is why I am quoting several excerpts from this talk, which seems interesting to me; I only want to add that as far as I know, this interview was not published by a single one of the major American newspapers (the American press has recently written alnost nothing about Jim Garrison; it is as if a deal had been made to hush up everything concerning the activities of this person). Why this

is so -- the reader will understand for himself, after reading the replies given by Garrison to questions of the "Free Press" reporter.

Reporter: What parallels, if there are any, do you see between the murders of John Kennedy, Martin Luther King and Robert Kennedy?

Garrison: There is nothing "mysterious" in what is happening. I think that the majority of the people in the country feel this, although the clever news services pretend that the word "mystery" explains everything and there is nothing further to be said. The "counter-revolution" that started on 22 November 1963 murdered John Kennedy with the help of an operation organized by the Central Intelligence Agency. This "counter-revolution" is continuing, and that is all...

They are destroying one public figure who opposes the system of military rule in the U.S.A. after another, or any sufficiently frank person who stands between them and the plans for the war in Asia. John Kennedy, Martin Luther King and Robert Kennedy have been killed... At the basis is always the same technique... A "lone killer" is always on hand. The differences are minor, details only.

Reporter: A "lone killer" ...

Garrison: In quotes, of course. In reality, if you look closely at the "lone killer," you will discover his direct connection with the C.I.A. -- it was so in the case of Oswald. Or you will discover a professional killer -- this was the case with Martin Luther King, although it is not clear: did James Ray do the shooting? I personally doubt that he was the killer. It looks like he was used as a decoy. But this is not important. These are details.

Reporter: And what about Sirhan Sirhan? If he had any connections with the C.I.A., they were apparently very thoroughly covered up, or as they say there, "isolated." Do you know anything about Sirhan?

Garrison: I do not want to go into it, because the district attorney and the Los Angeles authorities may decide that I am interfering in their affairs. I will speak generally. The C.I.A. acts under the cover of many facades. The characteristic feature of this case seems to consist of the following: The killer did not realize very clearly that he was used by the C.I.A. Perhaps he thought that he was acting in the interests of some organization of which he was a member. The Central Intelligence Agency has over 500"fronts." Is it difficult to find "motives" for any act by an individual person?

There is no doubt that no matter which path Robert Kennedy would have taken after his victory in California (in the primary elections, which were held there on June 4 -- G. B.), a killer was ready and waiting everywhere, a member of some organization perhaps, and one who did not realize that he was a tool of the Central Intelligence Agency of the USA.

When Robert Kennedy won in California, this meant that he was on the way to the President's chair. Had Robert Kennedy lost in California, he would be alive now. But having won, he was doomed to die. He won, and his chances of survival were few.

John Kennedy was murdered because he had once said that he "would break the C.I.A. into ten thousand small pieces." The C.I.A. did not wish to broken up. This machine is like a living organism -- it does not tolerate anyone standing in its way.

Reporter: Is it true that Robert Kennedy, after becoming President, intended to begin prosecution of the people responsible for his brother's murder? What can you say about this?

Garrison: I had several friends, who were close to him. After meeting with them here, in New Orleans, it became clear to me -- he understood what had occurred, but apparently decided not to undertake anything until he occupied a post that would permit hin to do something. He would have done something, if he could. But they killed him...

The C.I.A. is now so omnipotent that it is to a considerable degree autonomous. The C.I.A. is a global force. It is so powerful that as a secret participant in military-industrial operations, it has in a sense greater power than all other ruling bodies in the United States of America.

Such is the opinion of Jim Garrison, the district attorney of New Orlcans. I think that neither he nor the reporter who asked him the questions harbor the slightest doubts that this opinion -- be it correct or not -- will be corroborated at the trial in Los Angeles.

This trial will hardly be the major event of the next two months. On January 21, a trial -- if it is not postponed -- will begin in New Orleans, in which Jim Garrison accuses Clay Shaw of taking part in a conspiracy for the purpose of killing John Kennedy. And in March -- again if it is not postponed once more -- the trial of James Ray in Memphis, who is accused of murdering Martin Luther King... There are many sensations in the courts ahead. Americans are stocking up on patience. 2388 CSO: 1875-D MICHAELSON, a federal prisoner located at Liberty, Missouri. This letter was dated 2/5/69. In this letter to the U.S. Marshal, MICHAELSON claimed to have valuable information concerning the assassination of JOHN F. KENNEDY, MARTIN LUTHER KING, and Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY. A review of referenced report reveals that FREDERICK ALEXANDER MICHELSON, the subject of Kansas City file #87-21205, Bureau file #87-95561, and that MICHELSON indicated to Bureau Agents on 10/2/68, that he had information concerning the assassination of JOHN F. KENNEDY on 11/22/63, of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING on 4/3/68, and of the subsequent assassination of Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY. MICHELSON stated his information "goes to the scale of great national inportance." While he realized this information had been held too long, MICHELSON refused to discuss it while confined in the county jail at Liberty, Missouri. He indicated a full disclosure will be made if and when he is removed from the jail and placed in a penitentiary or hospital where he might

receive treatment for his nervous stomach.

The above information has already been furnished to the Memphis Division and it was noted that MICHELSON has made claims of being psychotic, however, he was incarcerated in the Missouri State Penitentiary from 6/25/65 to 8/26/68, and both MICHELSON and JAMES EARL RAY were in the Missouri State Penitentiary at the same time.

On 1/31/69, MICHELSON was sentenced to the custody of the Attorney General for a period of six years on three counts each to run concurrently for a violation of Title 18, Section 2314, U. S. Code.

On 2/27/69, MICHELSON was interviewed at the Jackson County Jail, Kansas City, Missouri, and stated that he had important information concerning the assassination of JOHN F. KENNEDY and ROBERT F. KENNEDY. It is noted that at this time MICHELSON did not mention the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING. MICHELSON stated that he had written a letter to JIM GARRISON, Prosecuting Attorney, New Orleans, Louisiana, in which MICHELSON had stated the same information was furnished to U. S. Marshal, OWENS, by letter on 2/5/69. MICHELSON stated that both these letters to GARRISON and OWENS had been mailed on the same day.

MICHELSON stated that he might be willing to furnish information concerning the assassination of the KENNEDY brothers to the FBI if a psychiatrist of MICHELSON's choosing was present along with an attorney to represent MICHELSON. MICHELSON stated that he had gathered the information concerning the assassination of the two KENNEDYs from various individuals in prison, but MICHELSON would not elaborate on what prisons or what individuals.

MICHELSON stated that he had a nervous stomach and was extremely high strung, and if the FBI would arrange for MICHELSON to be sent to the Federal Medical Center at Springfield, rather than the U.S. Penitentiary at Terre Haute, Indiana, he might consider ddvulging his important information concerning the assassinations. MICHELSON at this time refused to divulge any other information and on 2/27/69, he was removed from Jackson County Jail, Kansas City, Missouri, by U.S. Marshals and transferred to U.S. Penitentiary Terre Haute, Indiana.

Unless advised to the contrary, Kansas City is conducting no further investigation in this matter.



Canale, Jr., State Attorney General, Shelby County, Memphis, Tennessee, who is prosecuting the state's case. Our investigation thus far does not include any facts that would support the allegation that a conspiracy exists.

Attached is a memorandum from the Department giving us authority to disseminate the three listed documents. Memphis being instructed accordingly.

JAMES EARL RAY

Mr. Jerry Cohen, Los Angeles Times news reporter in New Orleans, Louisiana, residing at the Cochetta Motel, Room 216, Telephone 822-1560, New Orleans, Louisiana, telephonically advised he had contacted the Los Angeles Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and had been referred to the New Orleans Office of the FBI.

Cohen advised that he and Dave Lawson of Los Angeles, California, who is also a reporter of the Los Angeles Times, had obtained from Charles Stein a telephone number within one week after the arrest of James Earl Ray.

Cohen stated that Dave Lawson had made all the notes of the conversation with Stein but that as he, Cohen, recalls it, Stein showed Lawson a piece of paper which contained a telephone number and that Lawson had copied the telephone number from Stein's piece of paper into Lawson's note.

When Stein questioned Ray concerning this telephone number, Ray had said this is where Ray got his weather report.

Cohen stated that Stein two or three days after talking to Cohen and Lawson had made a call to New Orleans and had determined this number was a number for Troop B of the Louisiana State Police located in the Greater New Orleans area.

Cohen stated that neither he nor Lawson had furnished this telephone number to the Los Angeles Office of the FBI and when questioned as to whether or not this was an oversight advised that subconsciously it had been forgotten with the hope it might materialize into a good story.

Cohen advised that he did not have the telephone number with him but had made a contact in New Orleans while here to attend the Clay Shaw trial, who had determined that there was a Louisiana State Trooper at Troop B named Raul V. Esquivel.

Cohen advised he had no further information concerning this number but that Lawson would have more complete and accurate information from his notes.

A review of the New Orleans indices show an investigation was conducted in the case captioned "TROOPER RAUL VICTOR ESQUIVEL, LOUISIANA STATE POLICE, FERDINAND JOSEPH HORIO, JR. - VICTIM, CIVIL RIGHTS." Esquivel in 1964 was described as follows:

The current New Orleans Telephone Directory lists telephone number 524-6446 to the Provincial Motel, 1024 Chartres Street, New Orleans, Louisiana. The Provincial Motel is where Ray stayed in New Orleans in December, 1967

JAMES EARL RAY

Lieutenant Colonel Ben F. Ragusa, Assistant Superintendent, Louisiana State Police (LSP), Baton Rouge, Louisiana, advised that Trooper 1st Class Raul Victor Esquivel is assigned to LSP Troop B at New Orleans, Louisiana. He advised that in August of 1967 Trooper Esquivel was at that time also assigned to Troop B at New Orleans. He advised that Trooper Esquivel worked as follows during the month of August, 1967:

August 1, 2, and 3: on duty; 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

August 4: day off

August 5: on duty; 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

August 6 and 7: off duty due to a death in his family

August 8 and 9: on duty; 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

August 10: off duty

August 11 through 23: on duty; 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

August 24: off duty

August 25 and 26: on duty; 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Reduce advised that during August, 1967, Trooper Esquivel was resigned to duties in different areas of the Troop B LSP area as he was filling in for other troopers on their days off. He advised that during August, 1967, Trooper Esquivel worked in the New Orleans area.

Ragusa advised that on March 22, 1968, Trooper Esquivel worked an eight-hour shift on that date.

- I. Further to the memorandum of the A/Officer i/c C.I.B. dated in Ottawa the 28 OCT 68, the hotel mentioned is none other than the Harkey Apartments where RAY resided whilst in Montreal. This building concept is fairly large and is situated at the corner of Havre and Notre-Dame East Street in Montreal. The Acapulco Club is part of this building and has its main entrance on Havre Street while the Harkey Apartments have its main entrance around the corner of Notre-Dame Street.
- 2. Further to verbal instructions received from Insp. DUCHESNEAU, enquiries conducted at the Neptune Tavern, 121 rue des Commissaires West, have revealed the following.
- Mr. Eugène GAUDET, co-owner of Neptune Tavern, residing at Rang St-Dominique, Les Cèdres, Comté de Soulanges, P.Q., telephone 452-4438, was interviewed and stated being fully aware of newspaper articles which had been written in respect to WAY's activities in Montreal. He could not however identify photographs of RAY as having been a client at his tavern nor could he offer any information on the blond latin named RACUL.
- Mr. Arthur MORIN, day waiter at Neptune Tavern during the period concerned and residing at 1827 St-André Street, Montreal, P.O., was interviewed and could not offer any information of value relative to RAY and one RAOUL ever having been customers at the Neptune Tavern. From his records, Mr. GAUDET was able to supply the name of a former waiter who had been employed on the evening shift at the tavern during the Summer of 1967. This former waiter was identified as Michel RACON, 2823A Ontario East, SIN Attempts to interview BACON at 2823A Ontario East, have revealed that BACON is no longer residing there and it was not possible to obtain any information as to his present address or employer. It was however, learned that BACON was believed to still be in the Greater Montreal area. Enquiries have been instituted through the regional UIC Office in Montreal in view of locating BACON through his present employer.

Jean-Marie CHARRON, co-owner of Neptune Tavern residing at 5100 Boulevard fie IX, Apt. 104, Montreal, P.O., was interviewed and he stated that at approximately 6:30pm on one of the last days of October 1968, two (2) men who had identified themselves as newspaper reporters from U.S.A. had presented themselves at the tavern and had exhibited to CHARRON two (2) pictures one of which, they stated being the photograph of James Farl fall, and the other being a photograph of RAOUL.

One of the newspapermen who spoke broken French, enquired from CHARRON if either RAY or RAOUL had ever been customers at his tavern. CHARRON states having declined to make any identification either of RAY or RAOUL.

The picture of RAY which was in possession of these two (2) men was identical to the last photograph which was obtained prior to RAY's arrest. The dress and tie were similar with the exception that RAY was holding the lapel of his suit jacket with his right hand. The picture of RAOUL was a full-face picture, passport-type photograph which showed RAOUL to have blond curly hair, age approximately 30 years old, wearing a white shirt, a tie, and a dress jacket. SHARRON stated to us that from our photographs of RAY, he could not state whether or not RAY had ever been a customer at the Neptune Tavern. The same applied in the case of RAOUL. One comment made by CHARRON was to the effect that the photograph of RAOUL which had been exhibited by the American newspapermen indicated to him that RAOUL was not a sailor. One of the newspapermen also made mention that RAY was in possession of a Neptune Tavern matchbook which served to indicate to them that RAY could have visited the tavern.

- 7. The newspapermen who spoke to CHARRON were described as follows: First Spoke English like an American, height 5'6", built small, hair blond, spoke broken French. Second Spoke like an American, approximately 6' tall, thick dark hair, wore a band indicating that he was married.
- 8. Please find attached hereto, photostat copies of a newspaper article which appeared in "The Cazette", Montreal, F.Q., on the 12 NOV 68.
- In an attempt to corroborate CHARRON's statement to the effect that a photograph of a man reported to be RACUL had been exhibited to him, further enquiries will be conducted in the Montreal area. Some of the persons who were interviewed earlier during the course of this investigation will be contacted in a view of ascertaining if they have any information pertaining to RACUL.

This documentation is not just a layman's brief for the doforce of a man wrongfully accused. It is also a public indictment of his accusors, in particular J. Edgar Hoover, who personally supervised this frame-up.

I hereby declare and affirm that J. Edgar Mover - wilfully, knowingly and with malice aforethought conspired with other felonicus "lawenforcement officials" to bring about the judicial munder of James Earl Ray through trumped-up charges and decreed evidence.

Because Hosver knows that his false and fraudulent case will not stand up in court, extreme pressure is new being brought on Ray, a man virtually defenseless because of his long criminal record and his involvement in the conspiracy to kill King, falsely to plead guilty in return for a premise of lenioncy. Ray has been informed unembiguously that, if he defends himself against the murder charge, he will be convicted, sentenced to death and executed. On the other hand, he has been promised a recommendation of mercy, a comparatively light sentence and an early pardon if he accepts the role of a lone assassin.

That would obviate the inconvenience, for J. Edgar Rocver and the State authorities, of having to prove their false and untenable charges in court, but it would hardly serve the cause of justice in America.

As the Moment of Truth Dawns in New Orleans ...

At long last, the historic process of establishing the truth about the assassination of President John F: Kennedy is under way. The trial of Clay Shaw in New Orleans is only a first step in that direction; others will follow soon. In the end, the process inexorably will lead to the annaching of Lyndon B. Johnson as the power behind what was in effect the first coup distat in American history (Nov. 22, 1963).

The time has come for thoughtful Americans to start thinking the UNTHINKABLE -- because it is true.

As the truth gradually emerges in the courts, in the press and in public debate or private discussions, a careful compilation of all the available literature on the assassination and the Warren Report becomes an urgent task for historians, political scientists and librarians, for at least two reasons:

One, each and every book that has been published on the subject makes a contribution to the search for the truth - some large, some small, but none is negligible.

And Two, some day students of history, pondering the era of breathtaking disclosures that is now shead will ask in amazement: How did all this get started?

The Crime of Dallas was almost the perfect crime. Every precaution had been taken by its organizers to make sure that the truth would never come out. And then the Warren Report, this "gigantic fraud" (Garrison), all but sealed off the last avenues of truth-seeking.

Officialdom and the news media not only did nothing to help bring out the true facts, but they actively, and in concert, exerted every possible effort to obfuscate the truth and obstruct independent investigation.

BOOKS, and books alone, were the weapons of truth. District Attorney Jim Garrison himself has publicly acknowledged that it was through his reading of the published critiques of the Warren Report that he felt impelled to open an official investigation into the assassination of President Kennedy.

Now, it is a matter of record, easily to be verified, that the first book published in the United States which attacked the official version of the assassination as an unmitigated fraud was JOACHIM JOESTEN's <u>Cswald</u>: <u>Assassin or Fall Guy?</u> (New York, June 1964). The same book, in its second edition (January 1965) contained the first critique of the Warren Report to come out between book covers.

Since then, JOACHIM JOESTEN has published seven more books about the assassination of President Kennedy which are not, however, generally available in the United States. They are "books-in-exile," published in England. Switzerland and France, because their outspokenness made them too "hot" for American publishers to handle.
